Directions: 2014 Montrose Area Annual Incident Assignments / Experience Form

- **List all positions performed on the incident. There must be separate dates listed for each job.**
- **Only list those positions that are listed on your Red Card.**
- **Be sure that incidents with related Task Book evaluations are listed on this form!**
- **When you receive a Task Book evaluation during the fire season, send it to dispatch and we will enter it into IQCS. It keeps your Task Books current.**
- **You are only qualified for a position if you have received your certified Task Book from the FQRC Committee, not when you received a Final Evaluation.**
- **Send in copies of all training certificates and Sawyer Cards as you take the course! No certificate....No credit!**
- **An Incident Number is not a Fire Code or P Code!**
 - Incident Number – CO-GMF-001 **(Use This!)**
 - P Code/ Fire Code – P2EKU0 / EKU0 **(Not This!)**
- **The IQCS numbers for most incidents can be found on the Montrose Interagency Dispatch Web Page.**

 - **WILDWEB**
 - **Incidents By Month**
 - **Month**
 - **IQCS Number is in the far right “comments” column**
 - **The Incident number is in the second column “Inc #”**

- **Do not wait until next year to complete the Experience Form. Wild Cad information is circulated and will only show the current 12 months data.**
- **If the IQCS number is not in the comments column than use the incident number on the ROSS order you were given when dispatched.**
