The RT-300 Steering Committee regrets to inform everyone that the RT-300 Burn Boss and Agency Administrator training that was planned for July 2021 has been rescheduled. The **RT-300 training will now take place from November 29 through December 2, 2021.** The Chattanooga Convention Center will host our event with nearby lodging available. **Travel and “check in” will be November 29th, with instruction beginning November 30th at 0800; classes end Thursday afternoon, December 2nd.**
