Reporting Office	PL	Evening Remarks:
CO-CRC	2	Rain and partly cloudy conditions, more precipitation expected later this week. No new IA
CO-DRC	1	No new fires today. Unsettled conditions and below normal temperatures for the next several days.
CO-FTC	2	No IA. Remaining cool and moist, with some rain.
CO-GJC	1	No new IA. T-888 will go off contract at end of shift today. GJT Airport under TFR for Air Show. Phoscheck is on a 1 hour call back. No Aircraft remaining on the UCR.
CO-MTC	2	Minimal IA. Cooler temperatures and unsettled weather through next week.
CO-PBC	1	Warmer temps over the weekend with afternoon showers and thunderstorms across the zone. By mid-week anticipating cooler temps and precip for the zone.
CO-RMC	1	For the weekend an upper trough is expected to migrate across the northern Rockies and Great Basin Saturday, with showers and mountain snow ahead of it across Colorado and Wyoming. On Sunday a west-northwest upper level flow likely develops over Wyoming and Colorado, as a cold front initiates widespread shower activity across South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas.
SD-GPC	2	One initial attack for 0.1 acres today. Tomorrow will see warm and dry conditions before a wide-reaching cold front moves into the area early next week. This cold front is expected to bring below-average temperatures and high chances for precipitation. Updated SD-SDS YTD statistics.
WY-CPC	1	2 New IA's for 25 acres.
WY-CDC	1	No new IA today, weather temperatures were in the mid 60's with light winds across the dispatch zone, misc. overhead and equipment available.
WY-RWC	1	No new IA, no needs.
