DRIER AIR MOVING IN FROM THE SOUTH WILL BRING DRY AND WARM WEATHER THROUGH THURSDAY. A GUSTY SOUTHWEST WIND WILL DEVELOP AROUND MIDDAY AND CONTINUE INTO THE EVENING. WITH RELATIVE HUMIDITY FALLING INTO THE TEENS...FIRE DANGER MAY INCREASE EACH AFTERNOON...ESPECIALLY IN AREAS THAT SAW LITTLE RAIN FROM THE SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS OF THE PREVIOUS DAYS.
