

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.DISCUSSION...MINIMAL FIRE WEATHER CONCERNS OVER SOUTHEAST WYOMING AND WESTERN NEBRASKA THIS WEEK. AFTERNOON RELATIVE HUMIDITIES WILL RANGE BETWEEN 25 TO 40 PERCENT THROUGH WEDNESDAY. THE BEST CHANCE FOR DIURNAL SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS WILL BE TUESDAY AND WEDNESDAY WHERE SCATTERED COVERAGE IS EXPECTED OVER MOST OF THE AREA. THUNDERSTORMS WILL BECOME MORE ISOLATED BY LATE THIS WEEK AS DAYTIME HUMIDITIES BEGIN TO TREND LOWER DUE TO DRIER AIR MOVING INTO THE AREA UNDER WEST TO SOUTHWEST FLOW.
