

Weather Discussion

...CASPER DISPATCH AREA (INCLUDES FIRE WEATHER ZONES 280...281...
285...289...AND 300)...

...ELEVATED FIRE DANGER TODAY...

TODAY WILL BE A MUCH COOLER DAY FOLLOWING THE PASSAGE OF A COLD FRONT. A GUSTY WEST TO SOUTHWEST WIND WILL DEVELOP THIS MORNING WITH STRONG WINDS WITH GUSTS TO 50 TO 55 MPH POSSIBLE IN PORTIONS OF ZONES 280 AND 289 FROM MID MORNING INTO EARLY AFTERNOON. RELATIVE HUMIDITY WILL FALL INTO THE TEENS BUT SHOULD REMAIN ABOVE CRITICAL LEVELS. MIXING AND SMOKE DISPERSAL WILL BE GENERALLY VERY GOOD TO EXCELLENT. MAINLY DRY WEATHER SHOULD CONTINUE INTO WEDNESDAY WITH GRADUALLY WARMING TEMPERATURES. WITH A GUSTY WIND CONTINUING ON TUESDAY...FIRE DANGER COULD BE ELEVATED ONCE AGAIN.

20-FOOT WINDS.....WEST WINDS 15 TO 20 MPH WITH GUSTS TO AROUND 30 MPH UNTIL 2400...THEN AROUND 10 MPH WITH GUSTS TO AROUND 15 MPH.

RIDGE TOP WINDS.....WEST AROUND 25 MPH UNTIL 2100...THEN AROUND 15 MPH.

.DISCUSSION...

DESPITE THE COOLER TEMPERATURES TODAY BEHIND A COLD FRONT, A VERY DRY AIRMASS WILL CAUSE MINIMUM AFTERNOON HUMIDITY VALUES TO DROP TO 10-15 PERCENT. STRONG WINDS WILL ALSO DEVELOP BY LATE THIS MORNING WITH GUSTS TO 40 TO 60 MPH THROUGH THE AFTERNOON. THUS, CRITICAL TO EXTREMELY CRITICAL CONDITIONS ARE EXPECTED FOR AREAS TO THE EAST OF THE LARAMIE RANGE WHERE FUELS ARE SUPPORTIVE OF RAPID FIRE GROWTH. IT WILL BE LESS WINDY ON TUESDAY, HOWEVER VERY DRY CONDITIONS WILL STILL SUPPORT AN ELEVATED TO CRITICAL FIRE WEATHER THREAT.
