Weather Discussion

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A COMBINATION OF WARM TEMPERATURES...A GUSTY SOUTHWEST WIND AND RELATIVE HUMIDITY FALLING TO AROUND 10 PERCENT WILL INCREASE FIRE DANGER ACROSS MOST OF THE AREA THIS AFTERNOON AND EVENING. MIXING AND SMOKE DISPERSAL WILL BE GENERALLY GOOD TO EXCELLENT. A DRY COLD FRONT WILL MOVE ACROSS THE AREA LATER TONIGHT. FIRE DANGER WILL EASE SOMEWHAT SUNDAY WITH A COMBINATION OF COOLER TEMPERATURES...LESS WIND AND SOMEWHAT HIGHER RELATIVE HUMIDITY.

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HOT, DRY, AND BREEZY ACROSS THE AREA TODAY WITH MINIMUM RELATIVE HUMIDITY VALUES MAINLY IN THE 10 TO 20 PERCENT RANGE. FORTUNATELY FUELS ARE NON YET SUPPORTIVE OF RAPID FIRE SPREAD. A WEAK COLD FRONT WILL MOVE INTO THE AREA SUNDAY BUT THE MAIN PUSH OF COOLER AIR WILL OCCUR ON MONDAY. CHANCES FOR PRECIPITATION ARE NEAR ZERO TODAY AND SUNDAY WITH A SLIGHT CHANCE MONDAY MAINLY OVER THE MOUNTAINS.
