



# 2016 FTC ANNUAL REPORT

**The first recorded fire of 2016 was an abandoned campfire in Rocky Mountain NP. Human caused starts continue to be the typical early season fire occurrences.**

**In middle February a 1,773 ac. Fire was reported in Weld County and by the end of February we had 5 fires on the Grasslands, 2 of which had exceeded 100 acres.**

**The first lightning fire was reported on May 30<sup>th</sup> on the CLRD for .1 ac.**

**On July 9<sup>th</sup> the Cold Springs fire started on private land in Boulder County and due to high winds burned 606 acres of FS and private mix and destroyed several homes.**

**A RMA T2IMT (Black Team) was assigned for 5 days.**

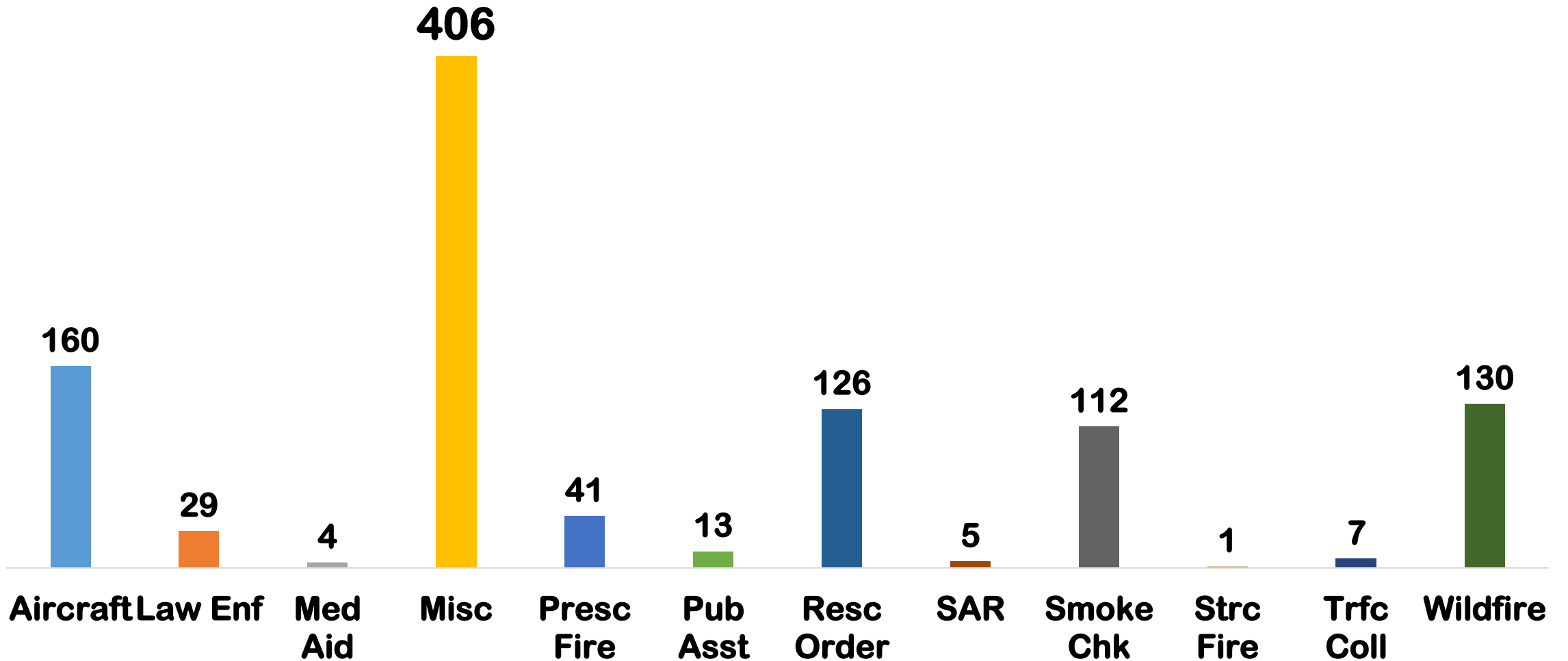
**FTC went into a PL2 at that time and remained there until late Sept.**

**On Sept. 4<sup>th</sup> the Starwood fire was ignited by lightning, also on private land, and burned a total of 301 acres, and was managed by a local Type 3 organization.**

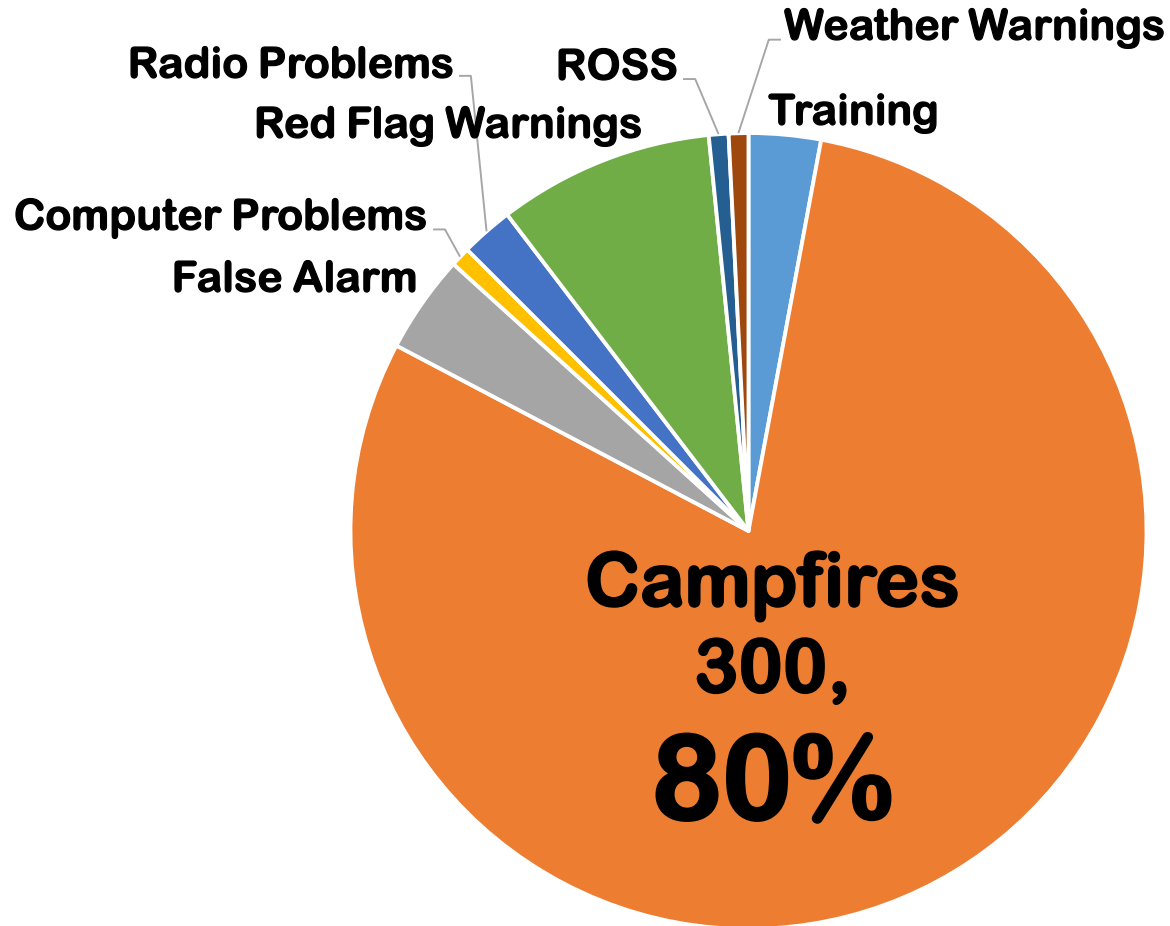
**FTC continued to provide support all summer and fall to the regional and national FF effort.**

**The last fire of the year was reported on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of December, when a tree fell onto a powerline due to high winds and burned 7 ac. Of FS land.**

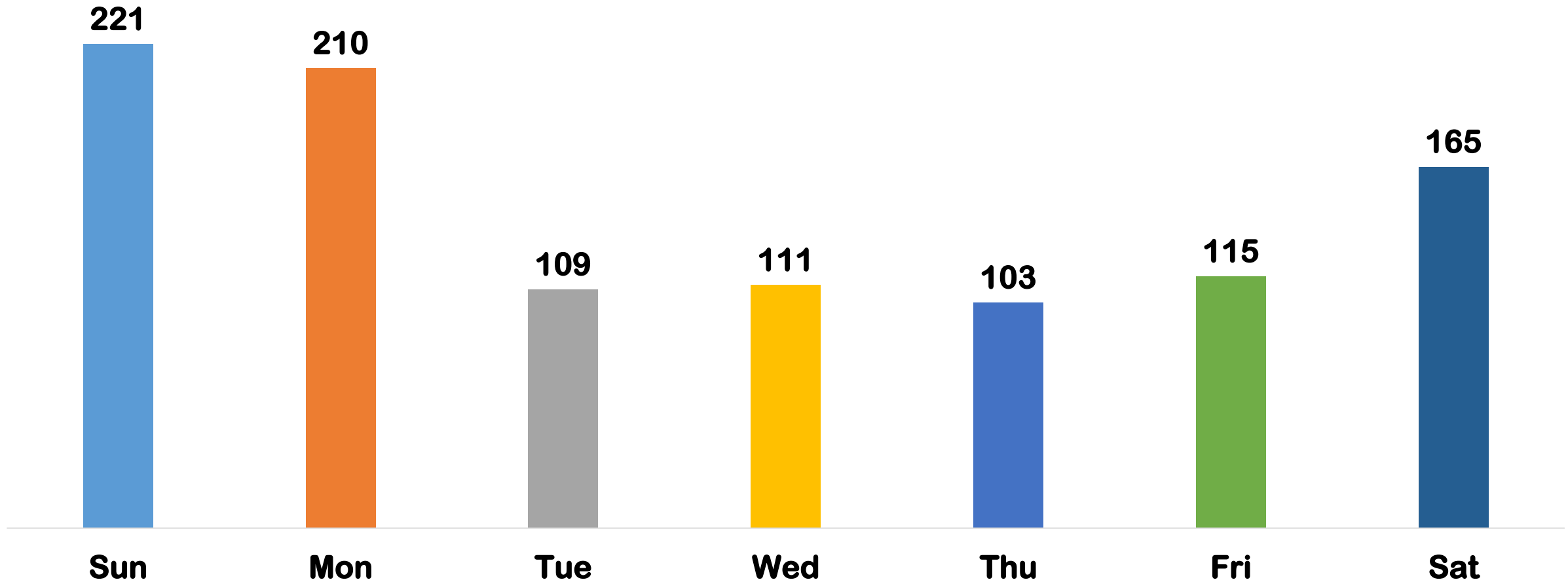
# # of All Incidents by Type



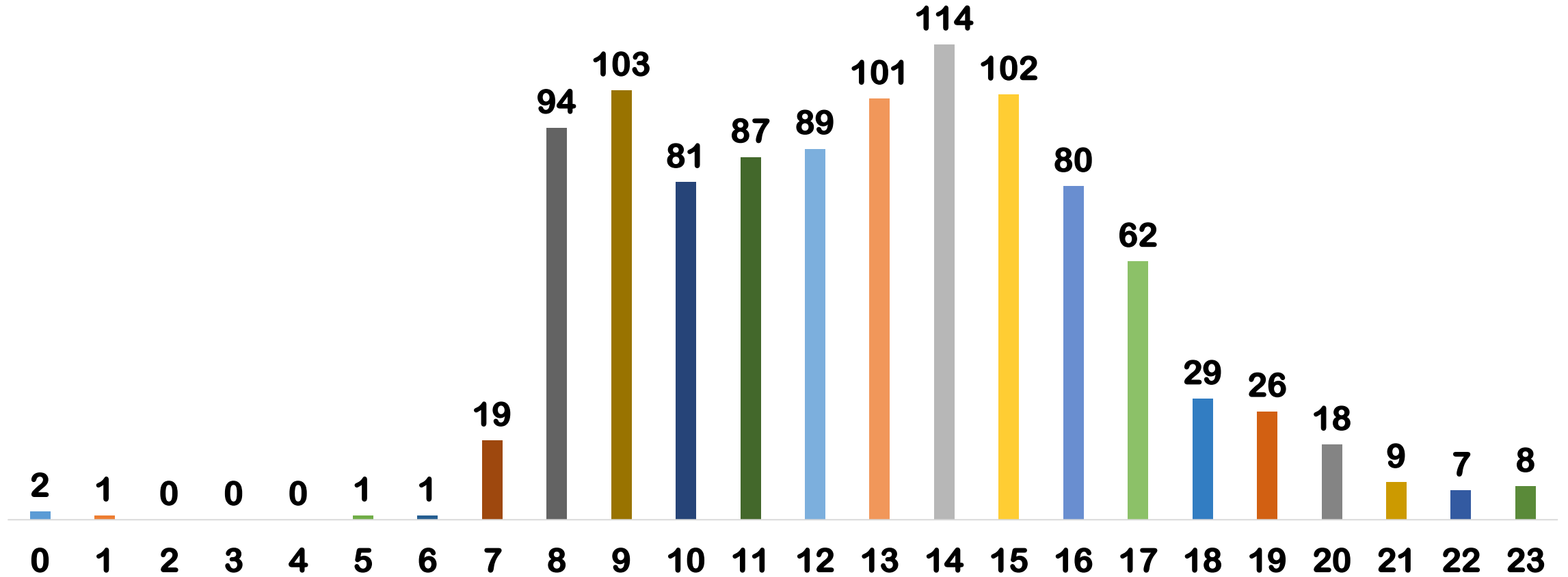
# Miscellaneous Incident Breakdown



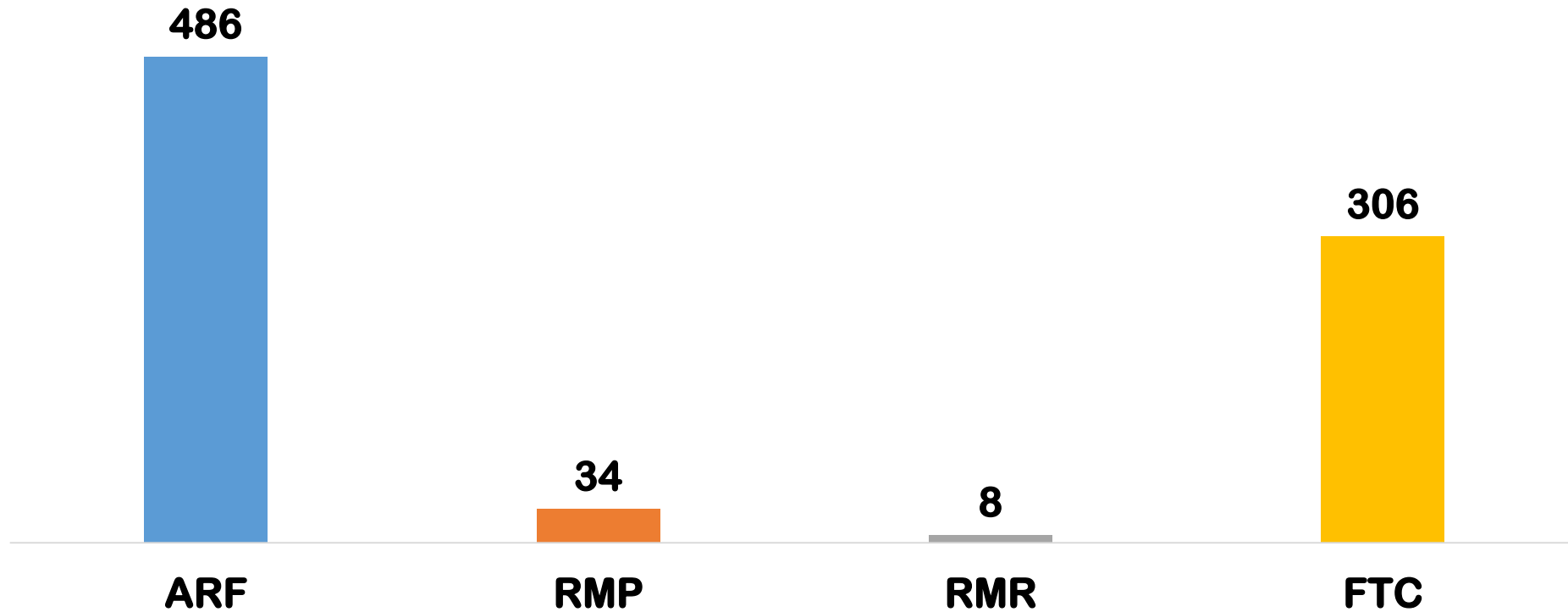
# # of All Incidents by Day of Week

# Total # of Incidents by Federal Agency



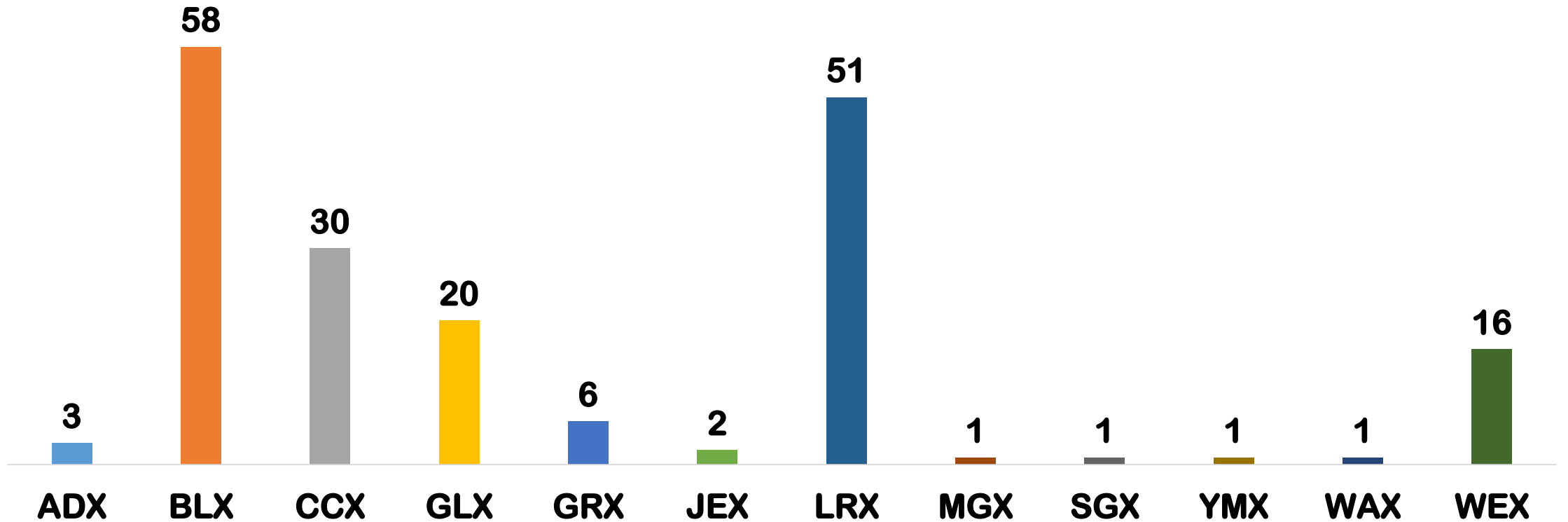

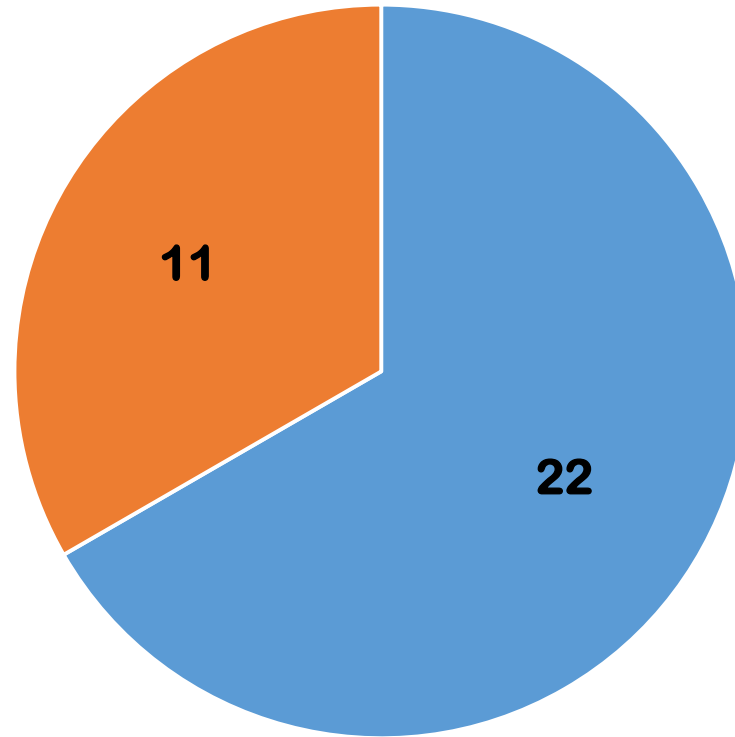

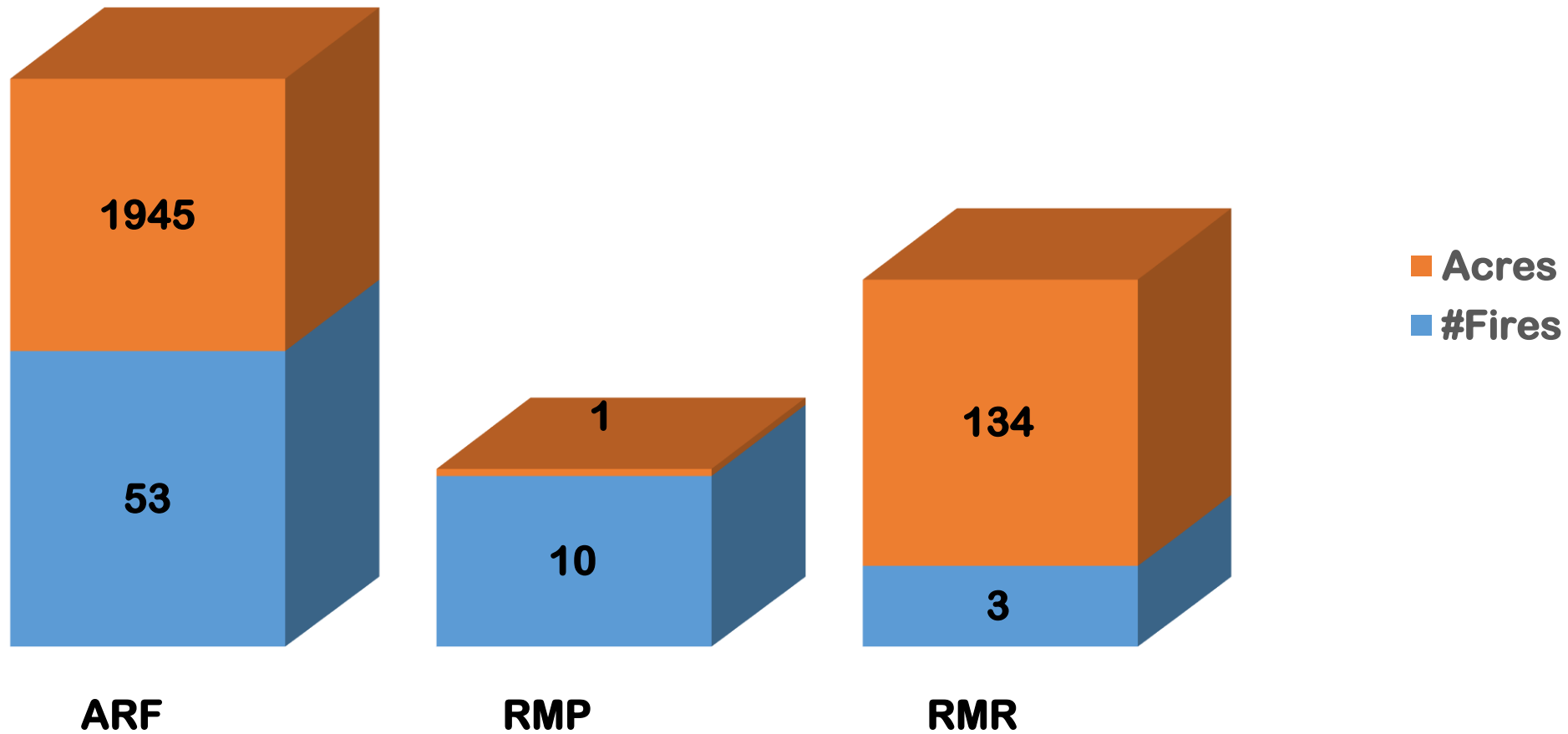

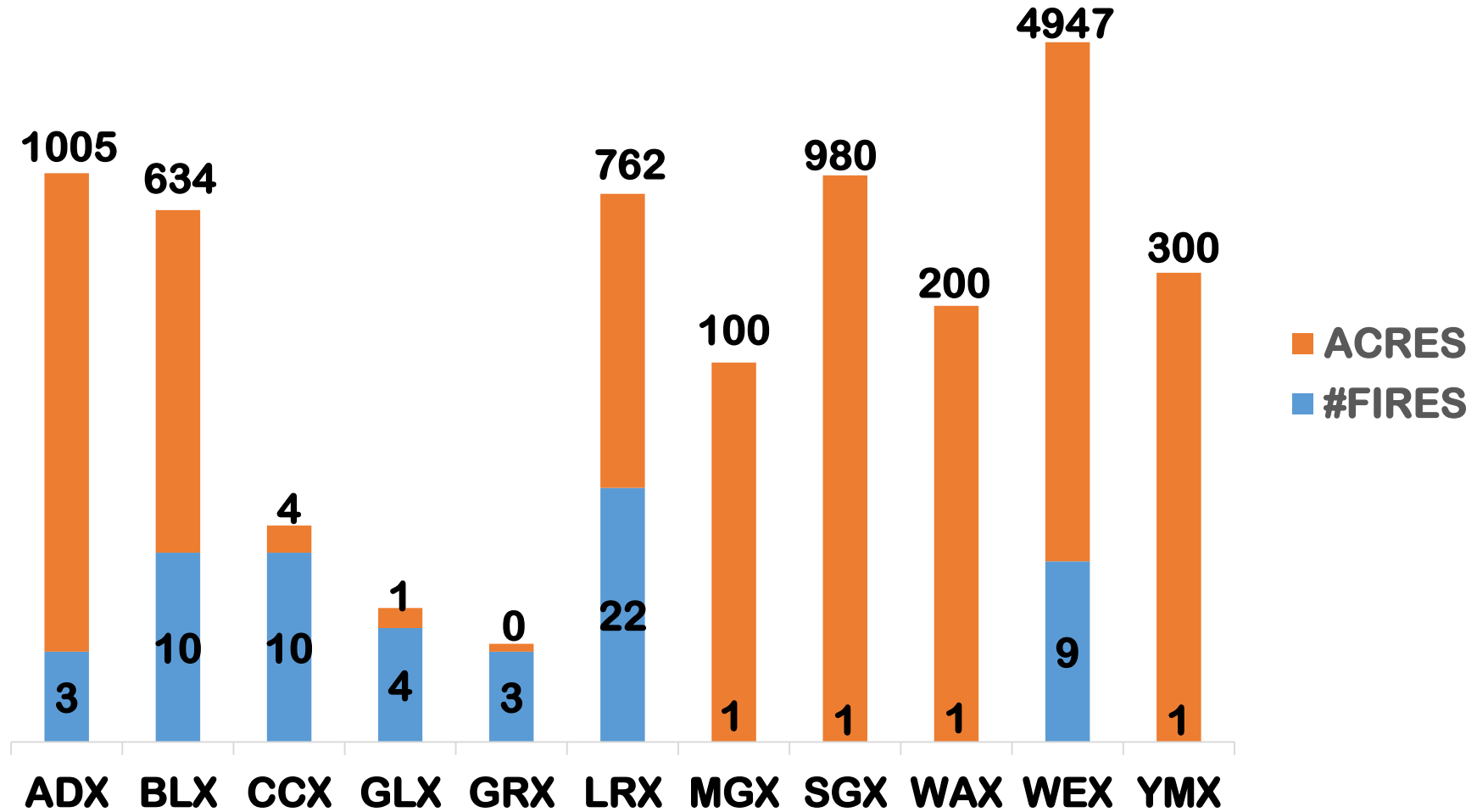

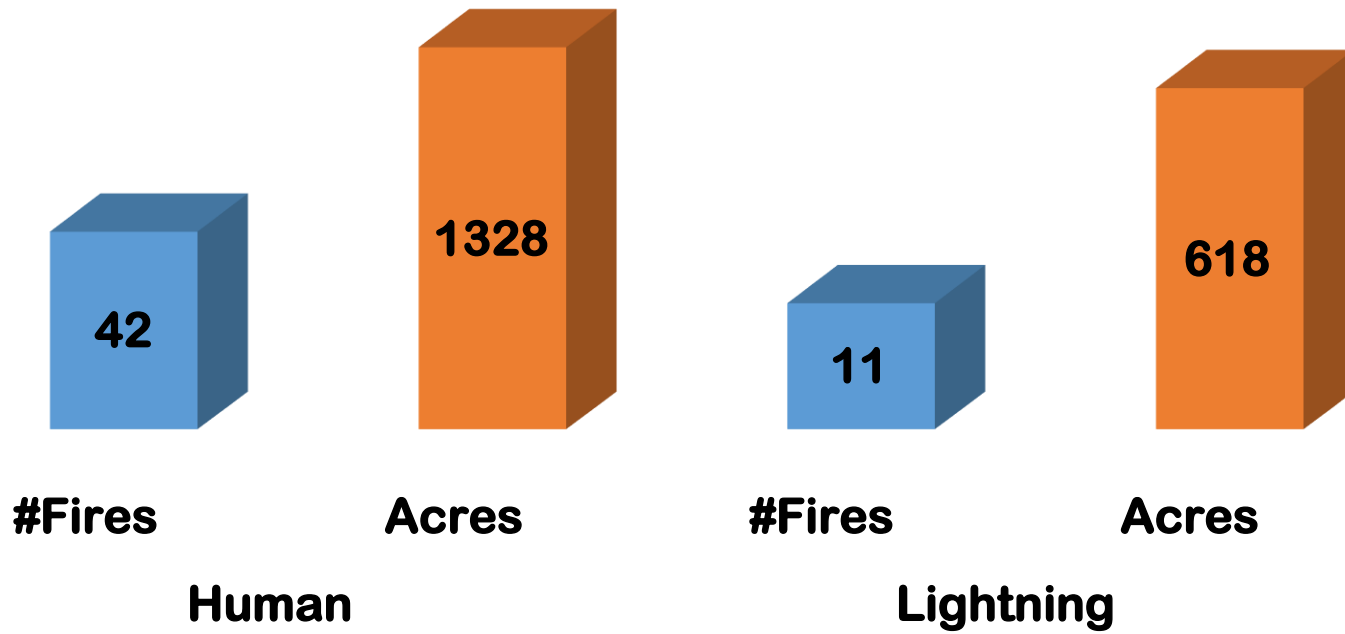
# # of Fires / Acres by Federal Agency



# # of Fires / Acres by County

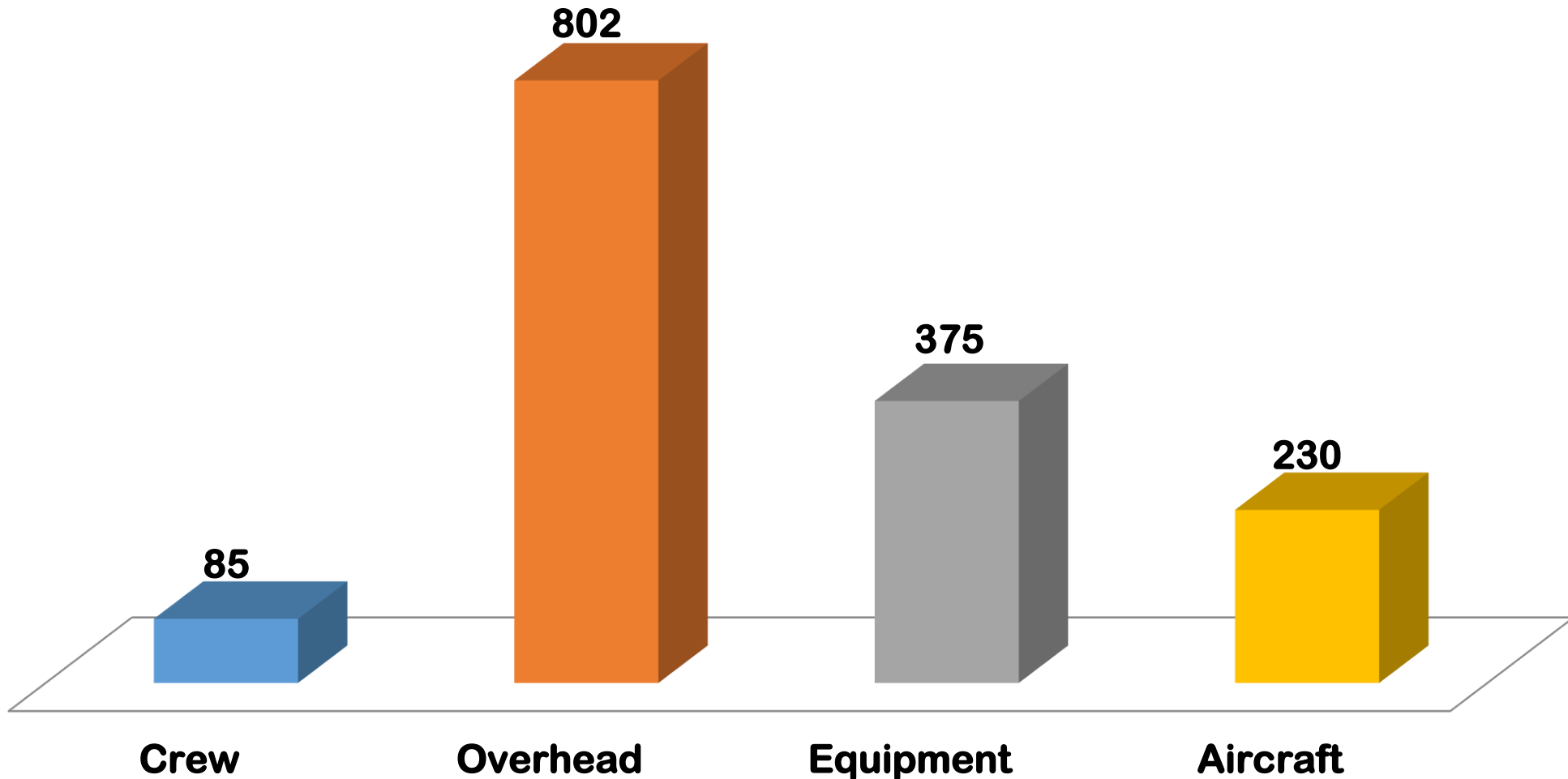


# ARF Fires / Acres by Cause



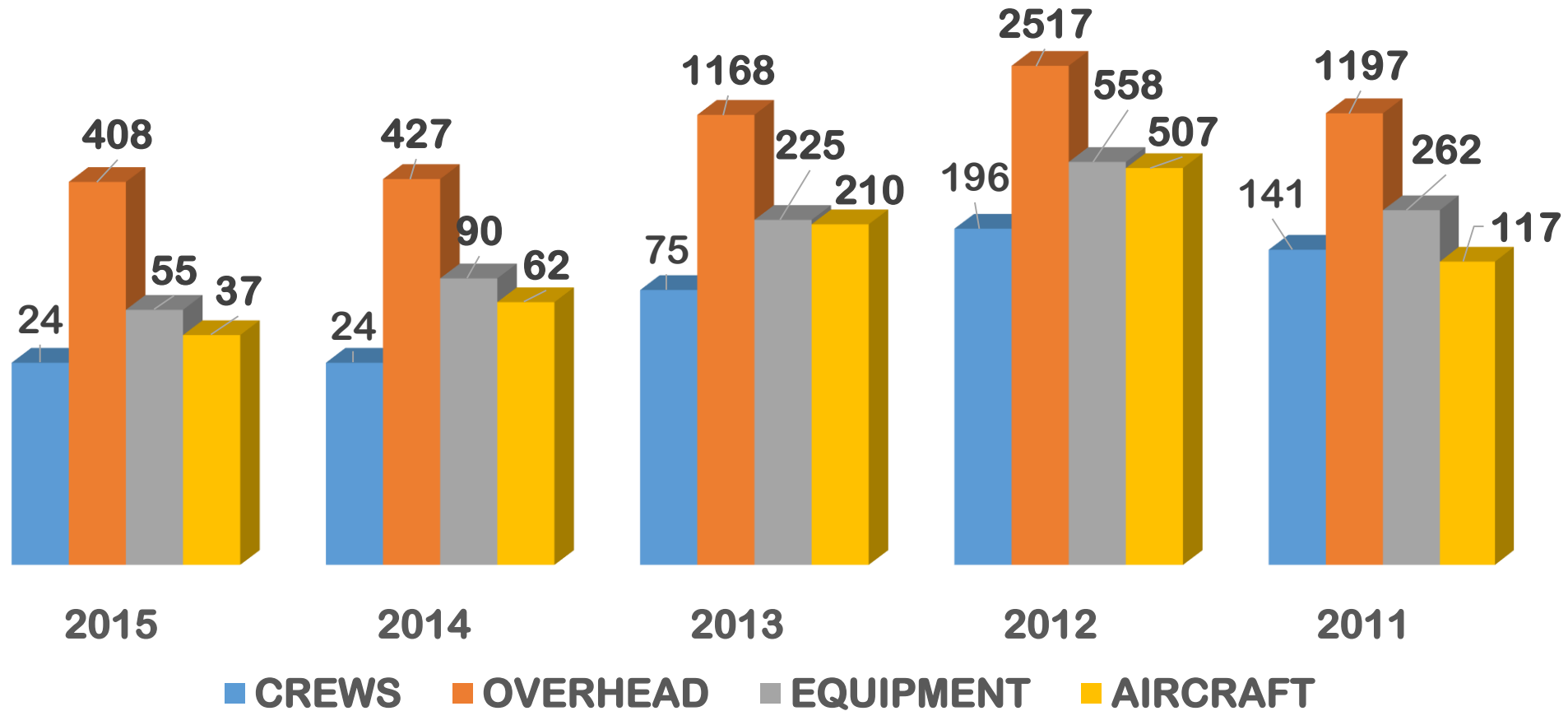

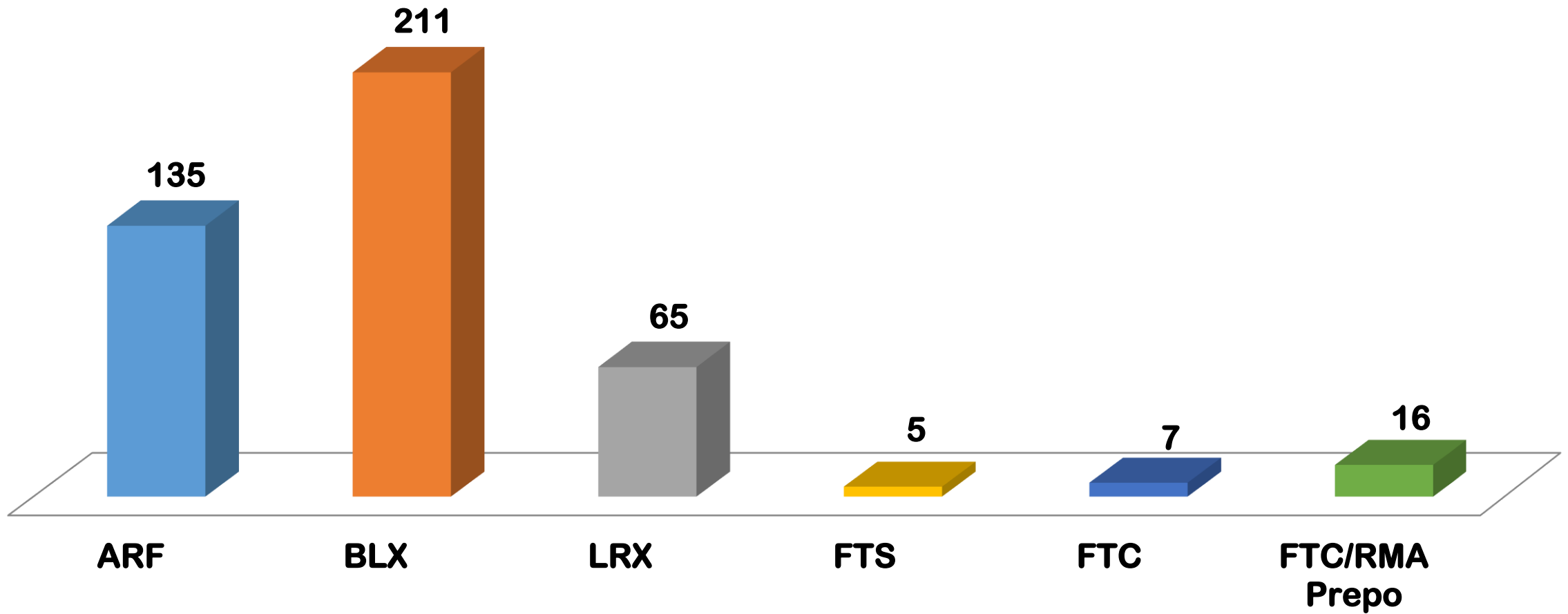

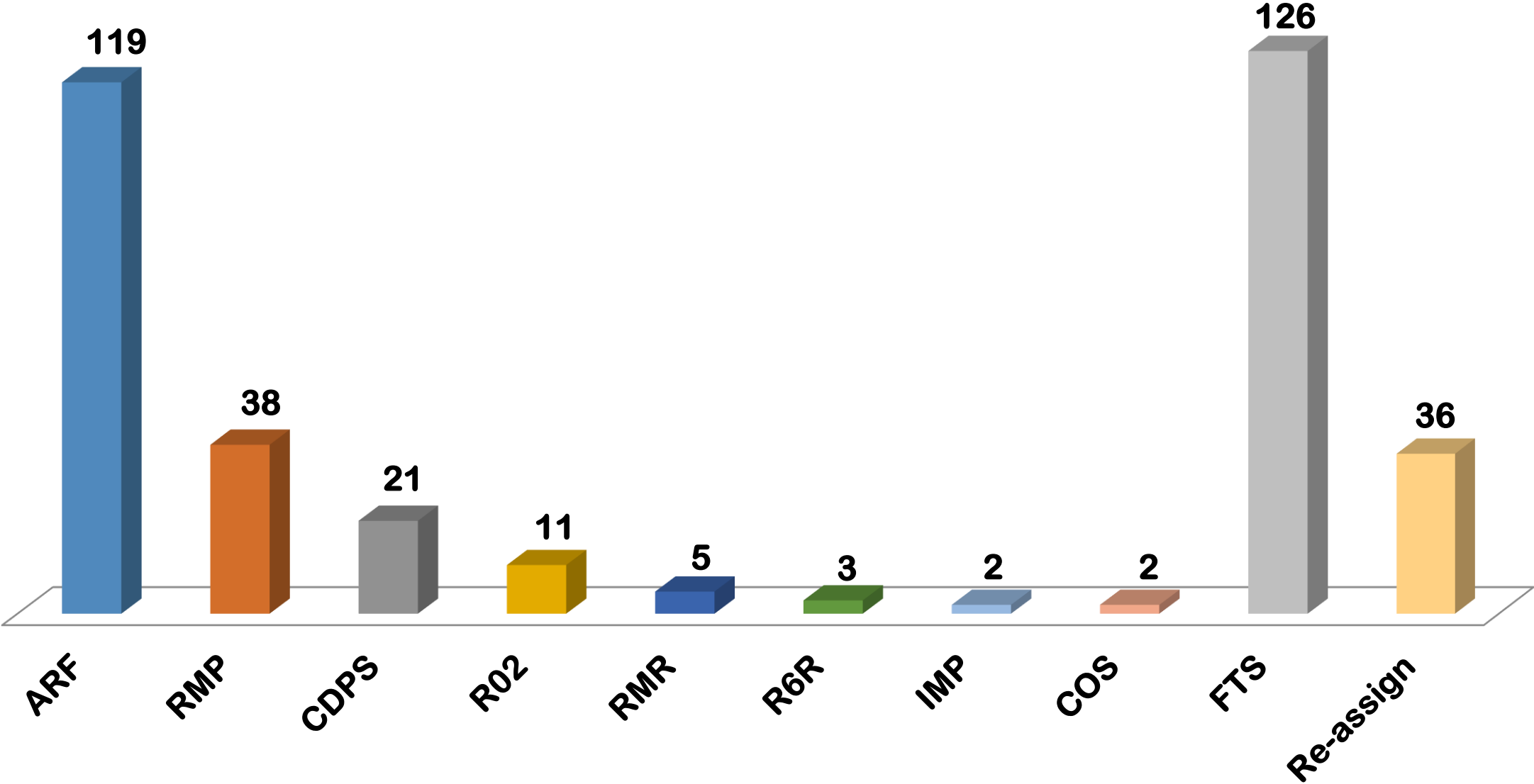




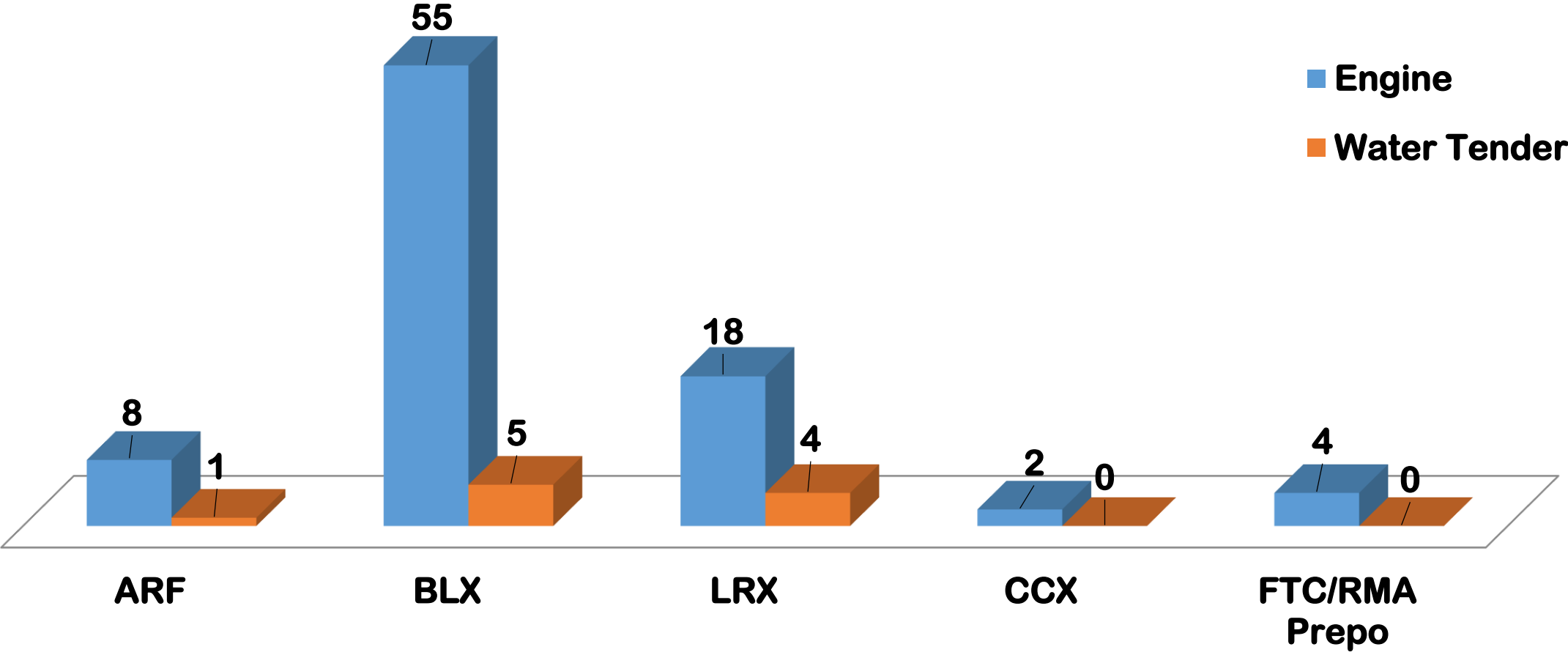
# Overhead Requests in Zone by Agency



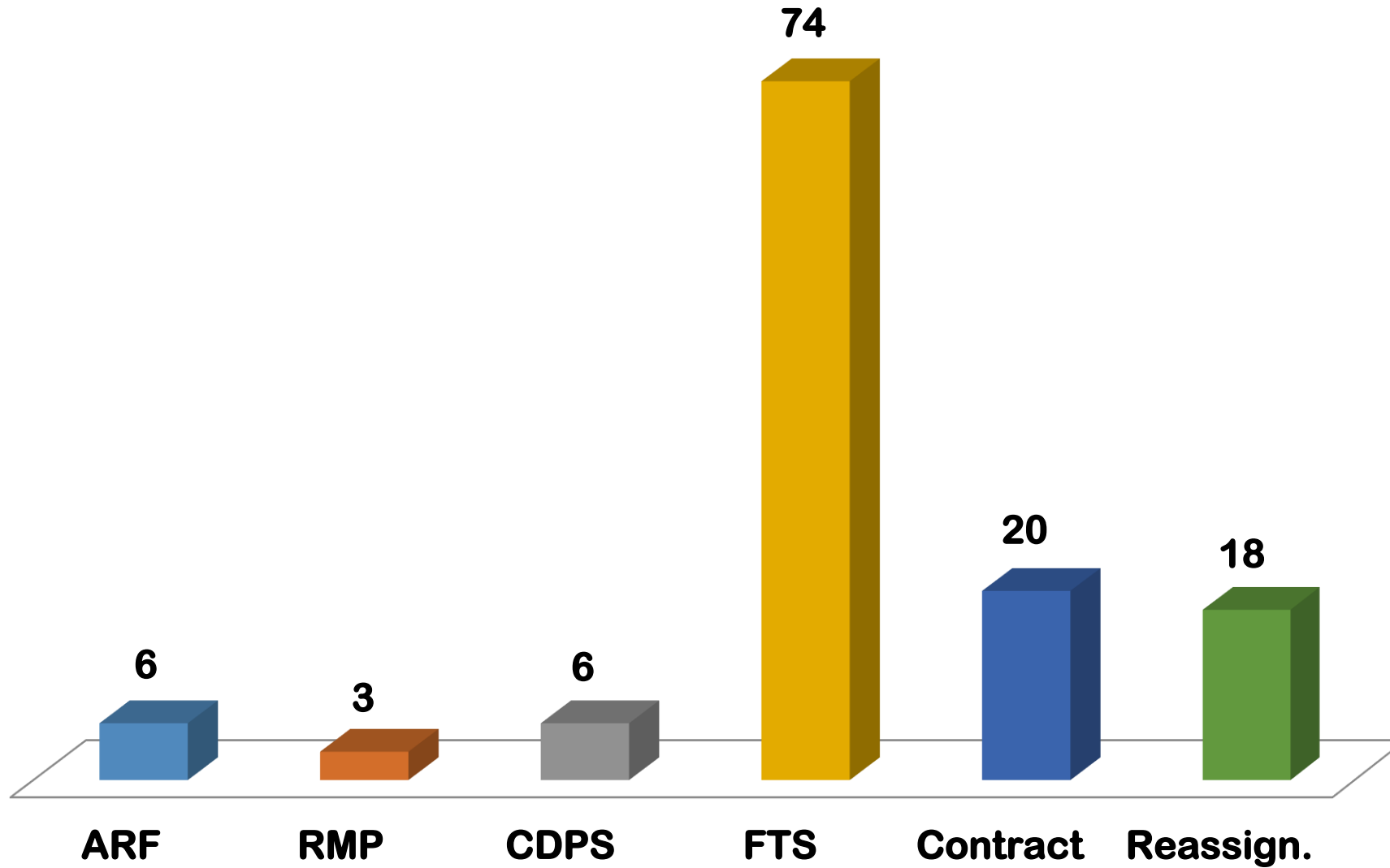
# Overhead Requests Out of Zone by Agency



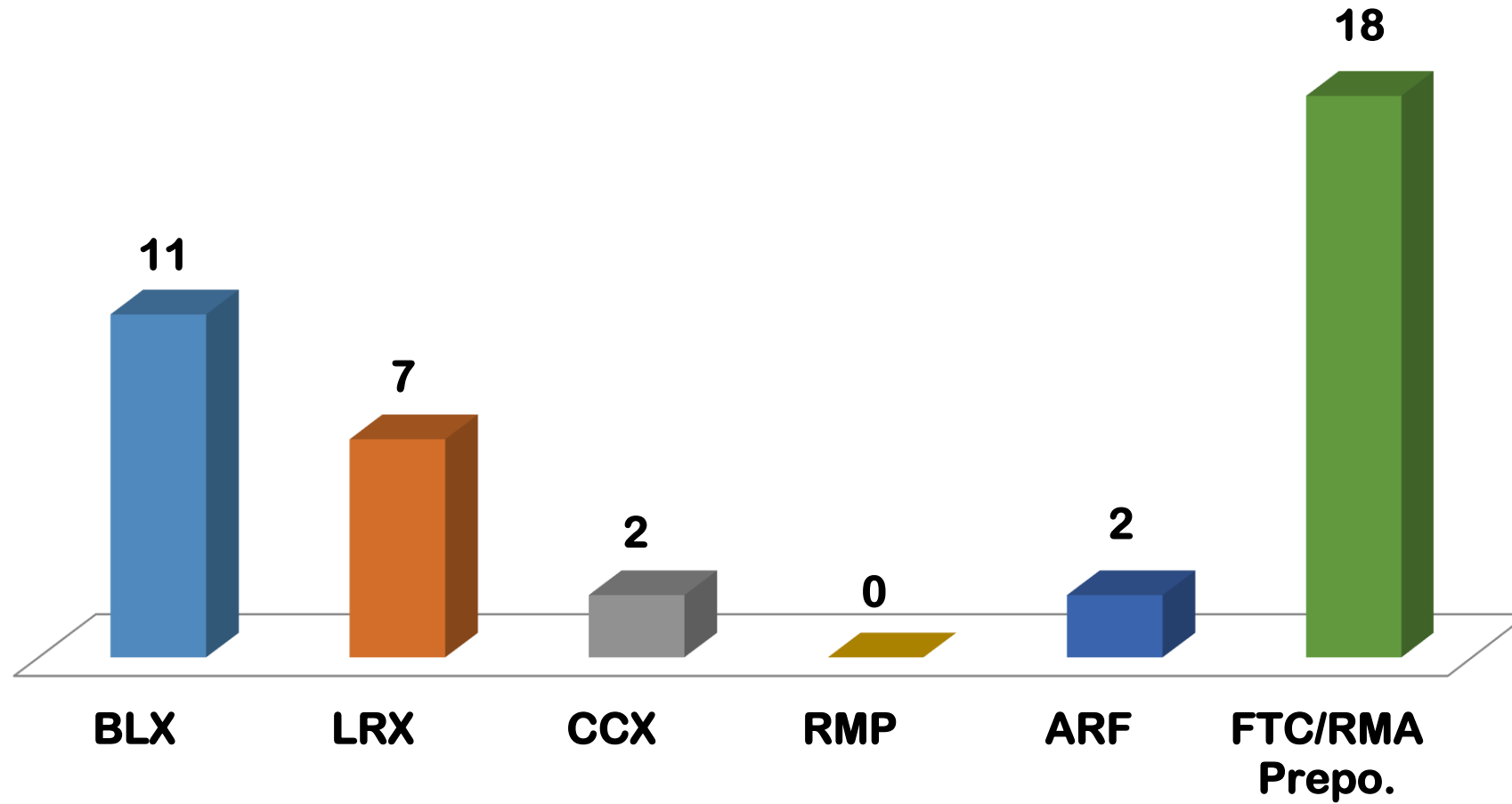
# Engine / WT Requests in Zone by Agency



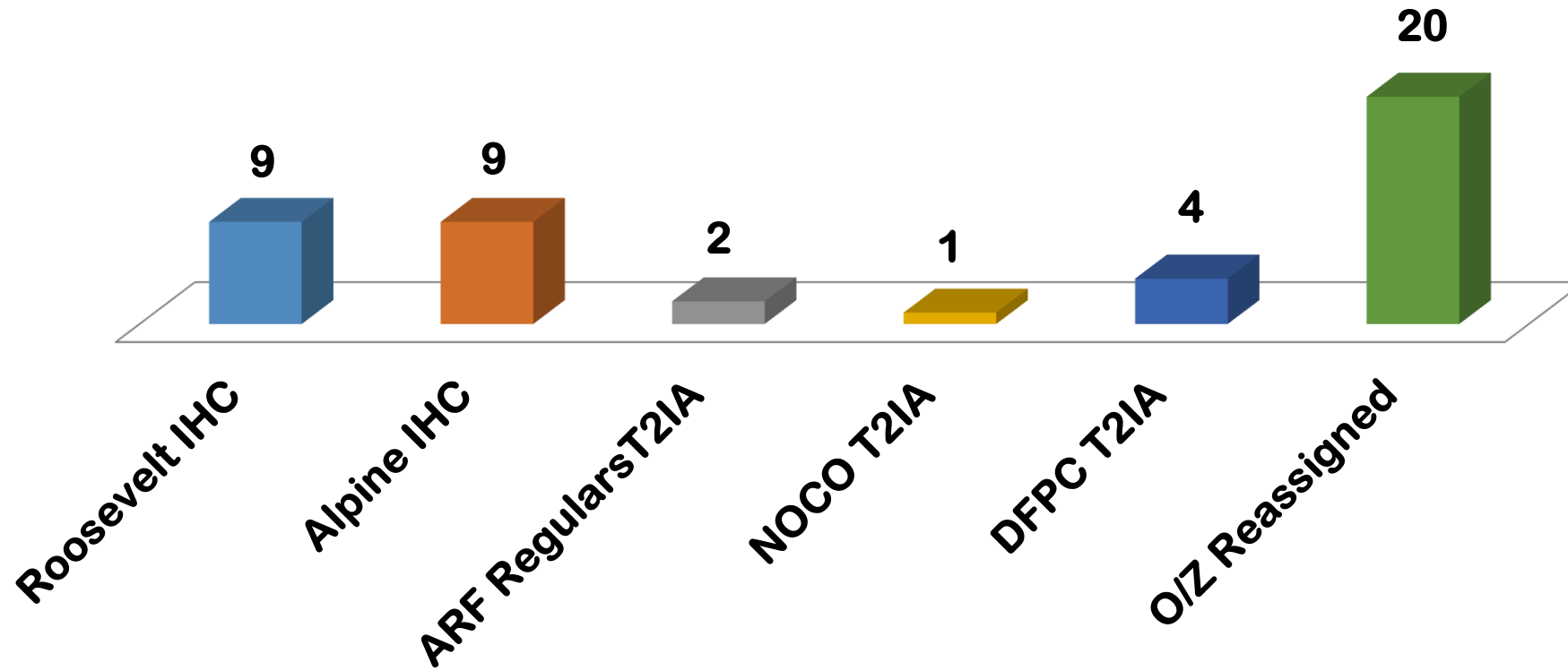
# Engine / WT Requests Out of Zone by Agency



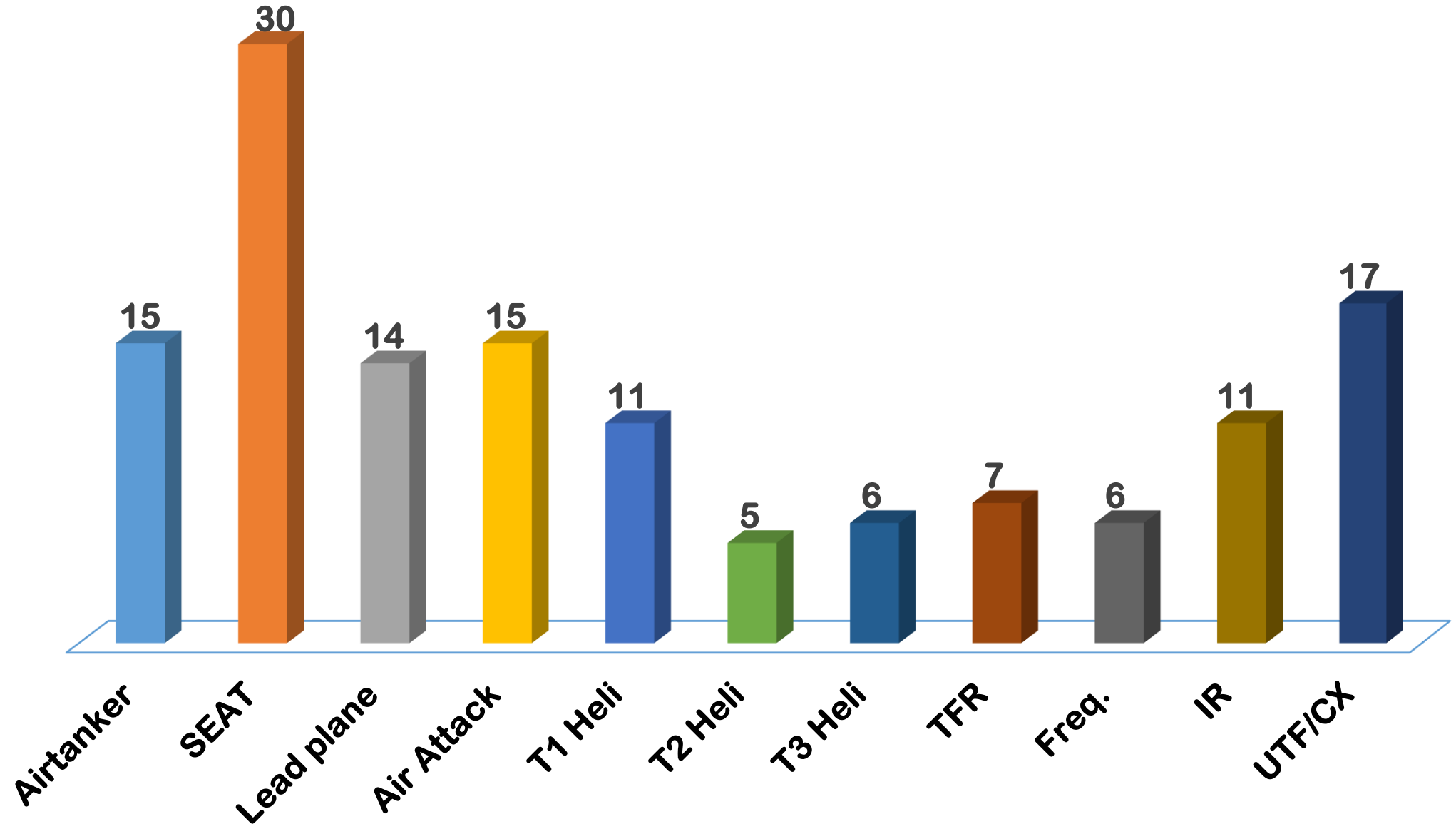
# Crew Requests in Zone by Agency



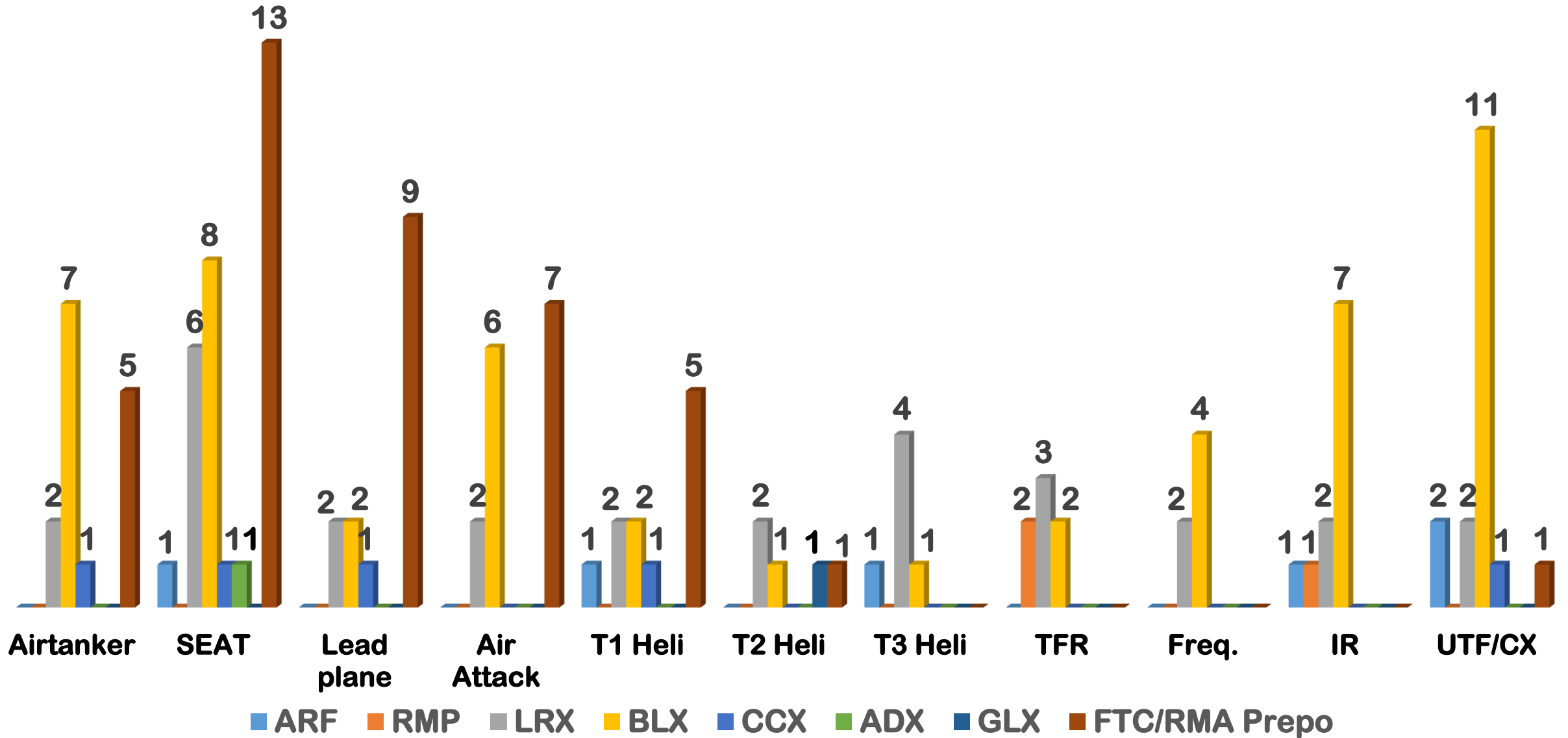

# Aircraft Requests in Zone 2016 by Type

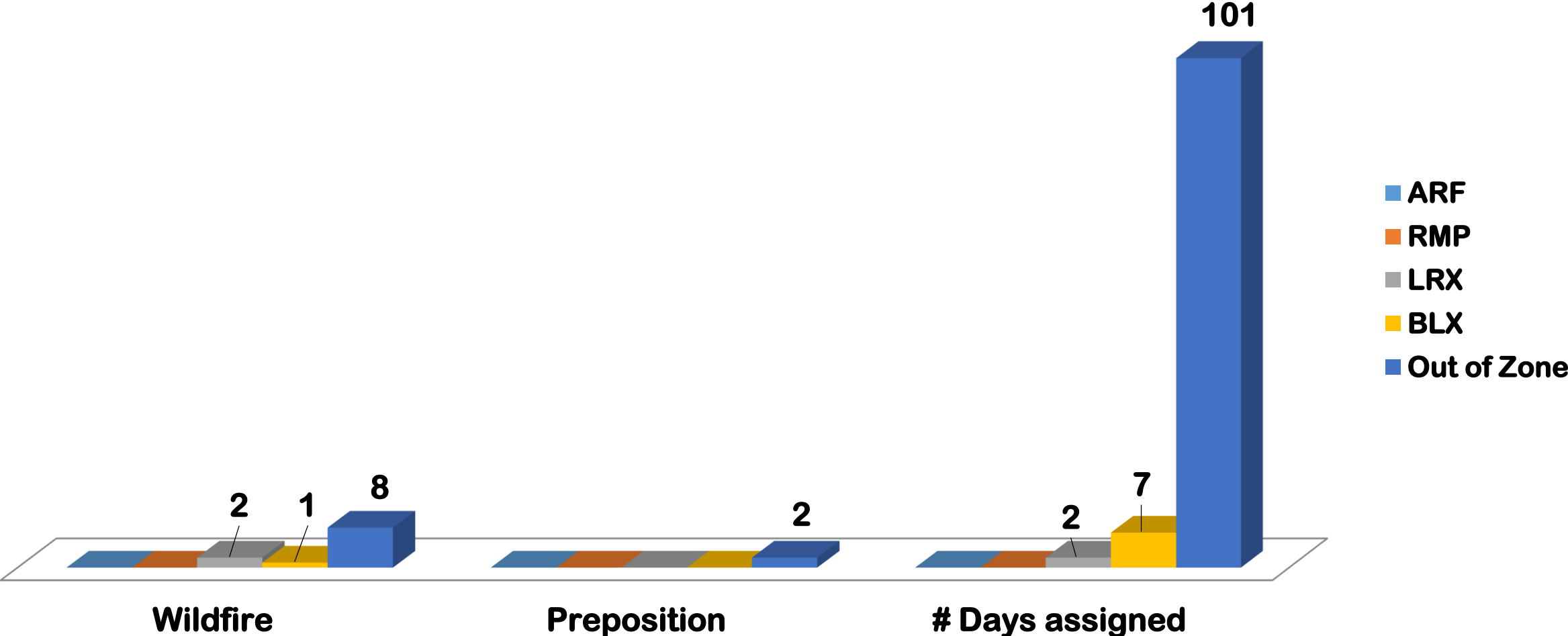


# Aircraft Requests in Zone 2016 by Agency



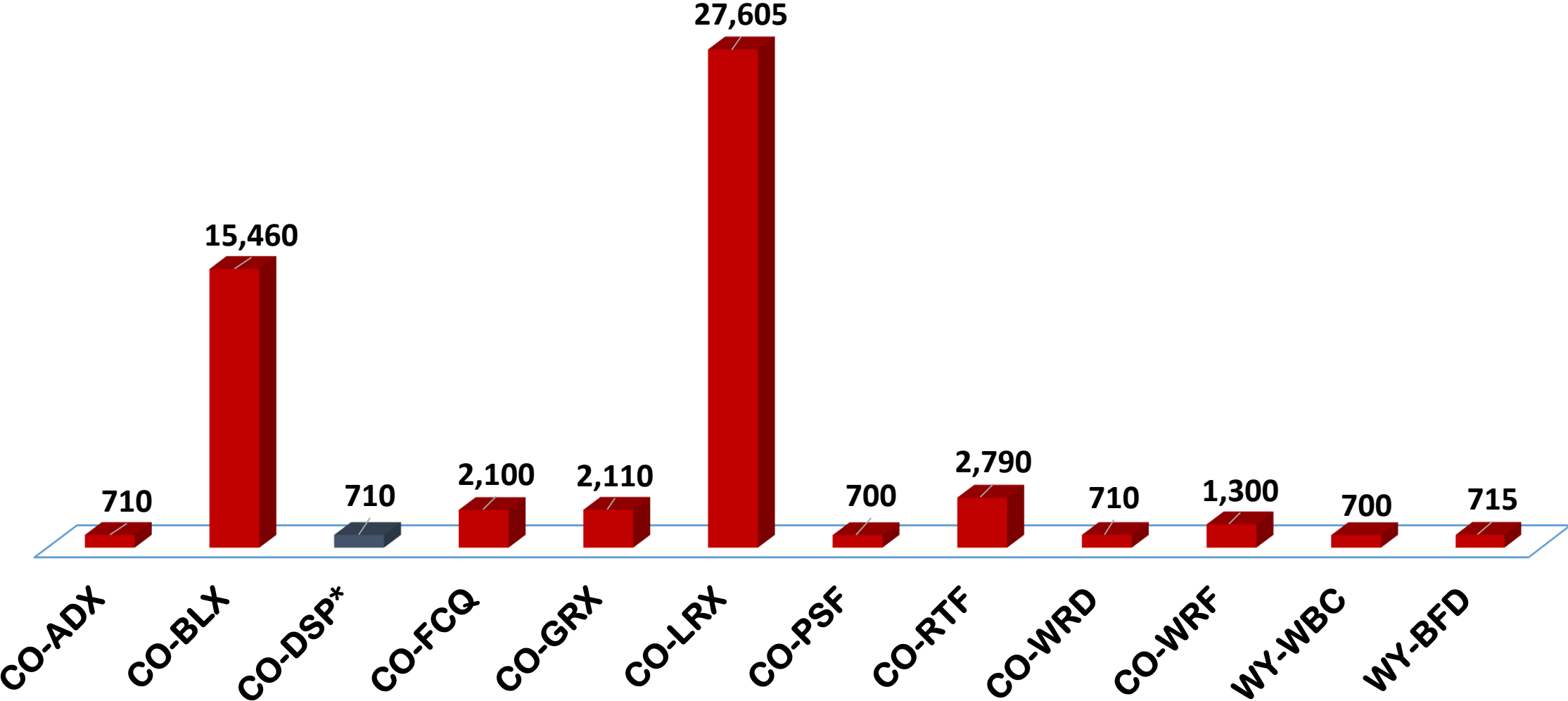


# Helicopter 9AC Use
