

...FIRE WEATHER WATCH FOR ZONE 280 BEGINNING NOON THURSDAY AND CONTINUING THROUGH EARLY SATURDAY EVENING...

FIRE DANGER MODERATE FOR MOST LOCATIONS TODAY...AS POST FRONTAL SLIGHTLY COOLER TEMPERATURES AND LIGHTER WINDS GIVE SOME IMPROVEMENT TO FIRE DANGER. HOWEVER...FIRE DANGER THEN BEGINS TO INCREASE ONCE AGAIN TO ELEVATED LEVELS ACROSS THE AREA...EXTREME LEVELS FOR ZONE 280...THURSDAY THROUGH SATURDAY AS HOT...DRY...AND GUSTY CONDITIONS PREVAIL ALONG WITH SOME POTENTIAL FOR DRY THUNDERSTORMS. EXTREME CONDITIONS IN LOW RH AND GUSTY WINDS WILL LIKELY RETURN TO ZONES 281...285...AND 300 BEGINNING ON FRIDAY.

EXPECT A COOLER DAY TODAY IN THE WAKE OF A COLD FRONT WITH DRY CONDITIONS ON TAP. ISOLATED TO SCATTERED THUNDERSTORMS ARE EXPECTED THURSDAY AND FRIDAY WITH AN INCREASE IN LOW AND MID LEVEL MOISTURE. A COLD FRONT WILL BRING COOLER AND DRIER CONDITIONS FOR THE WEEKEND WITH A CHANCE OF SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS AGAIN ON MONDAY AND TUESDAY.
