

...NEAR CRITICAL FIRE CONDITIONS POSSIBLE THIS AFTERNOON...

INDEPENDENCE DAY WILL BE SIMILAR TO SUNDAY WITH ISOLATED TO WIDELY SCATTERED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS DURING THE AFTERNOON AND EVENING HOURS. THE MAIN THREAT FROM ANY THUNDERSTORM WILL BE GUSTY AND ERRATIC WINDS. A GUSTY WEST TO SOUTHWESTERLY WIND WILL DEVELOP IN THE AFTERNOON. RELATIVE HUMIDITY WILL FALL INTO THE TEENS AT TIMES. ALTHOUGH CRITICAL FIRE CONDITIONS ARE NOT EXPECTED...ELEVATED FIRE DANGER IS POSSIBLE AT TIMES THIS AFTERNOON. SMOKE DISPERSAL AND MIXING WILL RANGE FROM FAIR IN NORTHERN ZONE 281 TO VERY GOOD TO EXCELLENT IN NATRONA COUNTY.

SKY/WEATHER.....MOSTLY SUNNY THEN BECOMING PARTLY CLOUDY.
ISOLATED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS LATE IN THE AFTERNOON. SOME THUNDERSTORMS MAY PRODUCE GUSTY WINDS LATE IN THE AFTERNOON. CHANCE OF PRECIPITATION 20 PERCENT.

20-FOOT WINDS.....WEST WINDS 15 TO 20 MPH WITH GUSTS TO AROUND 25 MPH.

.TONIGHT...

SKY/WEATHER.....PARTLY CLOUDY. ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS IN THE EVENING. ISOLATED RAIN SHOWERS UNTIL EARLY MORNING. ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS AFTER MIDNIGHT. SOME THUNDERSTORMS MAY PRODUCE GUSTY WINDS IN THE EVENING. CHANCE OF PRECIPITATION 20 PERCENT.

MAX HUMIDITY.....66-72 PERCENT.

.DISCUSSION...

WARMER TEMPERATURES COMBINED WITH A DRY AIR MASS WILL CAUSE MINIMUM AFTERNOON HUMIDITIES TO FALL INTO THE 15-20 PERCENT RANGE LATER THIS AFTERNOON. FIRE WEATHER CONCERNS WILL BE ON THE INCREASE ON TUESDAY AND WEDNESDAY FOR AREAS ALONG AND WEST OF THE LARAMIE RANGE AS MINIMUM AFTERNOON HUMIDITIES FALL TO AROUND 15 PERCENT ALONG WITH WIND GUSTS OF 25-35 MPH. IN ADDITION, ISOLATED SHOWER AND THUNDERSTORM ACTIVITY WILL BE POSSIBLE ACROSS ALL DISTRICTS EACH AFTERNOON THIS WEEK. SOME STORMS MAY BE STRONG OR MARGINALLY SEVERE. THESE SHOWERS/STORMS WILL BE SPOTTY SO ANTICIPATE THE CHANCE OF WETTING RAINS TO REMAIN LIMITED.
