

LOW PRESSURE SYSTEM OVER NORTH CENTRAL COLORADO WILL CONTINUE MOVING EAST THIS MORNING. LATEST RADAR IMAGERY BEGINNING TO SHOW PRECIPITATION BEGINNING TO EXPAND OVER AND WEST OF THE LARAMIE RANGE. PRECIP SHOULD BECOME MORE WIDESPREAD THIS MORNING. AS THE LOW MOVES INTO NORTHWESTERN KANSAS THIS AFTERNOON...PRECIP WILL COME TO AN END. WARMER AND DRIER WEATHER FOR SUNDAY AND MONDAY. BY TUESDAY...WEST WINDS LOOK TO SIGNIFICANTLY INCREASE AS A COLD FRONT APPROACHES FROM THE NORTH. WIDESPREAD STRONG WINDS BECOMING MORE LIKELY FOR TUESDAY EVENING INTO WEDNESDAY. SHOWERS WILL EXIT THE SOUTHERN PORTION OF THE DISTRICT EARLY THIS MORNING BEHIND A STORM SYSTEM EXITING INTO THE CENTRAL HIGH PLAINS. A SECOND TRAILING UPPER LEVEL DISTURBANCE WILL SPREAD ISOLATED TO WIDELY SCATTERED RAIN AND HIGHER MOUNTAIN SNOW SHOWERS SOUTHEAST ACROSS THE DISTRICT THIS AFTERNOON INTO THE EARLY EVENING. A DRY SOUTHWEST FLOW WILL PREVAIL UNDER A RIDGE OF HIGH PRESSURE ON SUNDAY. WESTERLY FLOW WILL STRENGTHEN MONDAY AND TUESDAY WITH AREAS OF STRONG WEST TO NORTHWEST WINDS EXPECTED TO DEVELOP DURING THE DAY TUESDAY INTO WEDNESDAY.
