

MINIMAL FIRE WEATHER CONCERNS THROUGH EARLY NEXT WEEK. MINIMUM HUMIDITY VALUES WILL FALL TO 10 TO 20 PERCENT EACH AFTERNOON THROUGH MONDAY FOR AREAS TO THE WEST OF THE LARAMIE RANGE. HOWEVER, WIND GUSTS WILL STAY MOSTLY BELOW 20 MPH AND THUS NO FIRE WEATHER THREAT IS ANTICIPATED ACROSS ZONES WHERE FUELS ARE READY.
