SHOWERS AND STORMS WILL BE PRESENT LATER THIS MORNING...ALONG WITH WARMING TEMPERATURES. STORMS WILL STRENGTHEN THROUGH THE AFTERNOON...ESPECIALLY ACROSS ZONES 281 AND 285. SOME STORMS ACROSS THESE AREAS COULD PRODUCE DAMAGING WIND AND LARGE HAIL. EVEN THE WEAKER STORMS FOUND ACROSS THE REMAINDER OF THE DISPATCH AREA WILL HAVE THREATS OF GUSTY AND ERRATIC WIND AND FREQUENT LIGHTNING.
