Weather Discussion

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FIRE DANGER MODERATE TO ELEVATED FOR MOST LOCATIONS TODAY AS WARMER...AND VERY DRY CONDITIONS PERSIST. HOWEVER...WINDS SHOULD BE LIGHT AND VARIABLE FOR THE MOST PART. NO PRECIPITATION EXPECTED TODAY. FIRE DANGER MODERATE MONDAY WITH SLIGHTLY WARMER TEMPERATURES BUT NOT AS DRY AND WITH STILL LIGHT WINDS. SMALL CHANCES FOR A THUNDERSTORM OR TWO WITH VERY GUSTY AND ERRATIC WINDS...MAINLY ACROSS ZONES 280 AND 300.

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.DISCUSSION...

LIGHTER WINDS WILL MITIGATE FIRE WEATHER CONCERNS OVER THE NEXT COUPLE DAYS ALONG WITH INCREASING CHANCES FOR MAINLY AFTERNOON AND EVENING THUNDERSTORMS. A WEAK COOL FRONT WILL PASS ACROSS TONIGHT.
