Wanblee Timber, Pine Ridge Agency. 12 miles NE of Wanblee, SD. Fuel Models 2, 3 and 5. Moderate fire behavior with creeping and backing. Expected Containment 7/29.

Keystone, Medicine Bow NF. IMT3 Markalunas. 7 miles W of Albany, WY. Fuel Model 10. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Area closures (Road/Trail) in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area in the last 24 hours. Expected Containment 7/31.

Wilson, White River Field Office. 8 miles N of Meeker, CO. Fuel Models 2 and 5. Minimal fire behavior with creeping, smoldering. Expected Containment 7/23.

CO-CRC		
CO-DRC	2	There has been many small IAs due to a couple of thunderstorms that have gone through the area. Most of the activity is on BIA SUA and UMA. UMA is dealing with an IA that is continuing to grow and spot, multiple aircraft are on the incident. There are storms in the area, but precipitation with them has been hit and miss over the zone. These are expected to continue for the next several days.
CO-FTC	2	1 new IA today .1 ac, no needs. T storms came through the zone today. Zone PL dropped to a PL2.
CO-GJC	2	Hot with afternoon thunderstorms. Moderate IA at this filing. Single tree lightning starts, routine IA. Jumpers mob to fire near Monticello, UT. All SEAT's committed to fires on Durango Zone. 2-T1 Helos at RIL .
CO-MTC	2	Light IA. T storms & precipitation throughout area.
CO-PBC	2	Moderate IA, picked up lightning fires from yesterday. Flash Flood Advisory for Arkansas River corridor.
CO-RMC	2	Scattered Wet Thunderstorms Southern Portions of the RMA through the Weekend, with a Drying Trend Friday through Monday in Northern Portions of the Region, Along with Breezy Conditions at Times
SD-GPC	2	One new I/A, very warm across the zone today
WY-CPC	3	Multiple new starts, no confirmed ownership or acres. Will update acres later when we get the information
WY-CDC	2	Light IA, Rain showers and thunderstorms occurred over the June fire area this afternoon. Weather to be hot and dry again tomorrow through the weekend.
WY-RWC	2	Minimal IA, currently working new IA getting AA1EG to check it out, no needs
