DISCUSSION...

High pressure builds back over the region today allowing for warm and dry conditions with light winds. Similar weather can be expected through the week before the next system could arrive this weekend. Chances for precipitation, strong winds, and cooler weather will be possible Saturday through Monday.

**Low elevation:** The BLM and Park Service are typically lower in elevation and experience the potential for active fire behavior or large fire growth when the live fuel moistures are at or near the following values: Sagebrush 120-135%, Pinion/Juniper 70-89%, Pondo 100%, 1000 hour-fuels with a fuel moisture value of 10% or less (7-8%). A combination of any of these factors can greatly increase fire behavior. 20' wind speeds over 10mph, RH less than 20%, Temperatures over 80 degrees.

**High elevation:** In recent years the Routt National Forest has experienced large fire growth with long range spotting when live fuel moistures near and drop below the following values: Sagebrush 100%, gambel oak 130%, lodgepole pine, engelman spruce, and subalpine fir 100%. Dead lodgepole pine 1000-hour fuels with a fuel moisture of 15% and below burns intensely in many areas of the forest due to the abundance of this fuel type. These values should only be used as a guide and keep in mind that wind and slope alignment will cause these fuels to burn readily at higher values.

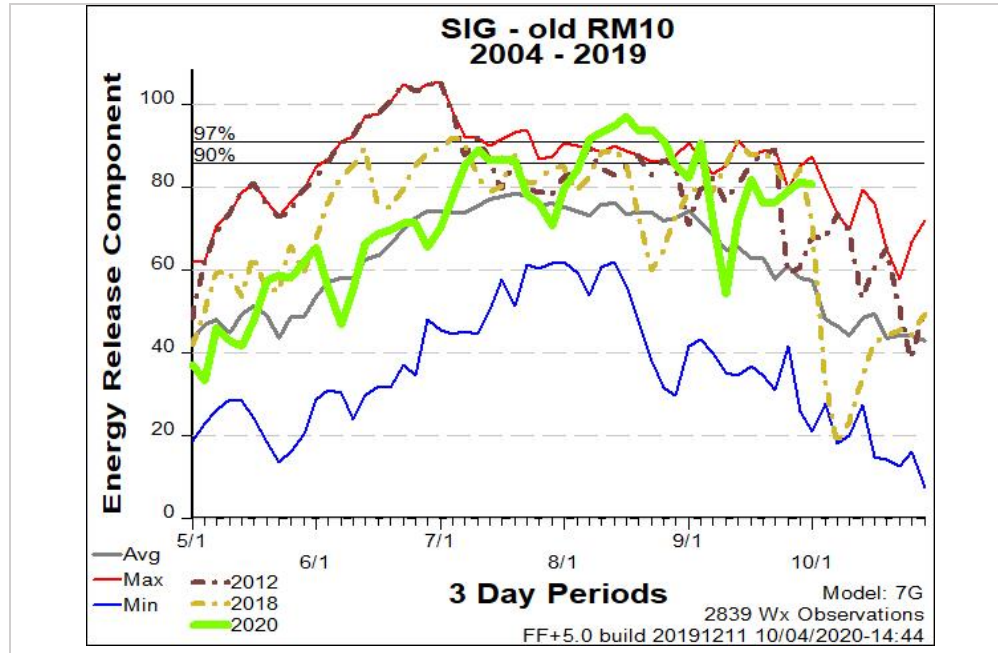

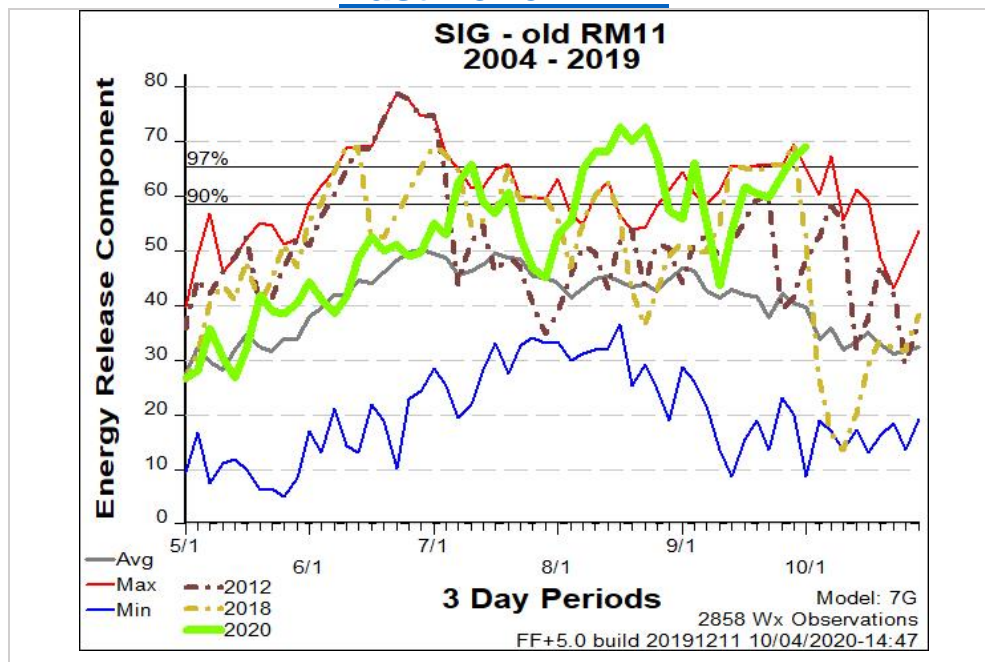

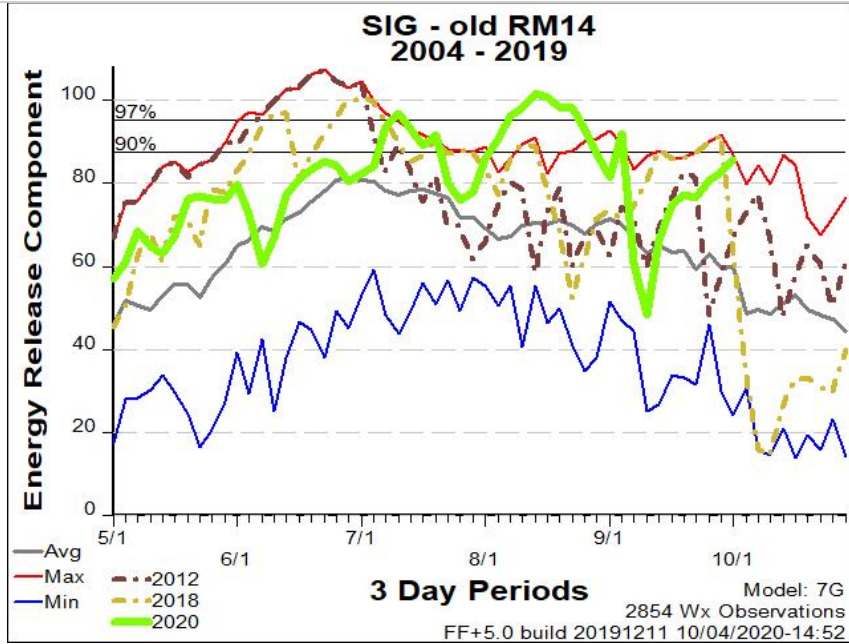
## North Zone RM10
