

Weather Discussion

...RED FLAG WARNING FOR ZONES 280 AND 300 THIS AFTERNOON AND EARLY EVENING...

FIRE DANGER ELEVATED FOR MOST LOCATIONS...EXTREME ACROSS PORTIONS OF NATRONA COUNTY TODAY AS WARMER AND DRIER CONDITIONS PREVAIL UNTIL THIS EVENING. MINIMUM RH VALUES WILL RANGE FROM THE LOWER AND MID TEENS ACROSS THE LOWER ELEVATIONS OF CENTRAL WYOMING TO THE MID TEENS TO LOWER 20S (PERCENT) IN THE MOUNTAINS. WINDS BECOMING SOUTHWEST 10 TO 20 MPH WITH GUSTS 25 TO 30 MPH AT TIMES. A FEW LATE DAY ISOLATED SHOWERS OR THUNDERSTORMS WILL BE POSSIBLE BY EVENING OVER THE MOUNTAINS. MOST OF THIS ACTIVITY WILL PRODUCE LITTLE RAINFALL AND GUSTY OUTFLOW WINDS TO 45 MPH. FIRE DANGER MODERATE MOUNTAINS TO ELEVATED ACROSS THE FOOTHILLS AND LOW ELEVATIONS TUESDAY WITH SLIGHTLY WARMER TEMPERATURES AND SLIGHTLY HIGHER RH VALUES AS WINDS BLOW OUT OF THE SOUTHWEST 5 TO 15 MPH. ONLY A FEW ISOLATED SHOWERS/STORMS POSSIBLE OVER THE MOUNTAINS AND ADJACENT FOOTHILLS OF THE FORECAST AREA.

.DISCUSSION...

ELEVATED TO CRITICAL FIRE WEATHER CONDITIONS ACROSS CARBON COUNTY AS WELL AS WESTERN CONVERSE COUNTY THIS AFTERNOON AS VERY DRY AIR REMAINS IN PLACE. STRONGEST WINDS WILL BE OUT OVER FWZ 303 AND 304 WHERE FUELS ARE STILL NOT REPORTED READY FOR RAPID FIRE GROWTH. ACROSS WESTERN 301...WINDS WILL BE ELEVATED BUT JUST BELOW CRITICAL LEVELS AT 20 TO 25MPH ON GUSTS. SHOULD SEE PRETTY DECENT TO GOOD HUMIDITY RECOVERIES FOR ALL LOCATIONS OVERNIGHT. ANOTHER DRY DAY FOR TUESDAY ACROSS CONVERSE AND CARBON COUNTIES...BUT WINDS CONSIDERABLY LESS. SO NO FIRE WEATHER CONCERNS EXPECTED.
