

A GENERALLY DRY DAY EXPECTED UNDER THE CONTINUED INFLUENCE OF THE RIDGE OF HIGH PRESSURE. WARMING TEMPERATURES AND DECREASING HUMIDITY EXPECTED. WIND IS EXPECTED REMAIN BELOW CRITICAL THRESHOLDS...THOUGH GUSTY WIND MAY BE POSSIBLE AT TIMES ACROSS ZONES 280 AND 289. SURGES OF MOISTURE MAY INTRODUCE SHOWER COVERAGE TO ZONE 285 BY SUNDAY...THOUGH COVERAGE WILL BE ISOLATED.

.DISCUSSION...

NO FIRE WEATHER CONCERNS ARE EXPECTED THROUGH MUCH OF NEXT WEEK FOR
AREAS EAST OF THE LARAMIE AS WINDS WILL GENERALLY REMAIN LIGHT WITH
DAYTIME HUMIDITIES BETWEEN 30 AND 45 PERCENT. WEST OF THE LARAMIE
RANGE...MOSTLY DRY CONDITIONS ARE EXPECTED OUTSIDE OF THE MOUNTAINS
WHERE AN ISOLATED THUNDERSTORM OR TWO IS POSSIBLE OVER THE HIGHER
PEAKS EACH AFTERNOON. THUNDERSTORM CHANCES GRADUALLY INCREASE
TUESDAY THROUGH FRIDAY. DAYTIME RELATIVE HUMIDITIES AROUND 15 TO
20 PERCENT ARE EXPECTED IN THE HIGH VALLEYS BUT WINDS SHOULD
REMAIN RELATIVELY LIGHT.

.DISCUSSION...

NO FIRE WEATHER CONCERNS ARE EXPECTED THROUGH MUCH OF NEXT WEEK FOR AREAS EAST OF THE LARAMIE AS WINDS WILL GENERALLY REMAIN LIGHT WITH DAYTIME HUMIDITIES BETWEEN 30 AND 45 PERCENT. WEST OF THE LARAMIE RANGE...MOSTLY DRY CONDITIONS ARE EXPECTED OUTSIDE OF THE MOUNTAINS WHERE AN ISOLATED THUNDERSTORM OR TWO IS POSSIBLE OVER THE HIGHER PEAKS EACH AFTERNOON. THUNDERSTORM CHANCES GRADUALLY INCREASE TUESDAY THROUGH FRIDAY. DAYTIME RELATIVE HUMIDITIES AROUND 15 TO 20 PERCENT ARE EXPECTED IN THE HIGH VALLEYS BUT WINDS SHOULD REMAIN RELATIVELY LIGHT.
