

Weather Discussion

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TODAY WILL BE A WARMER DAY WITH A GUSTY SOUTHWEST WIND DEVELOPING IN THE AFTERNOON. WITH RELATIVE HUMIDITY FALLING AS LOW AS 9 PERCENT...THE RED FLAG WARNING HAS BEEN CONTINUED. RED FLAG CONDITIONS LOOK LIKELY FOR NATRONA...BUT A BIT MORE BORDERLINE IN JOHNSON COUNTY. ISOLATED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS WILL DEVELOP LATER THIS AFTERNOON AND EVENING ACROSS ZONE 281 WITH ERRATIC WIND GUSTS THE MAIN THREAT FROM ANY STORM. MIXING AND SMOKE DISPERSAL WILL BE GOOD TO EXCELLENT. FIRE DANGER WILL REMAIN HIGH ON SUNDAY WITH STRONG WINDS AHEAD OF A COLD FRONT THAT WILL SWEEP ACROSS THE AREA SUNDAY NIGHT.

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.DISCUSSION...DRY...BREEZY AND VERY WARM TEMPERATURES WILL CREATE CRITICAL FIRE WEATHER CONDITIONS FOR MUCH OF EAST AND SOUTH CENTRAL WYOMING THIS AFTERNOON AND EARLY EVENING. MORE WIDESPREAD GUSTY WINDS COMBINED WITH VERY WARM TEMPERATURES ARE EXPECTED SUNDAY IN ADVANCE OF A STRONG COLD FRONT. DRY...MUCH COOLER AND BREEZY CONDITIONS CAN BE EXPECTED MONDAY FOLLOWING THE COLD FRONTAL PASSAGE.
