ICS-300: Intermediate ICS (FEMA E0300)

- Implement the Incident Management process on a simulated Type 3 incident.
- Develop an Incident Action Plan for a simulated incident.

Course Prerequisites: Completion of ICS-100, ICS-200, IS-700 & IS-800. Experience using concepts and principles from ICS-100 and ICS-200 in a response or exercise is recommended.
