

.DISCUSSION...

MINIMAL FIRE WEATHER CONCERNS THROUGH TUESDAY. MINIMUM HUMIDITY VALUES WILL FALL TO 10-20 PERCENT EACH AFTERNOON FOR AREAS TO THE WEST OF THE LARAMIE RANGE. HOWEVER, WIND GUSTS WILL STAY MOSTLY BELOW 20 MPH AND THUS NO FIRE WEATHER THREAT IS ANTICIPATED. ISOLATED AFTERNOON AND EVENING THUNDERSTORMS WILL BE POSSIBLE ACROSS AREAS TO THE EAST OF THE LARAMIE RANGE, HOWEVER THE CHANCE OF WETTING RAINS WILL BE SMALL.
