

WARM...BREEZY TO WINDY AND MAINLY DRY WEATHER WILL BE THE RULE FOR TODAY. A WEAK UPPER LEVEL DISTURBANCE MAY BRING ISOLATED AFTERNOON THUNDERSTORM TO NORTHERN PORTIONS OF ZONE 281 HOWEVER. SMOKE DISPERSAL AND MIXING WILL BE VERY GOOD TO EXCELLENT. DRY...BREEZY TO WINDY AND HOT WEATHER IS EXPECTED WEDNESDAY.
