

ELEVATED FIRE CONCERNS FOR THE SOUTH HALF TODAY WITH WINDY(SOUTHWEST 15 TO 25 MPH WITH GUSTS 30 TO 40 MPH) CONDITIONS BUT WITH MOST AREAS SEEING RH`S IN THE 20 TO 25 PERCENT RANGE. A CHANCE OF SHOWERS AND ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS WITH GUSTY WINDS WILL ALSO BE POSSIBLE...MORE NUMEROUS NORTH HALF.

SKY/WEATHER.....MOSTLY CLOUDY. ISOLATED RAIN SHOWERS IN THE MORNING...THEN SCATTERED RAIN SHOWERS AND ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS IN THE AFTERNOON. SOME THUNDERSTORMS MAY PRODUCE GUSTY WINDS AND SMALL HAIL IN THE AFTERNOON. CHANCE OF PRECIPITATION 50 PERCENT.

TRANSPORT WINDS.....SOUTH AROUND 15 MPH UNTIL 0900...THEN SOUTHWEST 25 TO 30 MPH.

HAINES INDEX.....3 OR VERY LOW POTENTIAL FOR LARGE PLUME DOMINATED FIRE GROWTH.

.TONIGHT...

SKY/WEATHER.....MOSTLY CLOUDY THEN BECOMING PARTLY CLOUDY. SCATTERED RAIN SHOWERS AND ISOLATED THUNDERSTORMS IN THE EVENING...THEN ISOLATED RAIN SHOWERS AFTER MIDNIGHT. SOME THUNDERSTORMS MAY PRODUCE GUSTY WINDS AND SMALL HAIL IN THE EVENING. CHANCE OF PRECIPITATION 50 PERCENT.

MIN TEMPERATURE.....45-50.

MAX HUMIDITY.....81-87 PERCENT.

HUMIDITY RECOVERY...EXCELLENT.

20-FOOT WINDS.....SOUTH WINDS AROUND 20 MPH WITH GUSTS TO AROUND 30 MPH UNTIL 2100...THEN EAST AND GUSTY UNTIL 2400...THEN NORTH WITH GUSTS TO AROUND 15 MPH.

RIDGE TOP WINDS.....SOUTH AROUND 25 MPH UNTIL 2100...THEN EAST AROUND 15 MPH UNTIL 2400...THEN NORTH.

LAL.....3 UNTIL 2400...THEN 1.

CHC OF WETTING RAIN.10 PERCENT UNTIL 2400...THEN ZERO PERCENT.

TRANSPORT WINDS.....SOUTH AROUND 30 MPH UNTIL 2100...THEN EAST AROUND 20 MPH UNTIL 2400...THEN NORTH.

HAINES INDEX.....3 OR VERY LOW POTENTIAL FOR LARGE PLUME DOMINATED FIRE GROWTH.

.DISCUSSION...

MINIMAL FIRE WEATHER CONCERNS TODAY, BUT WINDS WILL BE GUSTY FOR AREAS WEST OF THE LARAMIE RANGE. THIS AREA COULD SEE WIND GUSTS OF 30 TO 35 MPH. AFTERNOON HUMIDITIES ARE EXPECTED TO BE ABOVE CRITICAL LEVELS, IN THE UPPER 20S TO LOW 30 PERCENT RANGE, SO CONCERNS SHOULD BE MARGINAL. DRIER AIR MOVES INTO SOUTHEAST WYOMING WEST OF THE LARAMIE RANGE MONDAY AND PERSIST THROUGH THE WEEK. GUSTY SOUTHWEST WINDS WEST OF THE LARAMIE RANGE TO CREATE ELEVATED FIRE WEATHER CONDITIONS FOR THIS AREA EACH DAY THROUGH AT LEAST WEDNESDAY. A BACKDOOR COLD FRONT MOVES INTO AREAS EAST OF THE LARAMIE RANGE TUESDAY AND STALLS ALONG THE LARAMIE RANGE THROUGH WEDNESDAY BEFORE MOVING OFF TO THE EAST. MINIMAL FIRE WEATHER CONCERNS EAST OF THE LARAMIE RANGE.
