Due to Extreme Fire Danger
Fire Prevention Order # GJ-18-01

Due to high fire hazard conditions, pursuant to the Code of Federal Regulations, the following acts are prohibited on Bureau of Land Management lands within the Grand Junction Field Office:

1. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, coal or wood burning stove, any type of charcoal fueled broiler or open fire of any type in undeveloped areas. Fires within the provided fire grates in developed campgrounds are excluded. Stoves fueled by liquid petroleum or gas are also excluded.
2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building or in a developed recreation site or while stopped in an area at least 3 feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable vegetation.
3. Using explosive material: (ie: blasting caps, exploding targets, tracer rounds or any incendiary device which may result in the ignition of flammable material.)
4. Possessing, discharging, or using any kind of firework or other pyrotechnic device, to include sparklers. Using explosive material: (ie: blasting caps or any incendiary device which may result in the ignition of flammable material.)
5. Welding, or operating acetylene or other torches with open flame, except within an area that is barren or cleared of all flammable materials at least ten feet on all sides from equipment.
6. Operating or using any internal combustion engine without a spark arresting device properly installed, maintained and in effective working order meeting either:
 - a. Department of Agriculture, Forest Service Standard 5100-1a; or
 - b. Appropriate Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE) recommended practice J335 (b) and J350 (a).

The following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit or letter of authorization specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This order becomes effective at 12:01 a.m., June 8, 2018 and will remain in force until rescinded.

Due to Extreme Fire Danger
Fire Prevention Order # GJ-18-02

This order supersedes all previous orders involving fire restrictions in Grand Junction Field Office. Due to continuing high to extreme fire hazard conditions, pursuant to the Code of Federal Regulations, the following acts are prohibited on all public lands managed by the Bureau of Land Management – Grand Junction Field Office in Garfield County Colorado:

1. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, coal or wood burning stove, any type of charcoal fueled broiler or open fire of any type in all areas. This includes all camping and picnic grounds.
Exceptions: Devices using pressurized liquid or gas.
2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle, building, trailer or tent.
3. Using an explosive or pyrotechnic device including: fire crackers, sparklers, fireworks, blasting caps, rockets or any incendiary device which may result in the ignition of flammable material.
4. Exploding targets and tracers or incendiary ammunition.
5. Welding, or operating an acetylene or other torch with open flame.
Exceptions: Those with a current permit, contract or letter of authorization that allows welding.
6. Operating or using any internal combustion engine without a spark arresting device properly installed, maintained and in effective working order meeting either:
 - a. Department of Agriculture, Forest Service Standard 5100-1a; or
 - b. Appropriate Society of Automotive Engineers (SAE) recommended practice J335(b) and J350 (a).
7. Operating a chainsaw without an approved spark arrester and without a chemical pressurized fire extinguisher of not less than 8 ounces capacity by weight, and without one "O" or larger round point shovel with an overall length of at least 36 inches. The extinguisher will be with the equipment operator. The shovel may be kept with fueling supplies but readily available for use. Five gallons of water is required to be onsite.

The following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit or letter of authorization specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This order becomes effective at 12:01 a.m. June 29, 2018 and will remain in force until rescinded.
