

...RED FLAG WARNING IN EFFECT FROM NOON TODAY THROUGH 10 PM THIS EVENING FOR ALL ZONES...

FIRE DANGER CRITICAL FOR ALL LOCATIONS TODAY...AS SIMILAR TO SLIGHTLY COOLER TEMPERATURES COMPARED TO THOSE ON THURSDAY AND SIMILAR TO SLIGHTLY HIGHER RH VALUES COMBINE. MINIMUM RH VALUES WILL RANGE FROM THE MID AND UPPER TEENS ACROSS THE LOWER ELEVATIONS...TO THE UPPER 20S (PERCENT) OVER THE BIGHORN MOUNTAINS. WINDS INCREASING OUT OF THE SOUTHWEST 15 TO 25 MPH WITH GUSTS 30 TO 35 MPH AT TIMES. CHANCE FOR ISOLATED SHOWERS/STORMS MAINLY OVER THE BIGHORN MOUNTAINS. FIRE DANGER ELEVATED SATURDAY WITH COOLER TEMPERATURES AND HIGHER RH VALUES FOR MOST LOCATIONS WHEN COMPARED TO TODAY...RANGING FROM NEAR 20 TO 40 PERCENT. WINDS VARIABLE TO SOUTHWEST 5 TO 20 MPH WITH GUSTS 25 TO 30 MPH AT TIMES. CHANCE FOR ISOLATED TO WIDELY SCATTERED SHOWERS/STORMS...BETTER CHANCE IN THE EVENING

WINDY CONDITIONS ARE GOING TO CONTINUE TODAY AHEAD OF A COLD FRONT MOVING INTO NORTHWESTERN WYOMING. COMBINATION OF DRY HUMIDITIES AND STRONG WINDS STILL LOOK LIKELY ACROSS CONVERSE COUNTY IN FWZ 301 AND WILL CONTINUE THE RED FLAG WARNING FOR THIS ZONE. AS FOR CARBON AND NORTHERN ALBANY COUNTIES...HUMIDITIES LOOK JUST A LITTLE TOO HIGH FOR WARNINGS. WILL CARRY ELEVATED WORDING IN THE AM FWF FOR THESE ZONES. WINDY CONDITIONS WILL CONTINUE WEST OF THE LARAMIE RANGE AS THE FRONT LAYS UP AGAINST THE EAST SLOPES THROUGH SUNDAY EVENING BEFORE PUSHING OFF TO THE EAST. FORTUNATELY...COOLER TEMPERATURES AND HIGHER HUMIDITIES SHOULD KEEP CRITICAL FIRE WEATHER CONDITIONS FROM DEVELOPING AFTER TODAY.
