

.DISCUSSION...

NO FIRE WEATHER CONCERNS THROUGH THE REST OF THE WEEK. THUNDERSTORMS WITH HEAVY RAINFALL ARE EXPECTED TO BECOME MORE WIDESPREAD TODAY AND THURSDAY...WITH LOCALIZED FLASH FLOODING POSSIBLE. WETTING RAINS ARE LIKELY ACROSS MUCH OF THE AREA OVER THE NEXT 48 HOURS. CONDITIONS WILL BECOME DRIER INTO THE WEEKEND...WITH THE EXCEPTION OF ISOLATED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS OVER THE MOUNTAINS.

NO FIRE WEATHER CONCERNS THROUGH THE REST OF THE WEEK. THUNDERSTORMS WITH HEAVY RAINFALL ARE EXPECTED TO BECOME MORE WIDESPREAD TODAY AND THURSDAY...WITH LOCALIZED FLASH FLOODING POSSIBLE.
