

Weather Discussion

WYZ280 -
NATRONA COUNTY/CASPER BLM

UNSEASONABLY COOL CONDITIONS WITH SCATTERED SHOWERS...AND SOME SNOW ABOVE 10500 FEET BUT ACCUMULATIONS WILL BE LIGHT. DRY CONDITIONS MAY RETURN THIS AFTERNOON AND TONIGHT ACROSS THE NORTHERN AND EASTERN ZONES. VERY HIGH RELATIVE HUMIDITY WITH LOW MIXING HEIGHTS AND POOR TO FAIR SMOKE DISPERSAL IS EXPECTED. THE CHANCE OF SHOWERS WILL LINGER THROUGH WEDNESDAY WITH CONTINUED COOL TEMPERATURES AND ABOVE NORMAL RELATIVE HUMIDITY.
