...RED FLAG WARNING FOR ZONES 280 AND 281 THIS AFTERNOON...

TODAY WILL BE ANOTHER WARM TO HOT DAY. A SOUTHWEST WIND...AT TIMES STRONG WILL DEVELOP AHEAD OF A COLD FRONT THAT WILL MOVE ACROSS THE AREA THIS EVENING. WITH RELATIVE HUMIDITY FALLING INTO THE SINGLE DIGITS IN SOME AREAS...FIRE DANGER WILL BE ELEVATED TO EXTREME IN THE AFTERNOON. MIXING AND SMOKE DISPERSAL WILL BE GENERALLY VERY GOOD TO EXCELLENT. ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS WILL ERRATIC WINDS WILL BE POSSIBLE IN THE EVENING. MONDAY WILL BE A MUCH COOLER DAY BUT WITH A GUSTY WEST WIND CONTINUING.

SKY/WEATHER.....PARTLY CLOUDY. ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS LATE IN THE EVENING. ISOLATED RAIN SHOWERS IN THE LATE EVENING AND OVERNIGHT. SOME THUNDERSTORMS MAY PRODUCE GUSTY WINDS LATE IN THE EVENING. CHANCE OF PRECIPITATION 20 PERCENT.

HUMIDITY RECOVERY...GOOD.

...RED FLAG WARNING IN EFFECT FROM NOON TODAY TO 8 PM MDT THIS EVENING FOR FIRE WEATHER ZONES 301...310...311 AND 312...

.DISCUSSION...CRITICAL FIRE WEATHER CONDITIONS ARE FORECAST FOR THE SOUTHEAST WYOMING PLAINS AND NORTHERN NEBRASKA PANHANDLE THIS AFTERNOON DUE TO HOT TEMPERATURES...STRONG AND GUSTY WINDS AND VERY LOW HUMIDITIES. A RED FLAG WARNING IS IN EFFECT FOR FIRE WEATHER ZONES 301...310...311 AND 312 FROM NOON UNTIL 8 PM SUNDAY EVENING. VERY WINDY CONDITIONS WILL OCCUR MONDAY WITH THE PASSAGE OF A STRONG COLD FRONT...HOWEVER TEMPERATURES WILL BE COOLER. LOW HUMIDITIES WILL YIELD CRITICAL FIRE WEATHER CONDITIONS FOR THE PLAINS.
