

...NEAR CRITICAL FIRE CONDITIONS POSSIBLE THIS AFTERNOON...

TODAY LOOKS FAIRLY SIMILAR TO THE PREVIOUS FEW DAYS. EXPECT A WARM DAY WITH A GUSTY SOUTHWESTERLY BREEZE DEVELOPING SOUTHERN PORTIONS OF THE AREA THIS AFTERNOON. A SURGE OF MOISTURE WILL BRING ISOLATED AFTERNOON THUNDERSTORMS TO SOUTHERN AREAS THIS AFTERNOON. THUNDERSTORMS ARE ALSO POSSIBLE FURTHER NORTH BUT SHOULD HOLD OFF UNTIL CLOSER TO EVENING. ONCE AGAIN...ERRATIC WIND WILL BE THE MAIN THREAT FROM ANY SHOWER OR THUNDERSTORM. NEAR CRITICAL FIRE CONDITIONS WILL BE POSSIBLE AGAIN IN ZONES 289...280 AND 300.SMOKE DISPERSAL AND MIXING WILL RANGE FROM FAIR IN NORTHERN JOHNSON COUNTY TO VERY GOOD IN NATRONA COUNTY.

...THUNDERSTORMS IMPLY STRONG GUSTY AND ERRATIC WINDS...

.TODAY...

SKY/WEATHER.....PARTLY CLOUDY. ISOLATED RAIN SHOWERS EARLY IN THE MORNING. ISOLATED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS EARLY IN THE AFTERNOON. SOME THUNDERSTORMS MAY PRODUCE GUSTY WINDS EARLY IN THE AFTERNOON.
CHANCE OF PRECIPITATION 20 PERCENT.

MAX TEMPERATURE.....82-87.

MIN HUMIDITY.....18-24 PERCENT.

20-FOOT WINDS.....WEST WINDS AROUND 10 MPH UNTIL 0900. AROUND 20 MPH WITH GUSTS TO AROUND 25 MPH AFTER 1500.

RIDGE TOP WINDS.....NORTHWEST AROUND 10 MPH UNTIL 1500...THEN WEST AROUND 25 MPH.

LAL.....1 UNTIL 1200...THEN 2.

TRANSPORT WINDS.....NORTHWEST AROUND 15 MPH UNTIL 1500...THEN WEST AROUND 25 MPH.

.TONIGHT...

SKY/WEATHER.....PARTLY CLOUDY. ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS EARLY IN THE EVENING. ISOLATED RAIN SHOWERS UNTIL EARLY MORNING. ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS IN THE LATE EVENING AND EARLY MORNING. SOME THUNDERSTORMS MAY PRODUCE GUSTY WINDS EARLY IN THE EVENING.
CHANCE OF PRECIPITATION 20 PERCENT.

MIN TEMPERATURE.....52-57.

MAX HUMIDITY.....67-73 PERCENT.

HUMIDITY RECOVERY...GOOD.

20-FOOT WINDS.....WEST WINDS 10 TO 15 MPH WITH GUSTS TO AROUND 25 MPH UNTIL 2400...THEN NORTHWEST.

RIDGE TOP WINDS.....WEST AROUND 20 MPH UNTIL 2100...THEN AROUND 10 MPH UNTIL 2400...THEN NORTHWEST.

CHC OF WETTING RAIN.ZERO PERCENT.

TRANSPORT WINDS.....WEST AROUND 25 MPH UNTIL 2100...THEN AROUND 15 MPH UNTIL 2400...THEN NORTHWEST.

HAINES INDEX.....5 OR MODERATE POTENTIAL FOR LARGE PLUME DOMINATED FIRE GROWTH.

.DISCUSSION...

WARM, BREEZY AND MOSTLY DRY CONDITIONS TO CONTINUE ACROSS THE DISTRICTS TODAY AND WEDNESDAY. CONDITIONS LOOK TO FALL SHORT OF CRITICAL THRESHOLDS TODAY, WITH MINIMUM HUMIDITIES DRYING INTO THE 15-20 PERCENT RANGE WITH WIND GUSTS PERHAPS REACHING 20-25 MPH BY AFTERNOON. CONDITIONS LOOK MORE PROBLEMATIC ON WEDNESDAY AS MINIMUM HUMIDITIES LOOK TO FALL BELOW 15 PERCENT AND WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO GUST IN EXCESS OF 25 MPH. PENDING FUEL STATUS, WILL NEED TO CONTINUE EVALUATING THE POTENTIAL FOR FIRE HIGHLIGHTS ON WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON. WEAK FRONT MOVES THROUGH THURSDAY MORNING WHICH WILL HELP KEEP CRITICAL CONDITIONS AT BAY FOR THURSDAY-FRIDAY. CRITICAL FIRE CONDITIONS LOOK INCREASINGLY PROBABLE TO RETURN AGAIN NEXT WEEKEND. ALTHOUGH ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS WILL BE POSSIBLE EVERYWHERE TODAY AND ALONG A DOUGLAS TO ALLIANCE ON WEDNESDAY, PROSPECTS OF WETTING RAINS WILL BE LIMITED.
