...RED FLAG WARNING FOR ZONES 280...281...285...AND 300 THIS AFTERNOON AND EARLY EVENING...
FIRE DANGER ENHANCED FOR ZONE 289...EXTREME ACROSS ZONES 280...281...285...AND 300 WHERE FUELS ARE CONSIDERED CRITICALLY DRY. HOT AND DRY CONDITIONS TODAY ACROSS THE REGION WITH RH VALUES DROPPING INTO THE LOWER AND MID TEENS (PERCENT) WITH WINDS INCREASING OUT OF THE SOUTHWEST AT 15 TO 25 MPH WITH GUSTS 25 TO 40 MPH POSSIBLE. ONLY A VERY SMALL CHANCE FOR AN ISOLATED STORM OVER THE BIGHORN MOUNTAINS LATER THIS AFTERNOON. WEDNESDAY WILL SEE SOME IMPROVEMENT IN FIRE DANGER TO LESS THAN EXTREME FOR ALL AREAS AS BOTH HIGH TEMPERATURES AND WIND SPEEDS DECREASE ACROSS THE FORECAST AREA. FIRE DANGER THEN BEGINS TO INCREASE ONCE AGAIN ACROSS THE REGION THURSDAY AND FRIDAY WITH NEAR EXTREME CONDITIONS MOST LIKELY RETURNING TO ZONES 280...281...285...AND 300 ON FRIDAY.

.DISCUSSION...

CRITICAL FIRE WEATHER CONDITIONS WILL PREVAIL TODAY ACROSS
PORTIONS OF THE DISTRICT DUE TO GUSTY WINDS AND VERY LOW
HUMIDITIES. SOME IMPROVEMENTS IN HUMIDITIES WILL OCCUR THE NEXT
FEW DAYS AFTER A COLD FRONTAL PASSAGE TONIGHT AND SLOW INCREASES
IN LOW LEVEL MOISTURE.
