FIRE DANGER ELEVATED ALL LOCATIONS TODAY...AS SIMILAR TO SLIGHTLY
WARMER TEMPERATURES COMPARED TO THOSE ON WEDNESDAY AND SIMILAR TO
SLIGHTLY HIGHER RH VALUES COMBINE. MINIMUM RH VALUES WILL RANGE FROM
THE MID AND UPPER TEENS ACROSS THE LOWER ELEVATIONS...TO THE MID 20S
(PERCENT) OVER THE BIGHORN MOUNTAINS. WINDS SOUTH TO SOUTHWEST 5 TO
15 MPH WITH OCCASIONAL GUSTS TO 20 MPH. CHANCE FOR AN WIDELY
