

**FORT COLLINS INTERAGENCY DISPATCH CENTER
2015 ANNUAL REPORT**



The unseasonably dry and warm winter of 2015 in Northern Colorado finally gave way to a wet period that began in April and continued through May. This moisture provided much needed relief as the indices looked to be a concern towards the end of March, but by Mid-April it was clear that conditions had significantly moderated across the zone.

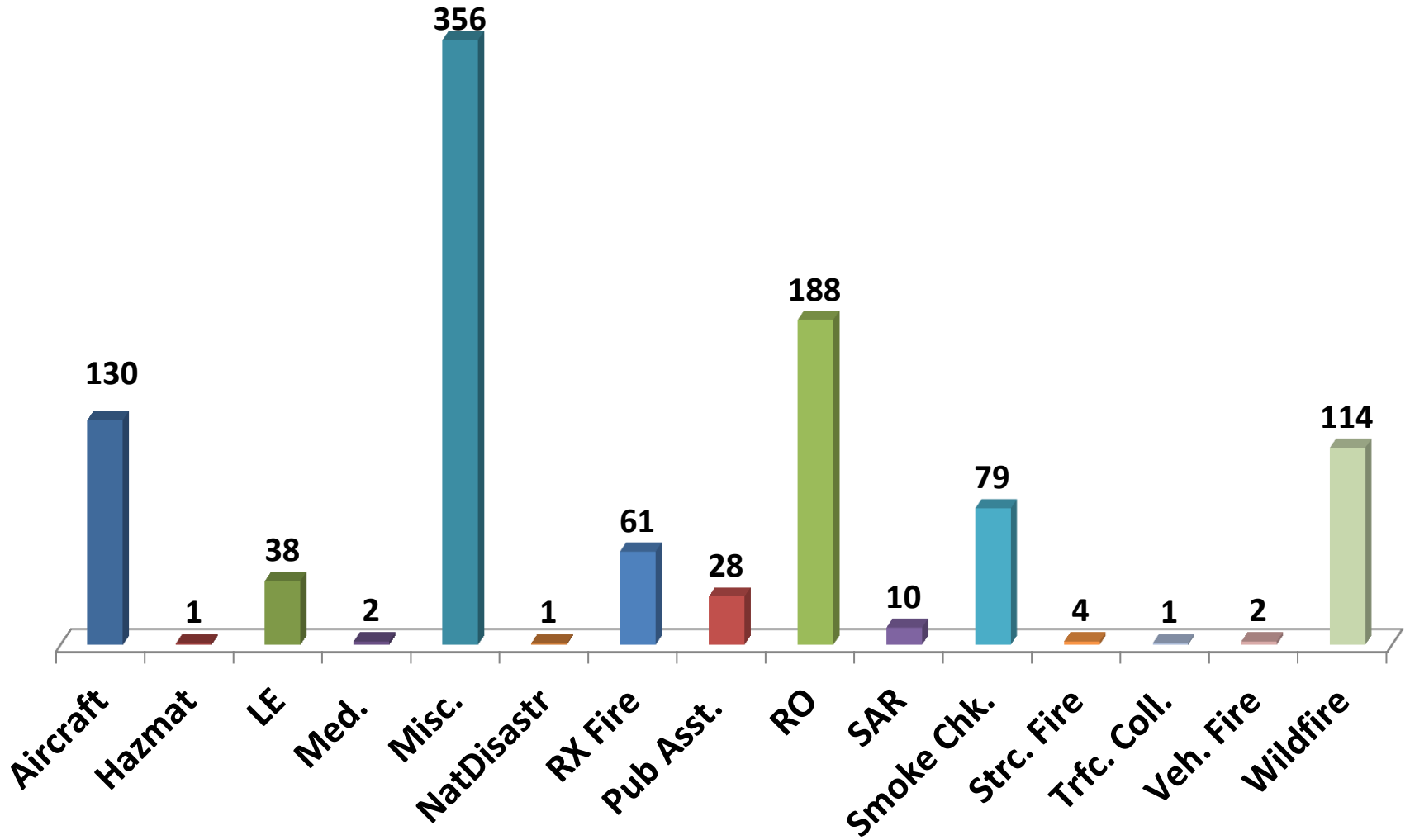
The first recorded fire in the zone was on the 18th of Jan. and by April 1st; we had 13 fires for over 500 acres across the FTC zone. The first lightning caused fire was on the West Zone of the Arapaho-Roosevelt NF, discovered on May 4; it was extinguished at .1 ac. The last fire reported for the year was on Oct. 20th, a human caused fire that was also on the West Zone of the Forest and was also extinguished at .1 ac.

Five fires in the Fort Collins Zone reached large fire reporting criteria all of which were in grass fuels; however no Interagency Incident Management teams were mobilized for in zone incidents. Nationally the Fire Preparedness Level reached 5 (highest possible) by early August and Fort Collins Dispatch was very busy supporting other geographic areas in need of resources.

With the retirement of the Forest FMO and Center Manager this past summer, FTC is looking forward to the coming year under new leadership.

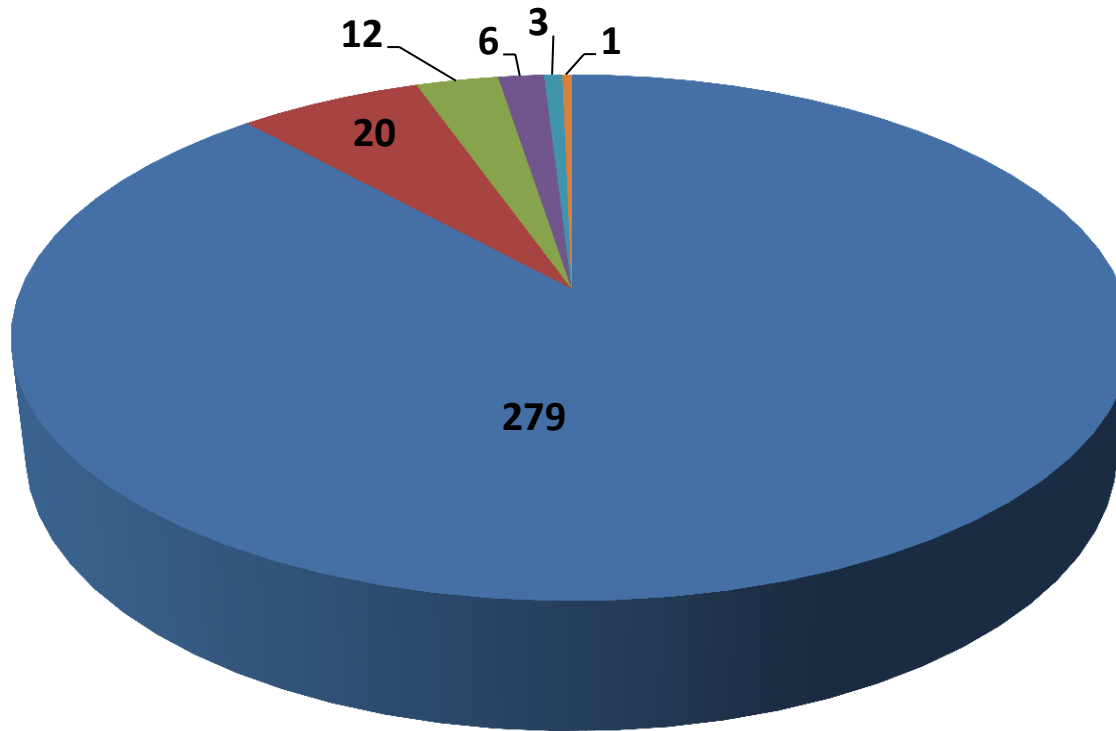
of All Incidents by Type

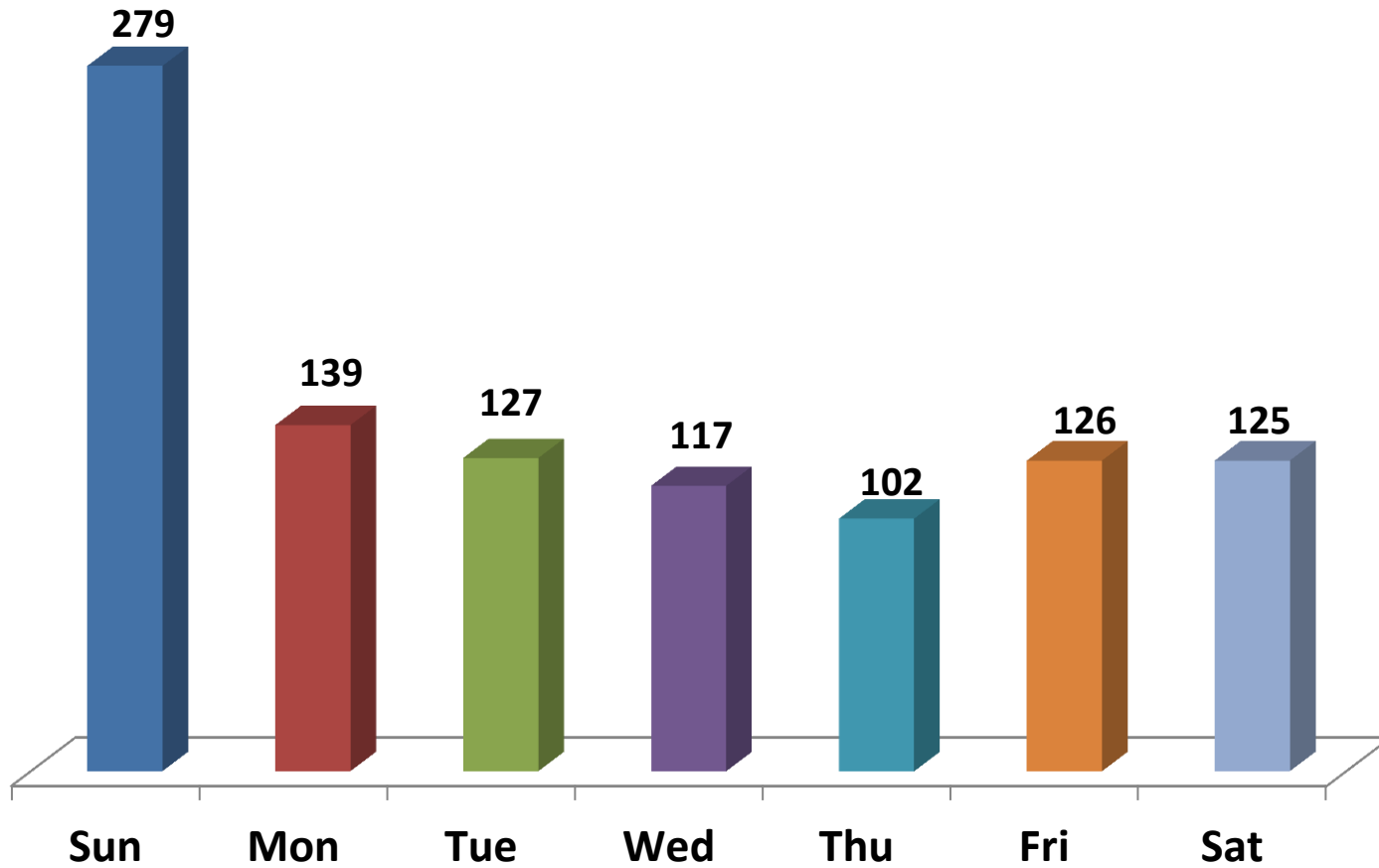
Breakdown of Miscellaneous Incidents

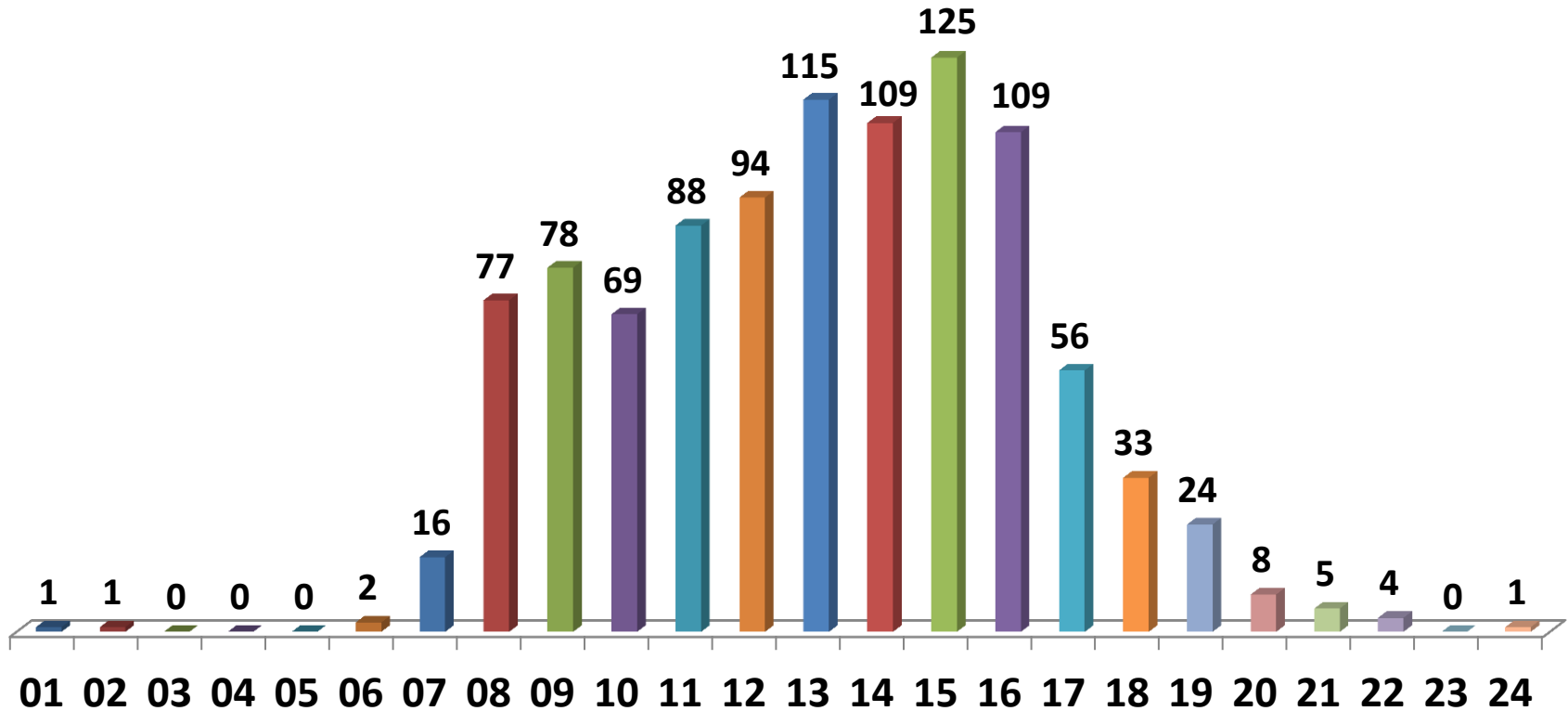

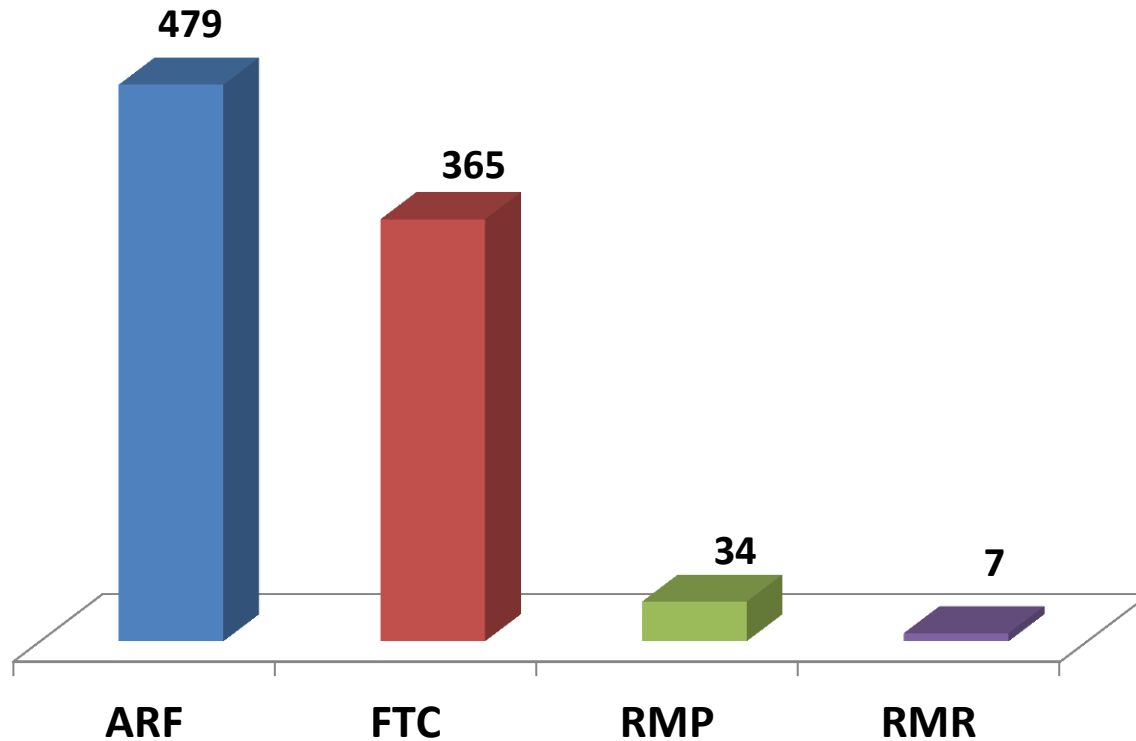
of All Incidents by Day of Week

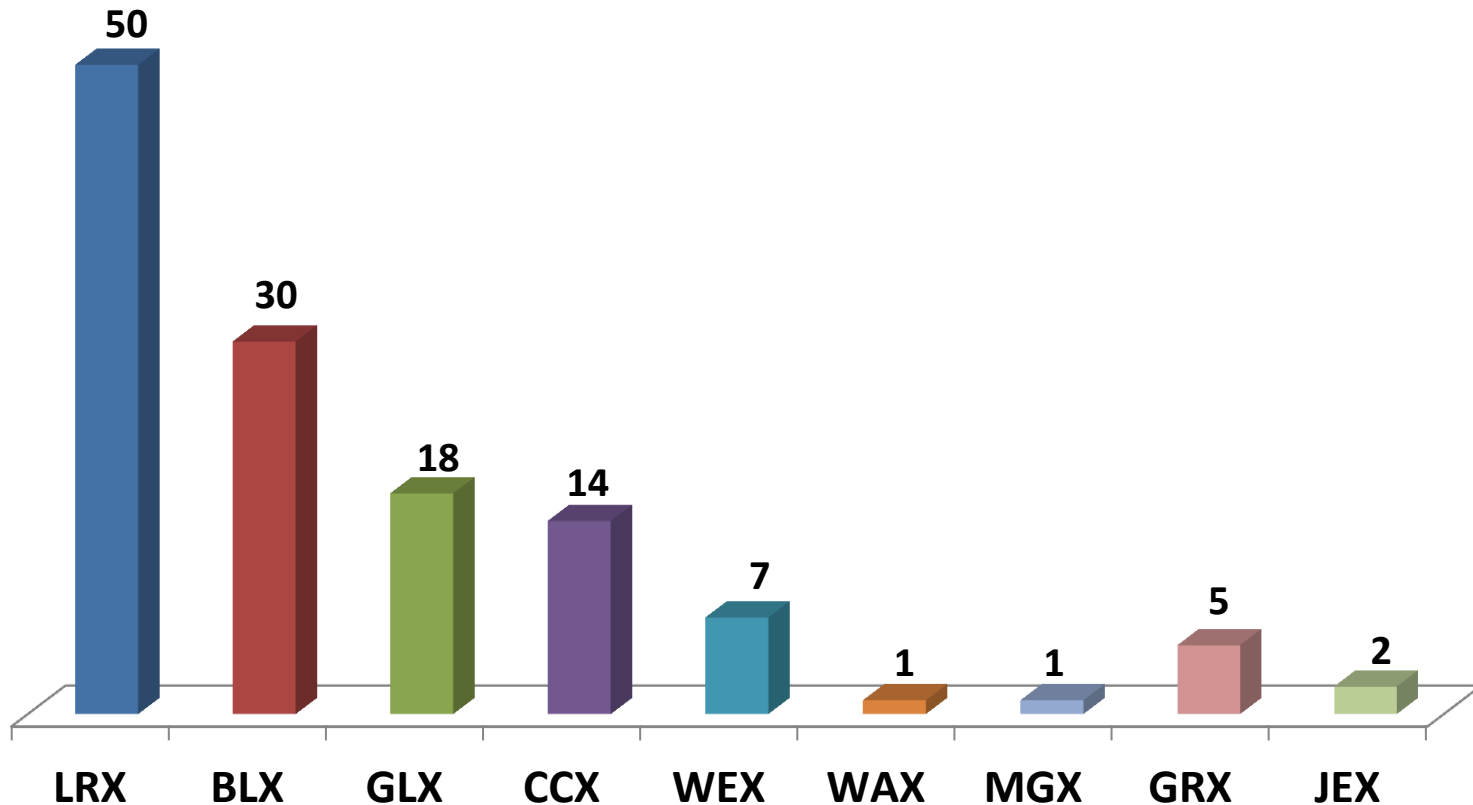

Total # of Incidents by County



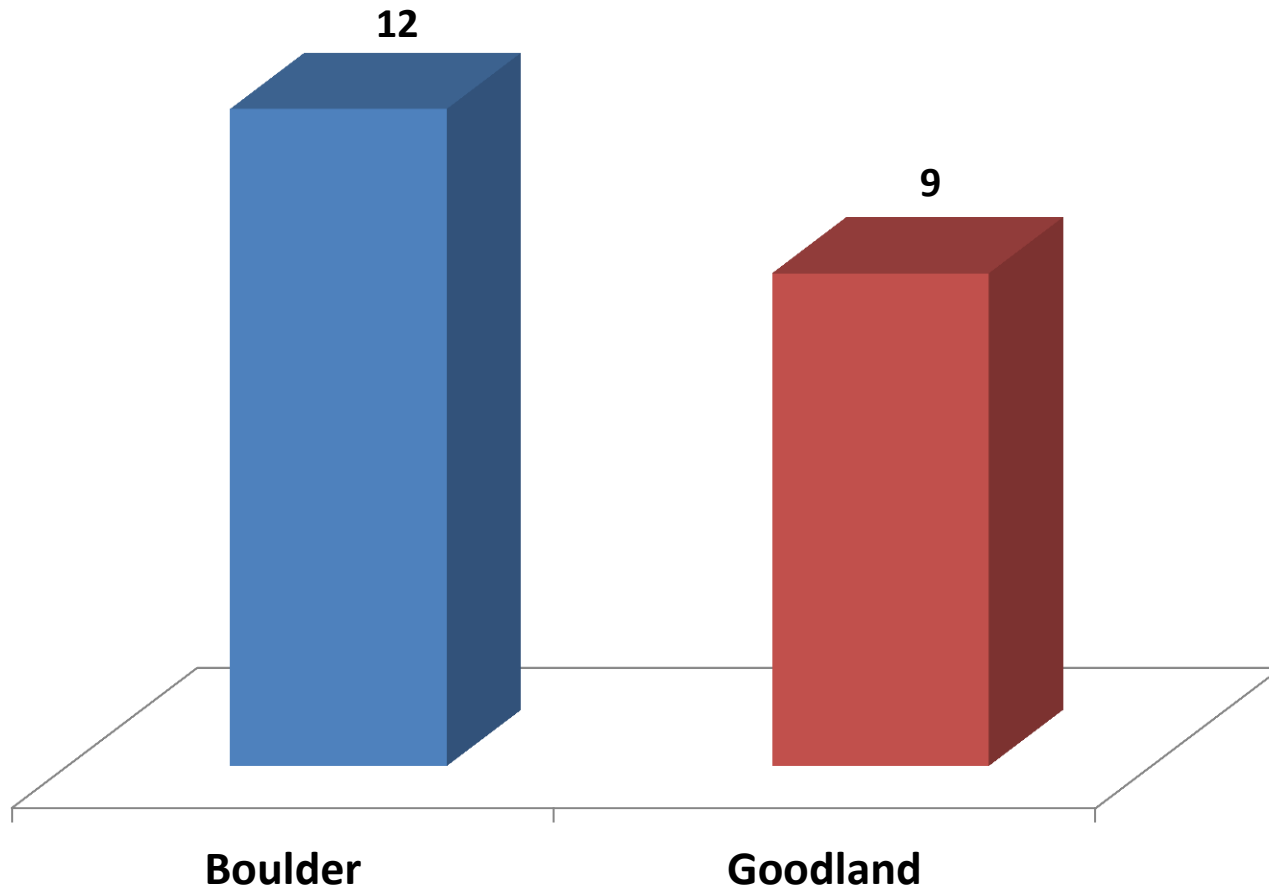

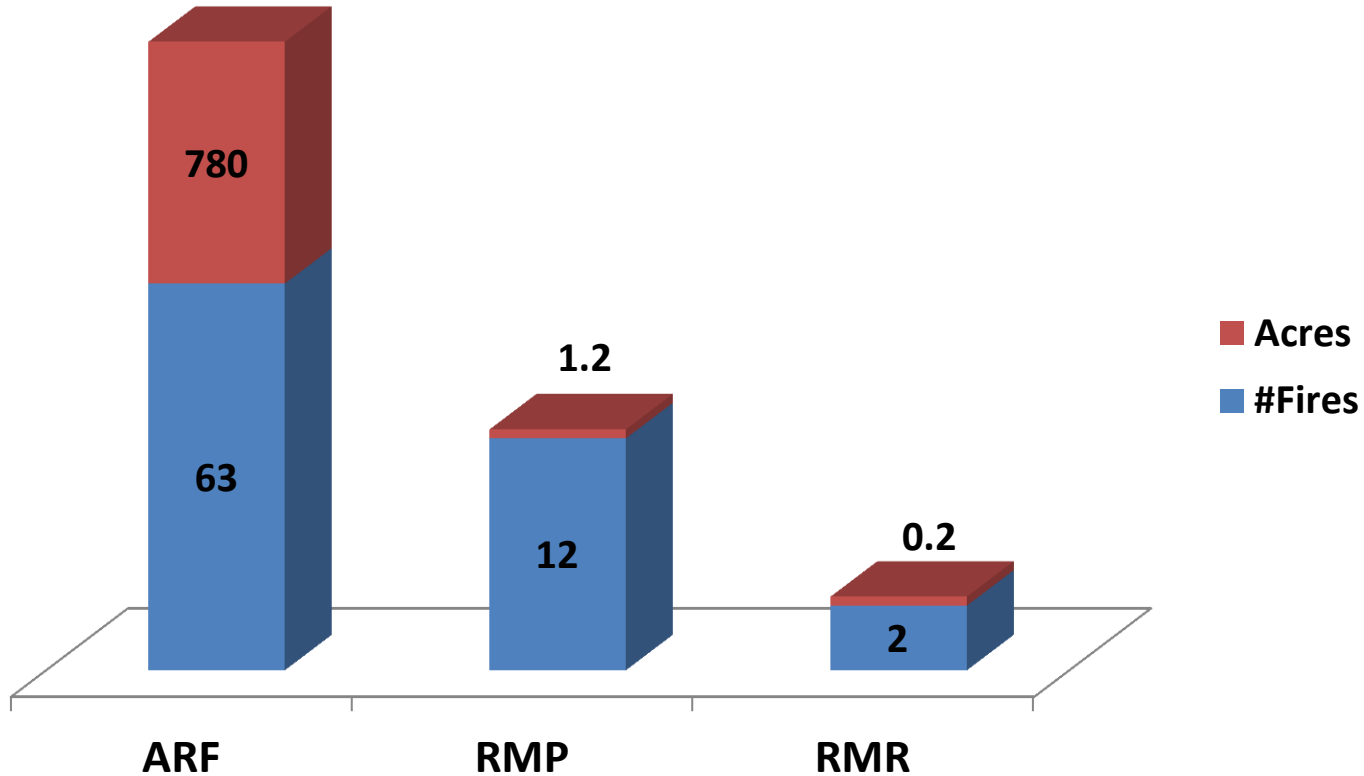

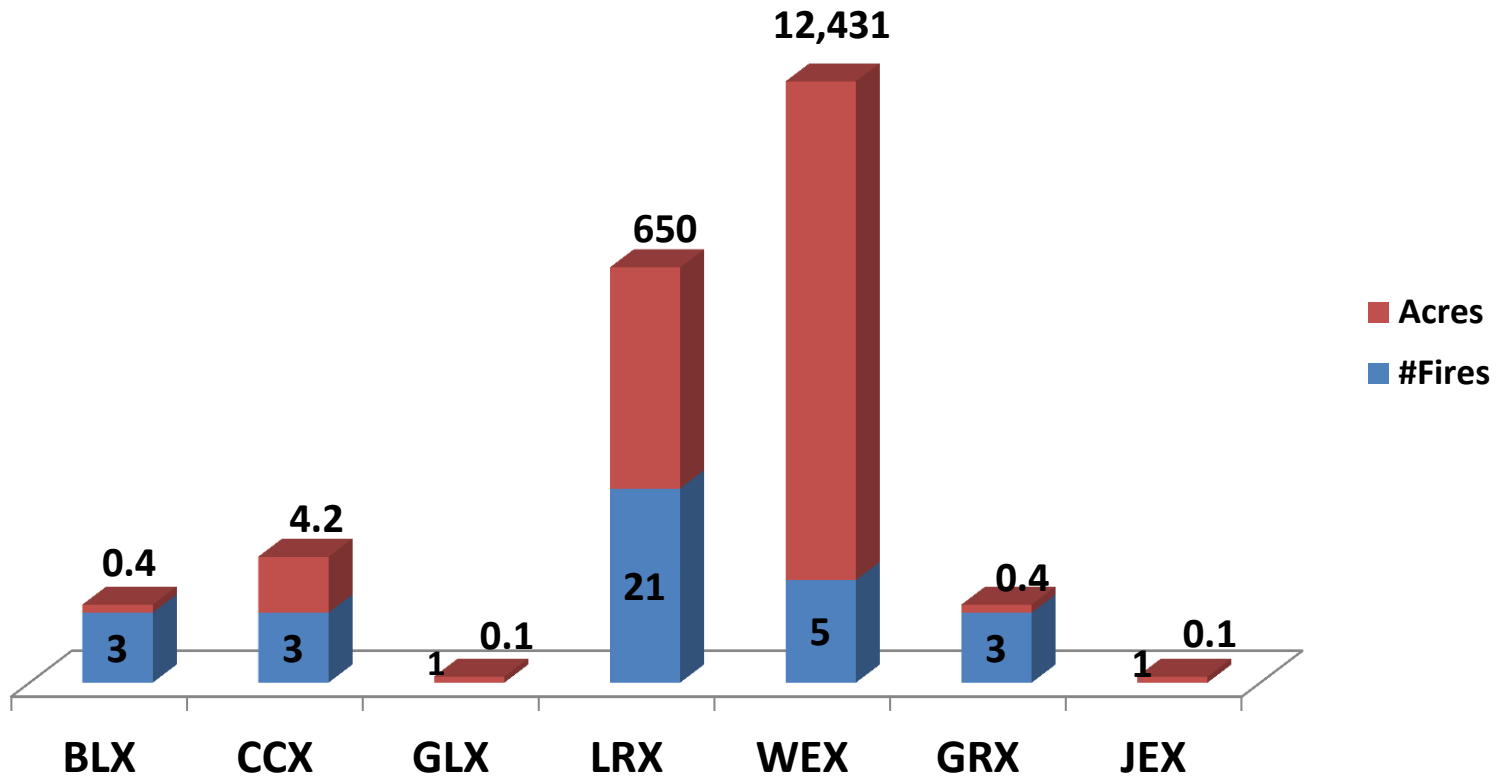

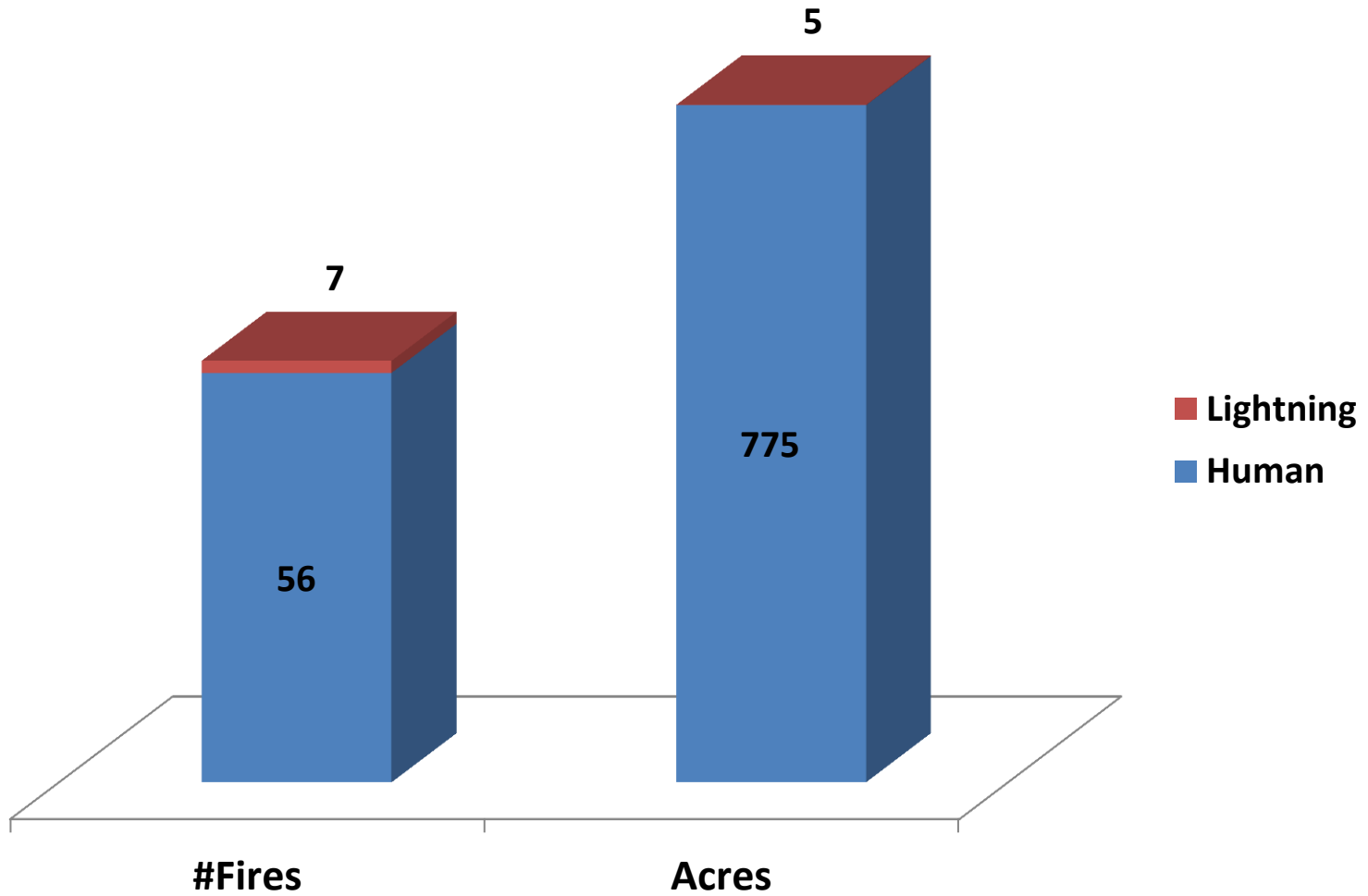

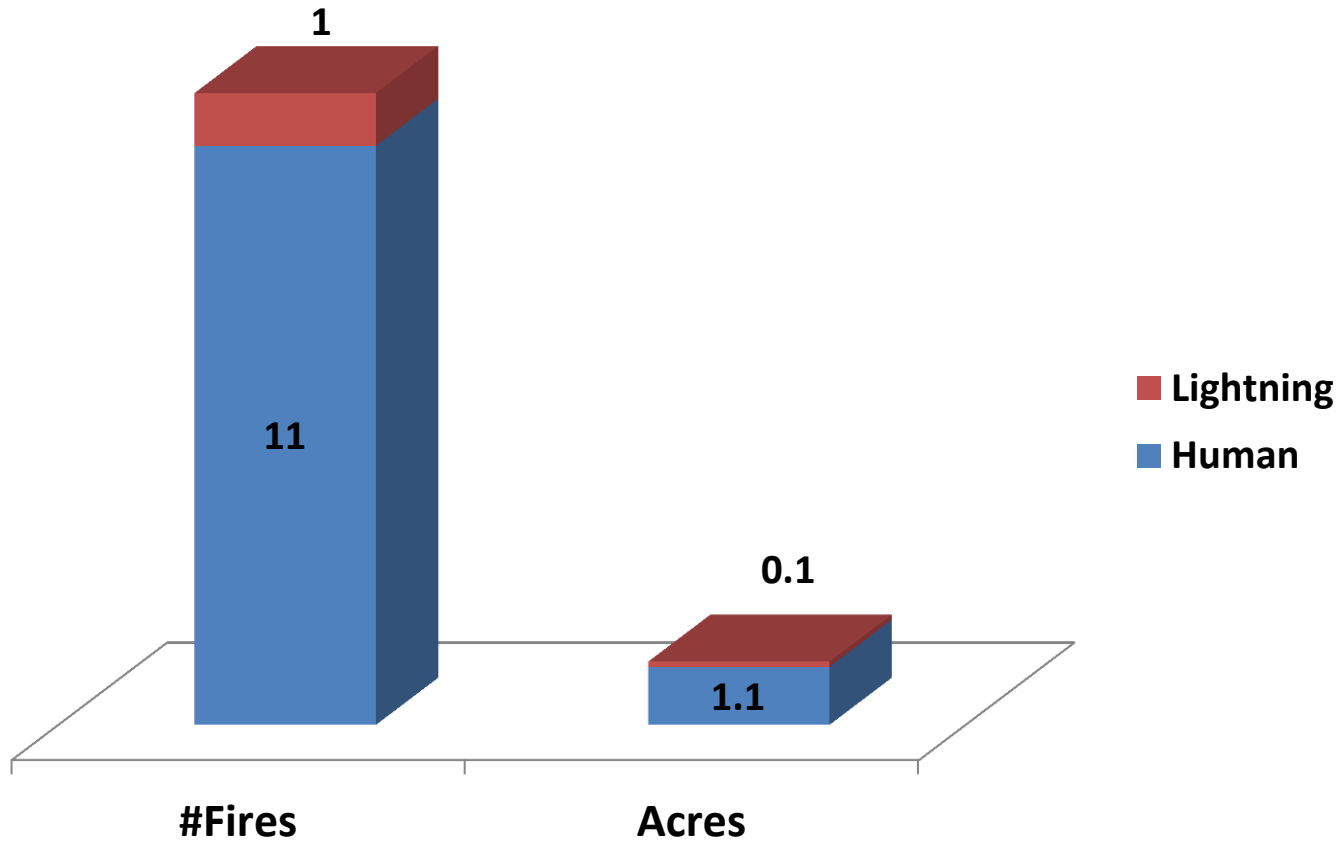

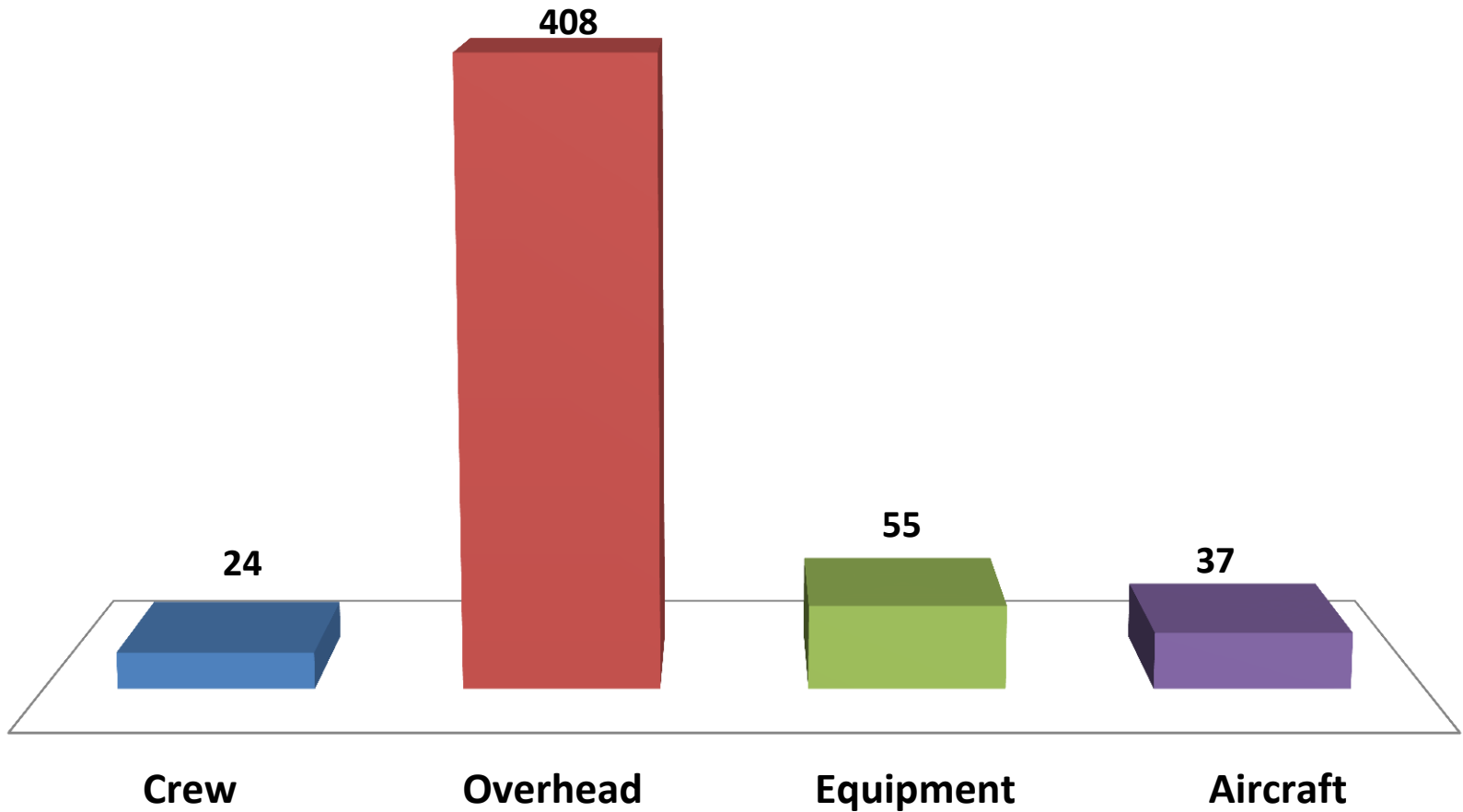


RMP Fires / Acres by Cause



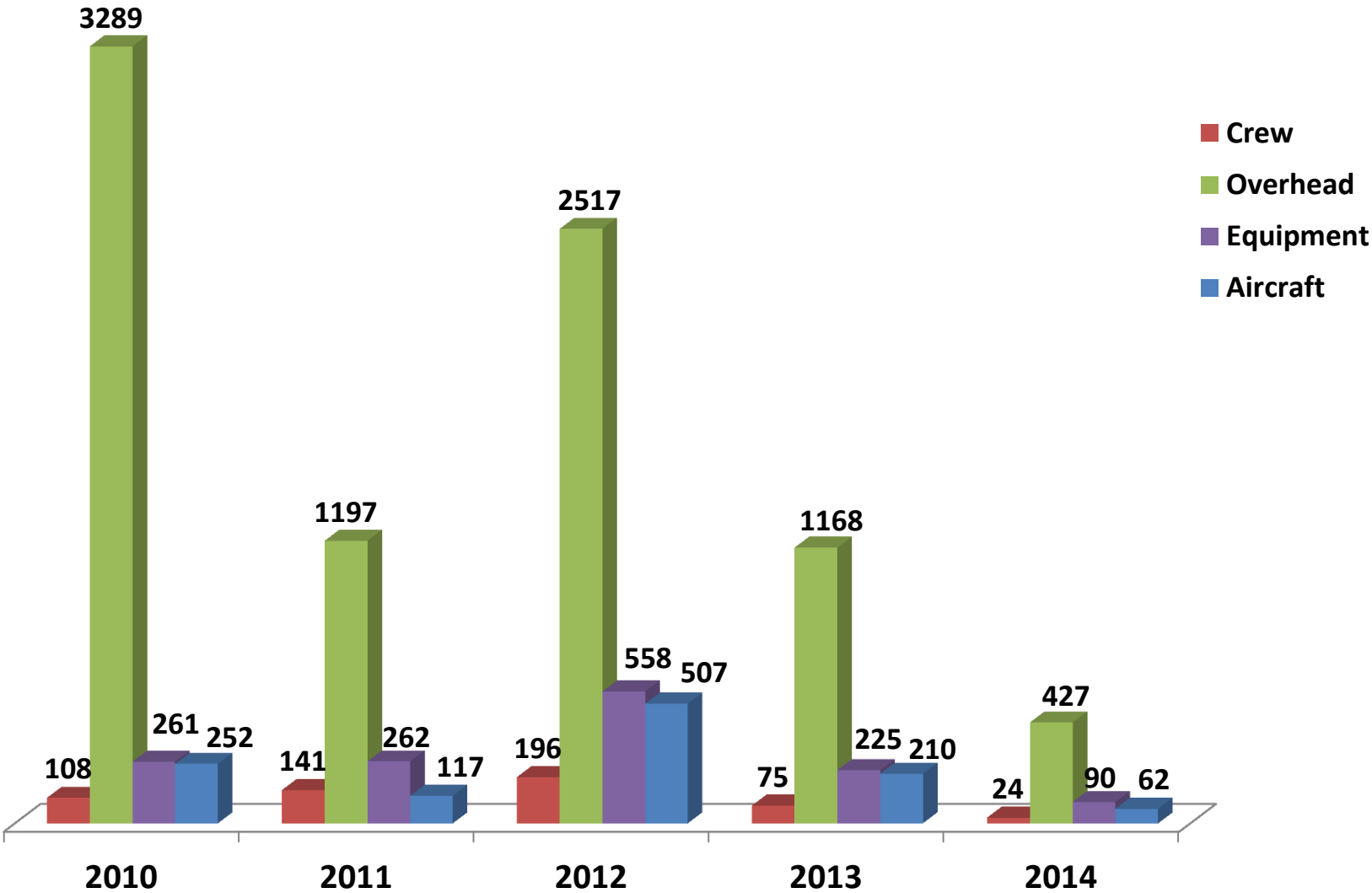

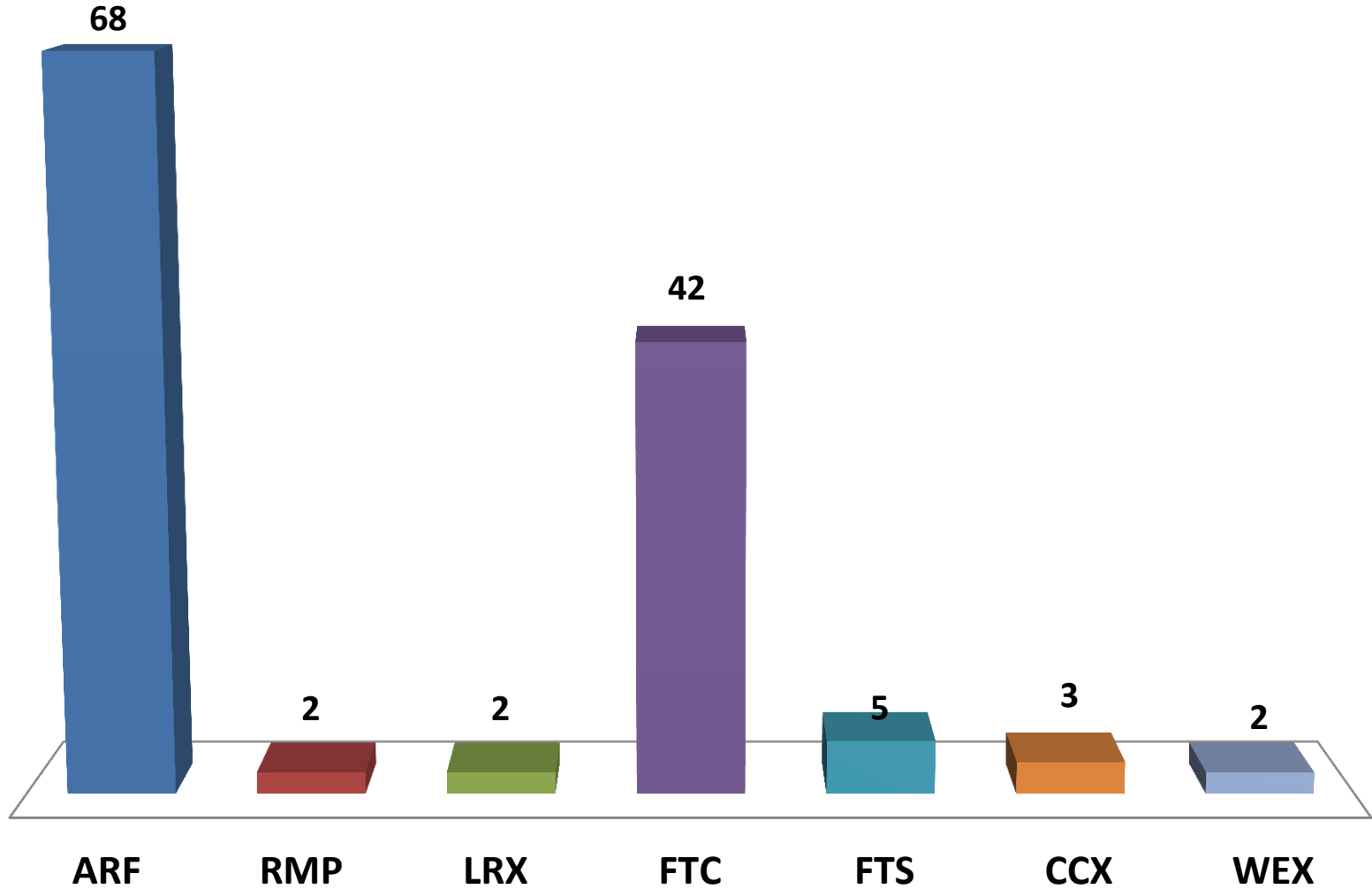

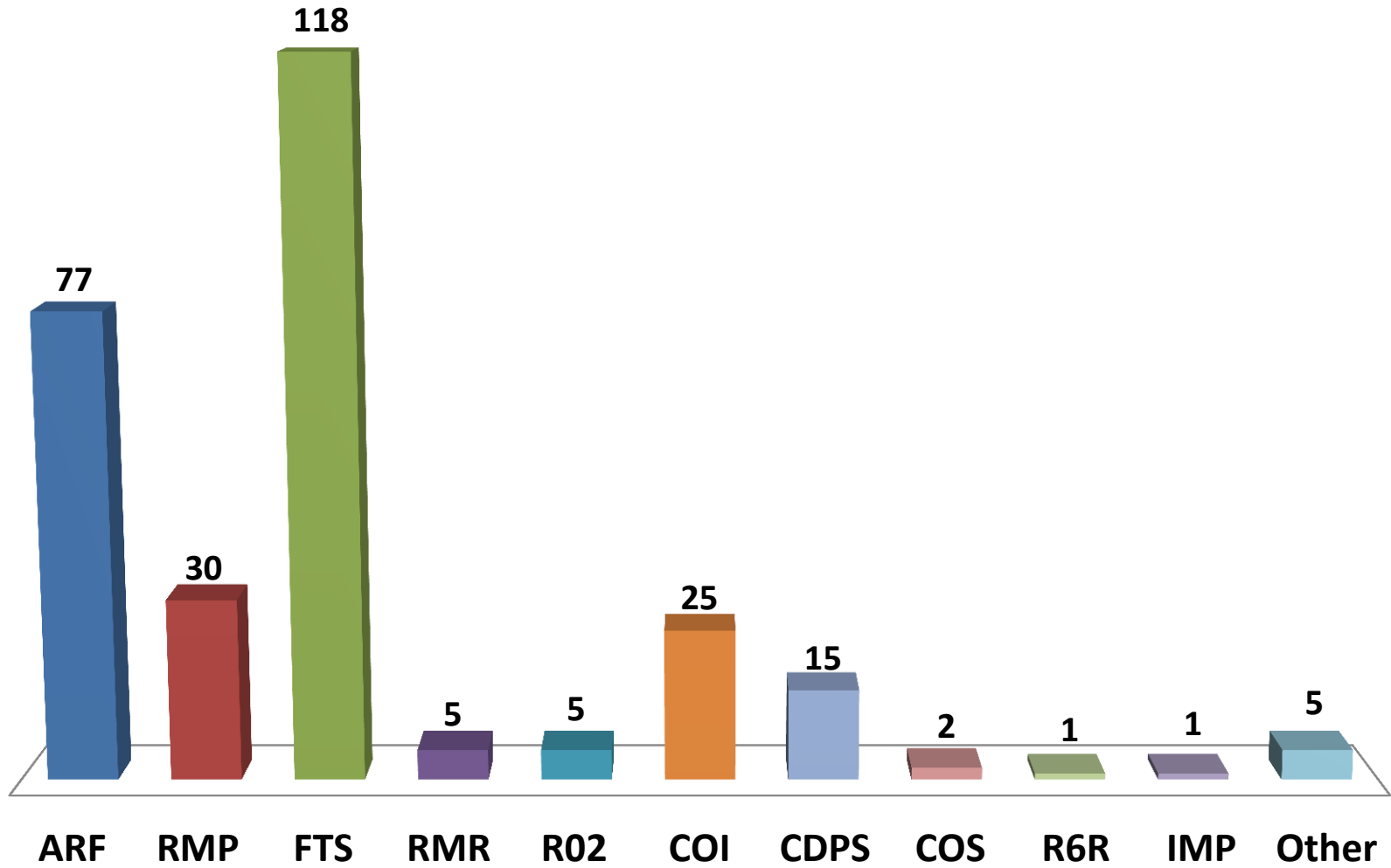

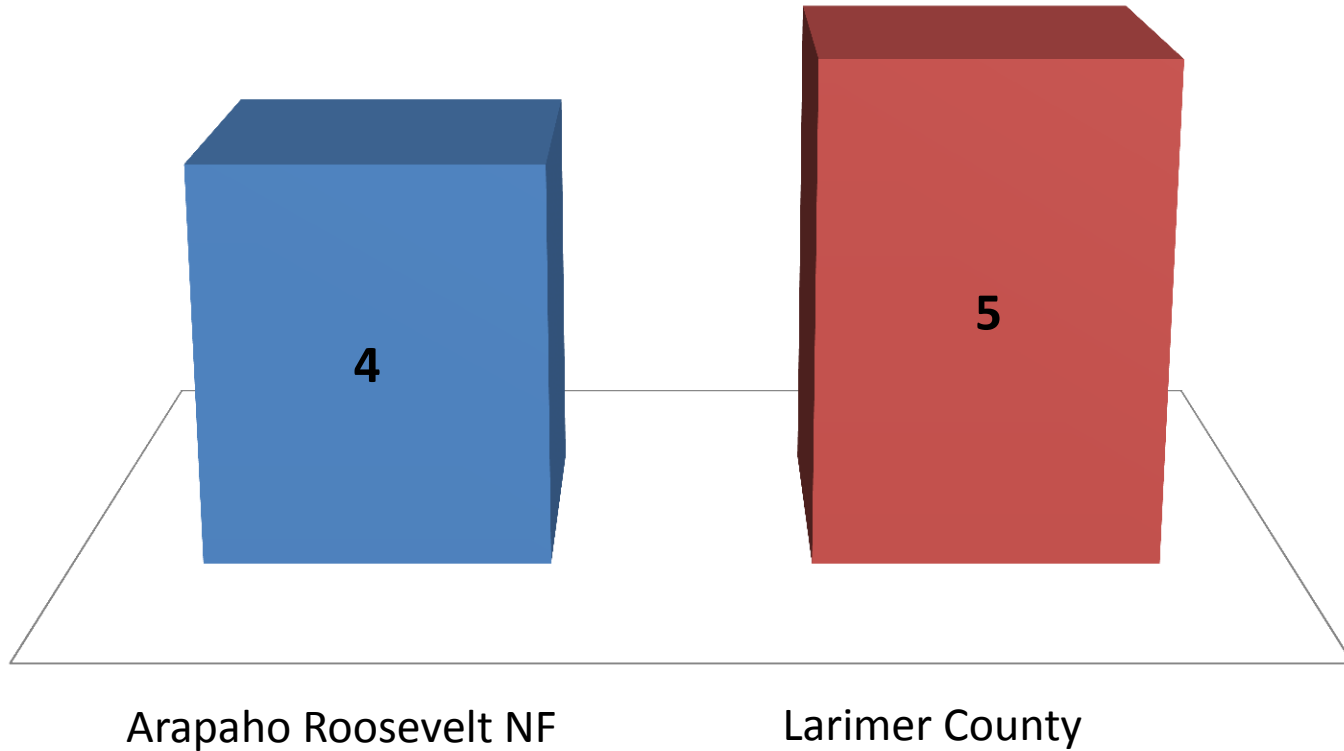
Overhead Requests in Zone by Agency



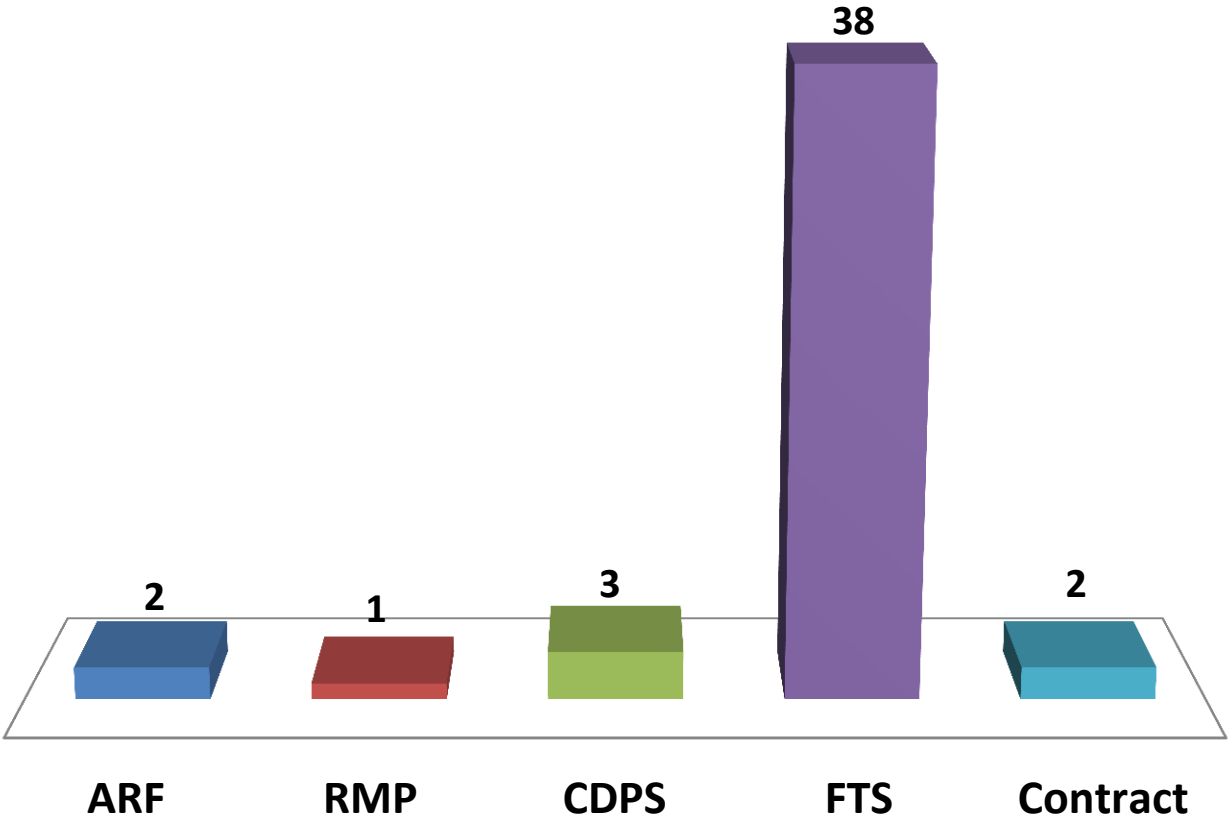
Overhead Requests Out of Zone by Agency



Engine / WT Requests in Zone by Agency

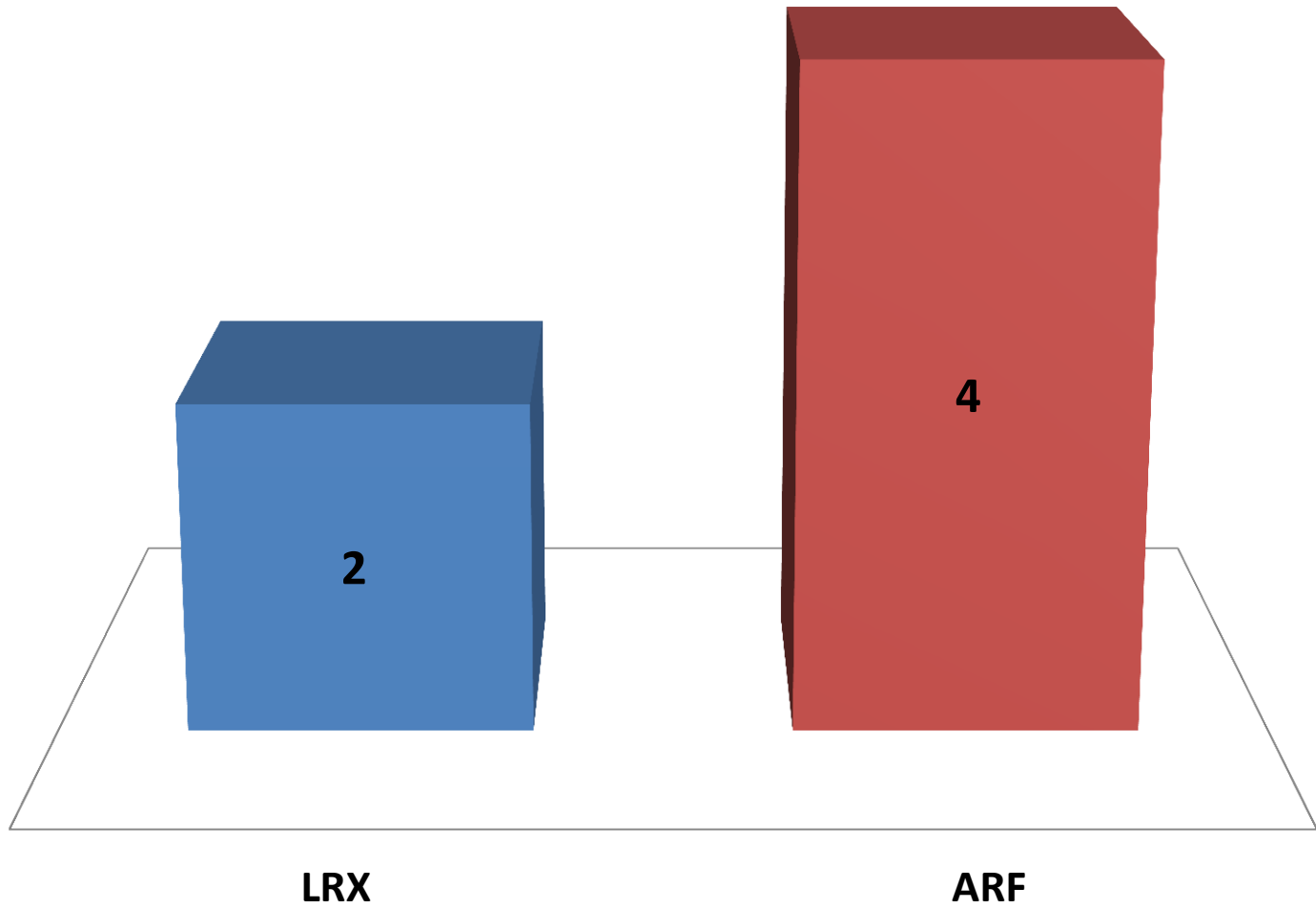


Engine / WT Requests Out of Zone by Agency

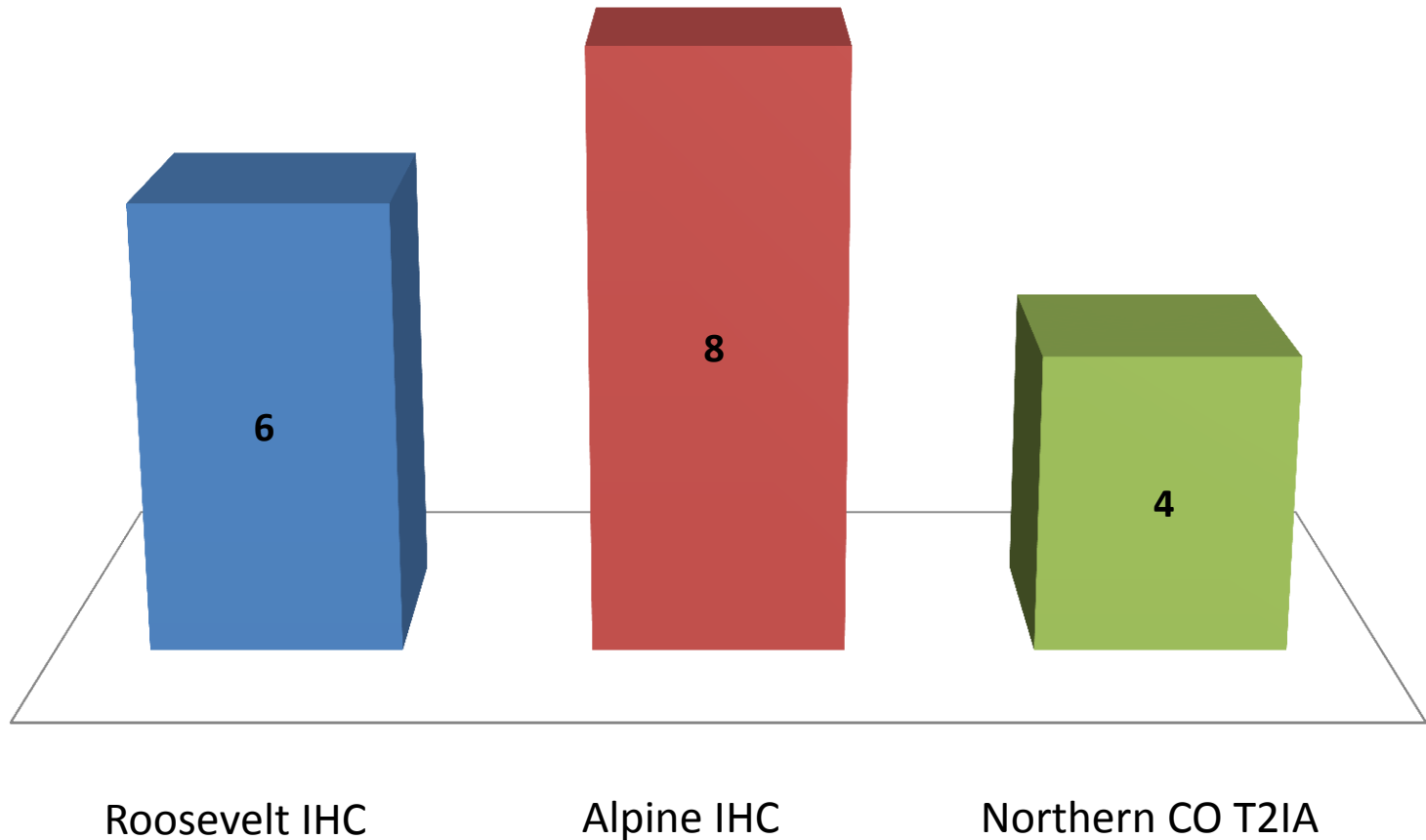

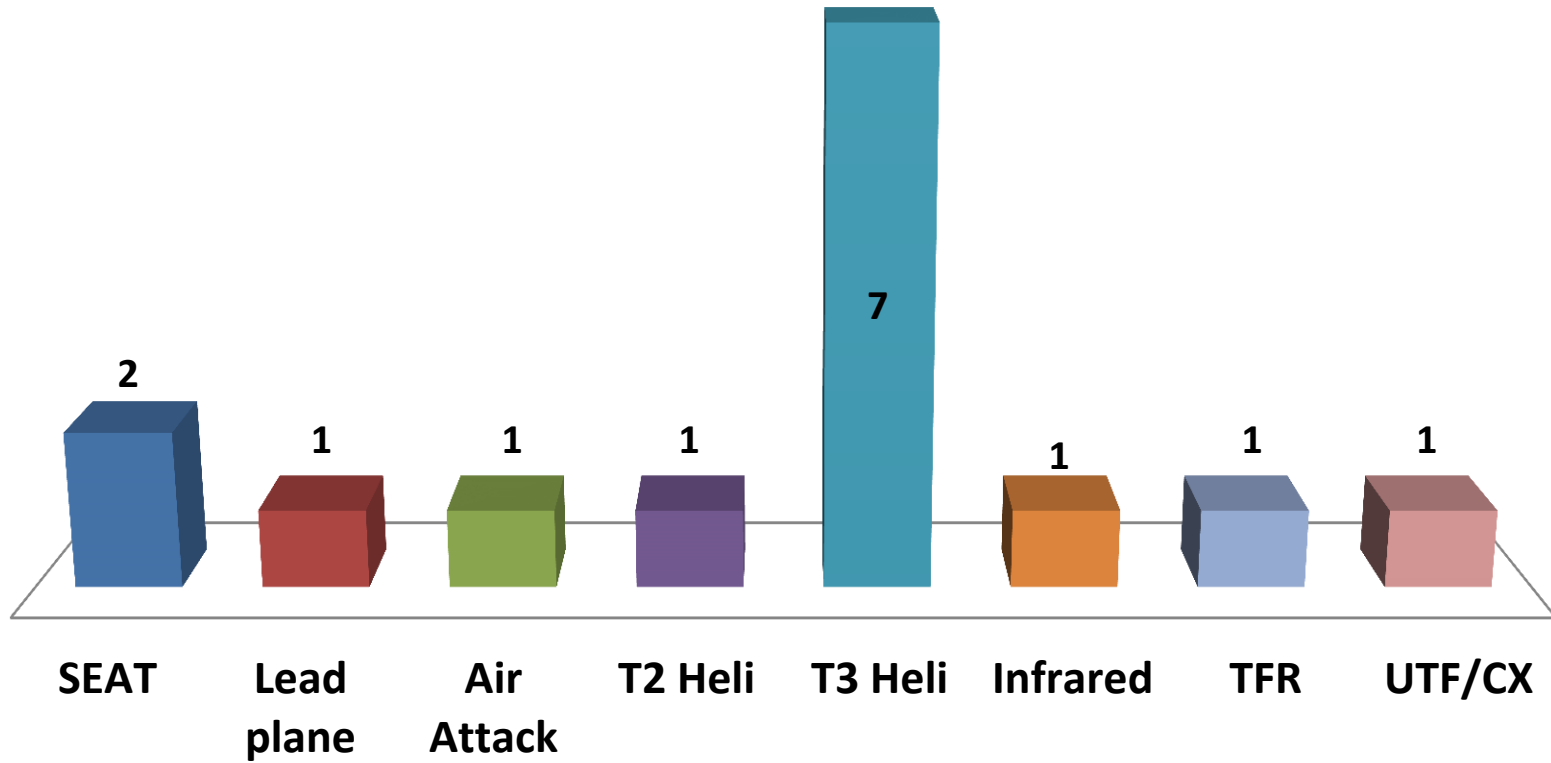
Crew Use in Zone by Agency



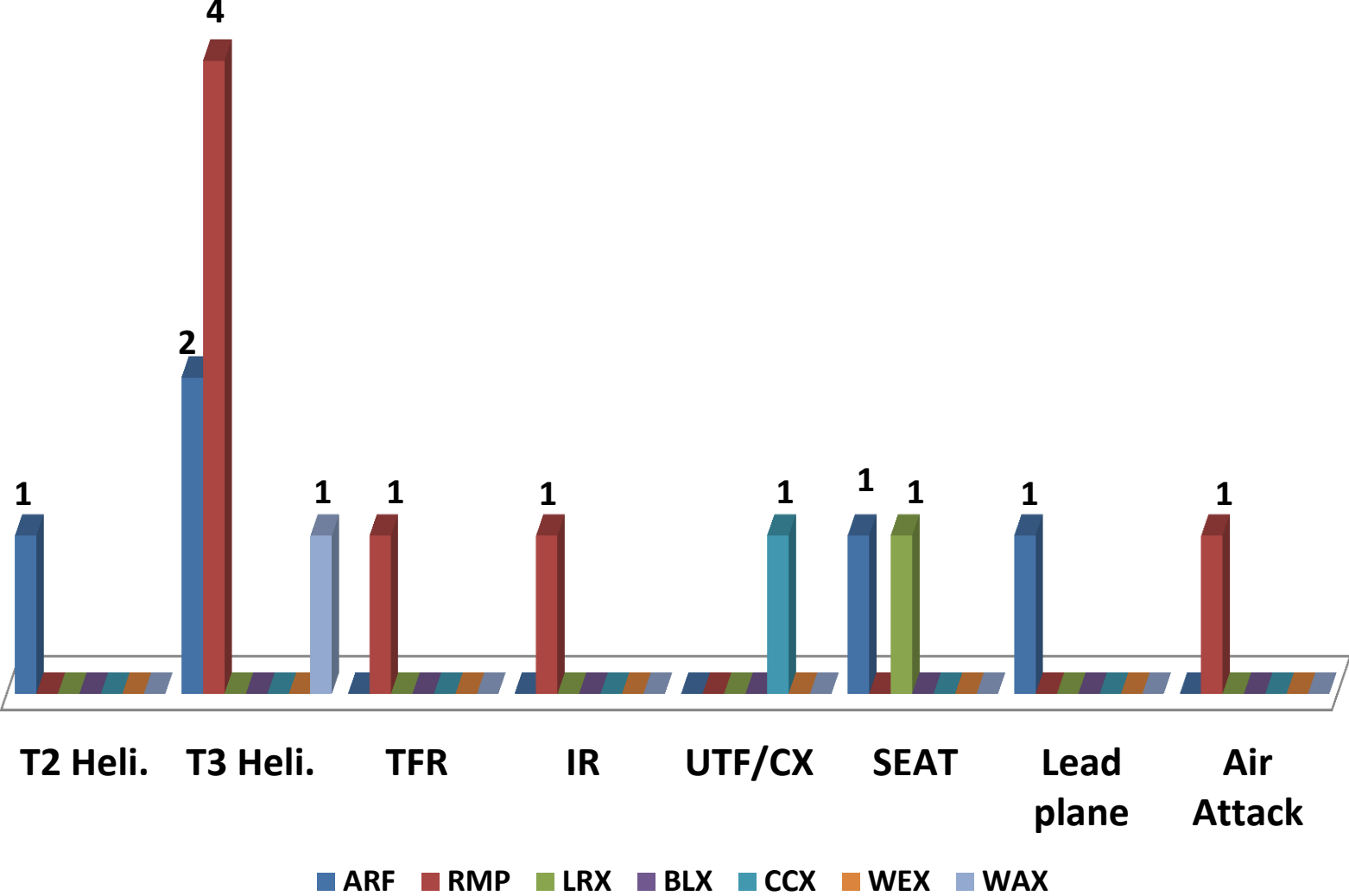
Crew Requests Out of Zone by Agency



Aircraft in Zone 2015

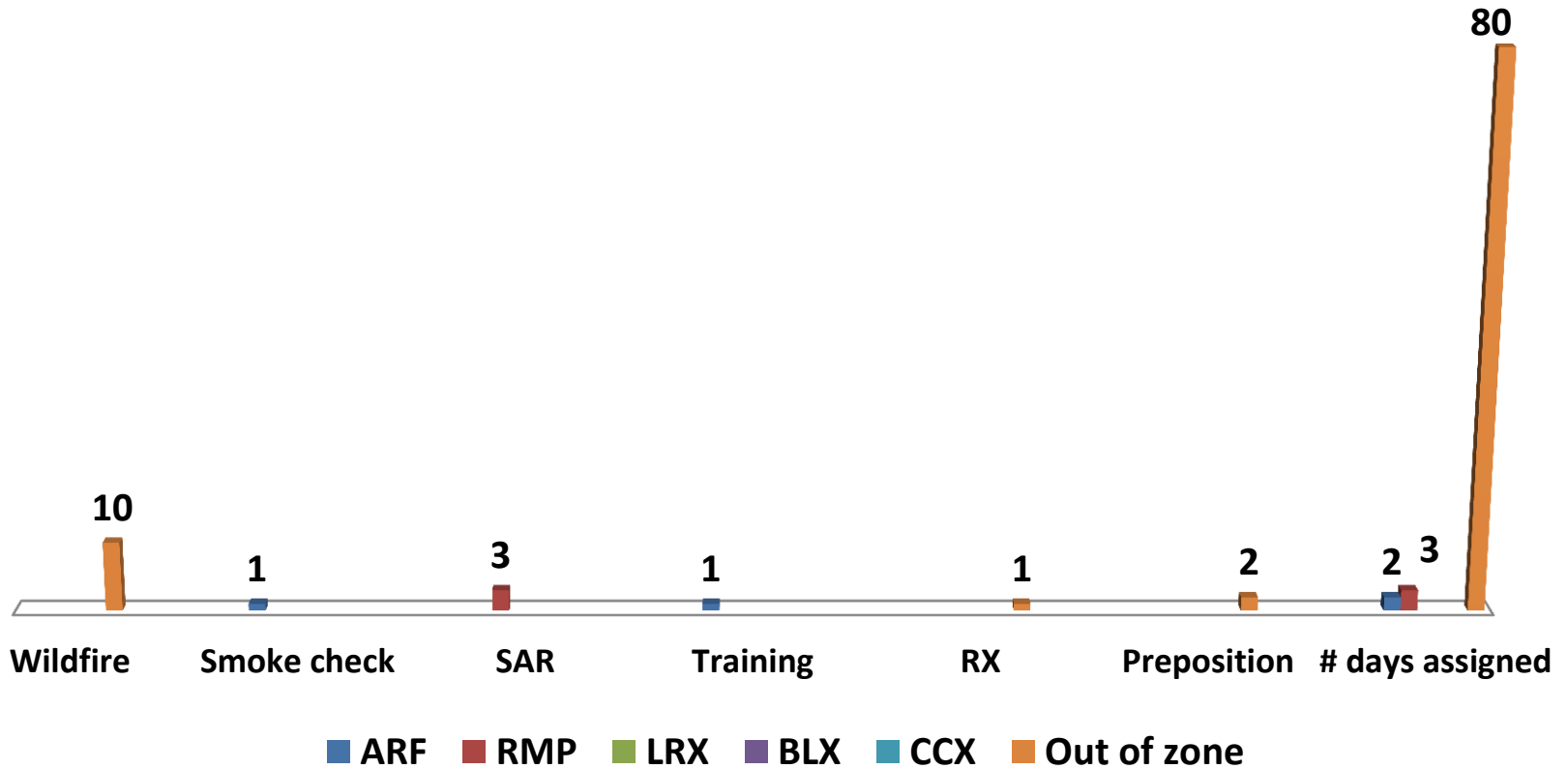


Aircraft Requests in Zone by Agency



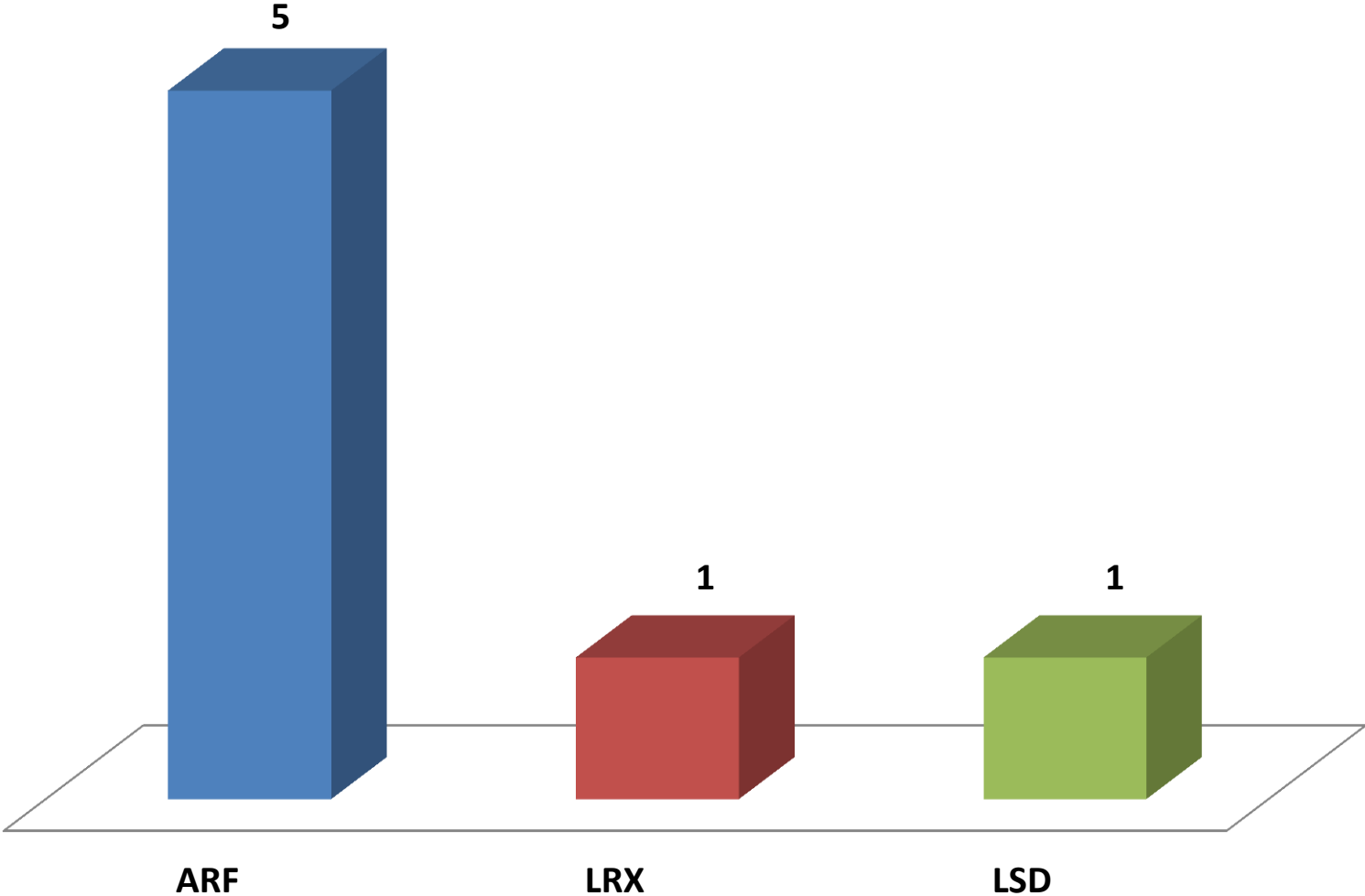
