

Weather Discussion

...STRONG TO SEVERE THUNDERSTORMS POSSIBLE THIS AFTERNOON...
AN UPPER LEVEL DISTURBANCE WILL CROSS THE AREA TODAY AND BRING
ISOLATED TO WIDELY SCATTERED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS...MAINLY
IN THE AFTERNOON. GUSTY WINDS AND SMALL HAIL WILL BE THE MAIN
THREAT FROM ANY STORM. HOWEVER...A FEW STORMS IN ZONE 281 AND EASTERN
ZONE 280 MAY BECOME SEVERE WITH STRONG WINDS AND LARGE HAIL.
RELATIVE HUMIDITY WILL FALL INTO THE TEENS THIS AFTERNOON.
HOWEVER...WIND OUTSIDE OF ANY THUNDERSTORMS IS EXPECTED TO REMAIN
BELOW CRITICAL LEVELS. MIXING AND SMOKE DISPERSION WILL BE GENERALLY
GOOD TO VERY GOOD.
...THUNDERSTORMS IMPLY STRONG GUSTY AND ERRATIC WINDS...
...HAINES INDEX IS HIGH LEVEL HAINES BOTH DAY AND NIGHT...

ISOLATED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS IN THE
AFTERNOON. SOME THUNDERSTORMS MAY PRODUCE
DAMAGING WINDS AND LARGE HAIL IN THE AFTERNOON.

.TONIGHT...

SKY/WEATHER.....PARTLY CLOUDY. ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS EARLY IN
THE EVENING. ISOLATED RAIN SHOWERS IN THE
EVENING. ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS LATE IN THE
EVENING. SOME THUNDERSTORMS MAY PRODUCE
DAMAGING WINDS AND LARGE HAIL EARLY IN THE
EVENING. CHANCE OF PRECIPITATION 20 PERCENT.

MAX HUMIDITY.....73-79 PERCENT.
HUMIDITY RECOVERY...EXCELLENT.
RIDGE TOP WINDS.....NORTHEAST 10 TO 15 MPH UNTIL 0300...THEN WEST.

DOMINATED FIRE GROWTH.

.DISCUSSION...

AN ACTIVE PATTERN WILL CONTINUE THROUGH THE WEEK WITH CHANCES FOR SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS EXPECTED EACH DAY. SOME STORMS MAY BECOME SEVERE TODAY ACROSS THE PLAINS WITH LARGE HAIL AND DAMAGING WINDS POSSIBLE. ISOLATED DRY THUNDERSTORMS REMAIN A POSSIBILITY IN THE MOUNTAINS...HOWEVER CURRENT MODEL GUIDANCE SHOWS A BETTER CHANCE FOR WETTING RAINS TODAY THAN PREVIOUS FORECASTS. ANOTHER ROUND OF SCATTERED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS ARE EXPECTED ON WEDNESDAY...WITH AN OVERALL BETTER CHANCE FOR WETTING RAINS IN THE MOUNTAINS. SIMILAR CONDITIONS LOOK LIKELY FOR THURSDAY.

.TODAY...

SKY/WEATHER.....PARTLY CLOUDY UNTIL 0900...THEN MOSTLY SUNNY UNTIL 1200...THEN PARTLY CLOUDY. SCATTERED THUNDERSTORMS AFTER 1200 UNTIL 1500. SCATTERED SHOWERS AFTER 1200. SCATTERED THUNDERSTORMS AFTER 1500. SOME THUNDERSTORMS MAY BE SEVERE WITH DAMAGING WINDS AND LARGE HAIL AFTER 1500.

20-FOOT WINDS.....SOUTHEAST AROUND 10 MPH AND GUSTY.

TRANSPORT WINDS.....SOUTHEAST AROUND 10 MPH.
HAINES INDEX.....5 OR MODERATE POTENTIAL FOR LARGE PLUME DOMINATED FIRE GROWTH.

.TONIGHT...

SKY/WEATHER.....MOSTLY CLOUDY UNTIL 2100...THEN PARTLY CLOUDY. SCATTERED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS UNTIL 2100...THEN ISOLATED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS UNTIL 0300. SOME THUNDERSTORMS MAY BE SEVERE WITH DAMAGING WINDS AND LARGE HAIL UNTIL 2100.

HAINES INDEX.....4 OR LOW POTENTIAL FOR LARGE PLUME DOMINATED FIRE GROWTH.

SKY/WEATHER.....MOSTLY SUNNY UNTIL 0900...THEN PARTLY CLOUDY
UNTIL 1500...THEN MOSTLY CLOUDY. ISOLATED
SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS AFTER 1200.

MAX TEMPERATURE.....73-81.

MIN HUMIDITY.....11-17 PERCENT.

20-FOOT WINDS.....SOUTHWEST AROUND 5 MPH AND GUSTY INCREASING TO
WEST AROUND 15 MPH WITH HIGHER GUSTS IN THE
AFTERNOON.

LAL.....1 UNTIL 1200...THEN 2 UNTIL 1500...THEN 3.

CHC OF WETTING RAIN.5 PERCENT.

TRANSPORT WINDS.....SOUTHWEST 15 TO 20 MPH.

HAINES INDEX.....6 OR HIGH POTENTIAL FOR LARGE PLUME DOMINATED
FIRE GROWTH.

.TONIGHT...

SKY/WEATHER.....PARTLY CLOUDY. ISOLATED SHOWERS AND
THUNDERSTORMS UNTIL 2400.

MIN TEMPERATURE.....45-51.

MAX HUMIDITY.....60-66 PERCENT.

HUMIDITY RECOVERY...FAIR.

20-FOOT WINDS.....SOUTHWEST 5 TO 10 MPH. GUSTS UP TO 25 MPH
DECREASING TO 15 MPH AFTER MIDNIGHT.

LAL.....3 UNTIL 2100...THEN 2 UNTIL 2400...THEN 1.

CHC OF WETTING RAIN.5 PERCENT.

TRANSPORT WINDS.....SOUTHWEST 10 TO 15 MPH.
