FIRE DANGER MODERATE TO ELEVATED FOR MOST LOCATIONS TODAY AS SLIGHTLY WARMER...AND INCREASINGLY MOIST CONDITIONS EXIST. WINDS WILL ALSO BE LIGHT EAST TO NORTHEAST AT 5 TO 10 MPH. SMALL CHANCES FOR AN ISOLATED THUNDERSTORM OR TWO WITH LITTLE RAIN AND VERY GUSTY AND ERRATIC WINDS...WITH BEST CHANCES ACROSS NATRONA COUNTY. FIRE DANGER MODERATE TUESDAY WITH SLIGHTLY WARMER TEMPERATURES AND A BIT MORE MOISTURE AND BETTER CHANCES FOR WIDELY SCATTERED THUNDERSTORMS...A FEW STRONG TO SEVERE WITH STRONG OUTFLOW WINDS AND LARGE HAIL.

.TODAY...

SKY/WEATHER.....MOSTLY SUNNY. ISOLATED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS LATE IN THE AFTERNOON. SOME THUNDERSTORMS MAY PRODUCE GUSTY WINDS AND SMALL HAIL LATE IN THE AFTERNOON. CHANCE OF PRECIPITATION 20 PERCENT.

SKY/WEATHER.....MOSTLY CLEAR. ISOLATED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS EARLY IN THE EVENING. SOME THUNDERSTORMS MAY PRODUCE GUSTY WINDS AND SMALL HAIL EARLY IN THE EVENING. CHANCE OF PRECIPITATION 20 PERCENT.

MAX HUMIDITY.....76-82 PERCENT.

HUMIDITY RECOVERY...EXCELLENT.

20-FOOT WINDS.....EAST WINDS AROUND 10 MPH UNTIL 0300...THEN DOWNSLOPE/DOWNVALLEY 4-7 MPH. GUSTS UP TO 15 MPH.

.DISCUSSION...

A SERIES OF WEATHER DISTURBANCES MOVING ACROSS THE DISTRICT THIS WEEK WILL BRING CHANCES FOR SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS EACH AFTERNOON AND EVENING. FOR TODAY...STORMS WILL BE FOCUSED MAINLY ALONG AND EAST OF THE LARAMIE RANGE AND SHOULD PRODUCE WETTING RAINS. COVERAGE LOOKS TO EXPAND WESTWARD INTO THE HIGH COUNTRY ON TUESDAY WITH ISOLATED T-STORMS POSSIBLE. HOWEVER...DRY HUMIDITIES IN THE MID TEENS TO LOW 20S COULD KEEP RAINFALL MINIMAL HERE. WEDNESDAY WILL FEATURE HIGHER HUMIDITIES AND THEREFORE A BETTER CHANCE FOR WETTING RAINS IN THE HIGH COUNTRY. CHANCES FOR WETTING RAINS DISTRICT-WIDE WILL CONTINUE THROUGH THE END OF THE WEEK.
