

# Weather Discussion

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A GENERALLY QUIET FEW DAYS ACROSS THE DISPATCH AREA WITH LIMITED SHOWER AND THUNDERSTORM ACTIVITY THROUGH MONDAY. WARMING TEMPERATURES EXPECTED WITH DECREASING DAYTIME HUMIDITY. SOME GUSTY WIND ANTICIPATED ACROSS ZONES 289 AND 280 THIS AFTERNOON...WITH GUSTS TO 20 KTS POSSIBLE. THE NEXT ROUND OF SHOWER ACTIVITY MAY BE TUESDAY AFTERNOON AS A SURGE OF MOISTURE MOVES INTO THE AREA. OTHERWISE...WITH FUELS STILL NOT CRITICAL... FIRE BEHAVIOR WILL REMAIN LOW.

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NO FIRE WEATHER CONCERNS. AFTERNOON RELATIVE HUMIDITY VALUES SHOULD STAY WELL ABOVE CRITICAL THRESHOLDS THROUGH MIDWEEK. WIND GUSTS TO 30 MPH ARE EXPECTED TODAY ALONG AND WEST OF THE LARAMIE RANGE...BUT HUMIDITY VALUES ARE EXPECTED TO REMAIN AT OR ABOVE 20 PCT. A TROUGH OF LOW PRESSURE WILL BRING A CHANCE FOR SHOWERS AND STORMS OVER THE MOUNTAINS AND ADJACENT PLAINS THIS AFTN...LIKELY SPREADING INTO THE NEBRASKA PANHANDLE IN THE EVE. A FEW STORMS COULD CONTAIN GUSTY AND ERRATIC WINDS.
