

FIRE DANGER SHOULD REMAIN LOW TO MODERATE TODAY. ALTHOUGH RELATIVE HUMIDITY COULD FALL INTO THE LOWER TEENS AT TIMES IN THE SOUTHERN ZONES...WIND SHOULD REMAIN LIGHT TO MODERATE FOR ALL AREAS. ISOLATED AFTERNOON AND EVENING THUNDERSTORMS ARE POSSIBLE THIS AFTERNOON AND EVENING THAT COULD CONTAIN ERRATIC WINDS. MIXING AND SMOKE DISPERSAL WILL BE GENERALLY GOOD.

.TODAY...

SKY/WEATHER.....MOSTLY SUNNY THEN BECOMING PARTLY CLOUDY.
ISOLATED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS LATE IN THE AFTERNOON. SOME THUNDERSTORMS MAY PRODUCE GUSTY WINDS LATE IN THE AFTERNOON. CHANCE OF PRECIPITATION 20 PERCENT.

MAX TEMPERATURE.....83-88.

MIN HUMIDITY.....14-20 PERCENT.

20-FOOT WINDS.....UPSLOPE/UPVALLEY 5-9 MPH.

RIDGE TOP WINDS.....WEST 5 TO 10 MPH UNTIL 1200...THEN SOUTH.

LAL.....1 UNTIL 1200...THEN 2.

TRANSPORT WINDS.....WEST AROUND 10 MPH UNTIL 1200...THEN SOUTH.

.TONIGHT...

SKY/WEATHER.....PARTLY CLOUDY. ISOLATED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS IN THE EVENING. SOME THUNDERSTORMS MAY PRODUCE GUSTY WINDS IN THE EVENING. CHANCE OF PRECIPITATION 20 PERCENT.

MIN TEMPERATURE.....51-56.

MAX HUMIDITY.....61-67 PERCENT.

HUMIDITY RECOVERY...GOOD.

20-FOOT WINDS.....EAST WINDS 10 TO 15 MPH AND GUSTY UNTIL 0300...THEN DOWNSLOPE/DOWNVALLEY 4-7 MPH.

RIDGE TOP WINDS.....EAST 10 TO 15 MPH UNTIL 0300...THEN SOUTH.

LAL.....2 UNTIL 2400...THEN 1.

CHC OF WETTING RAIN.ZERO PERCENT.

TRANSPORT WINDS.....EAST 15 TO 20 MPH UNTIL 0300...THEN SOUTH AROUND 10 MPH.

HAINES INDEX.....6 OR HIGH POTENTIAL FOR LARGE PLUME DOMINATED FIRE GROWTH.

.DISCUSSION...CRITICAL FIRE WEATHER CONDITIONS ARE POSSIBLE ON SATURDAY...MAINLY OVER THE MOUNTAIN ZONES.ISSUED A FIRE WEATHER WATCH FOR THE SIERRA MADRE RANGE AND SNOWY RANGE...INCLUDING THE MEDICINE BOW NATIONAL FOREST. ALTHOUGH CONDITIONS ARE MARGINAL...THERE IS ELEVATED CONCERN DUE TO THE ACTIVE BEAVER CREEK WILDFIRE NEAR THE COLORADO AND WYOMING BORDER SOUTH OF ENCAMPMENT AND SARATOGA. RELATIVE HUMIDITIES WILL BEGIN TO TREND HIGHER BY SUNDAY AND MONDAY AS SUBTROPICAL MONSOON MOISTURE BEGINS TO MOVE INTO THE REGION.
