## SOUTHWEST AREA TRAINING PROGRAM NIMO TASKING (4/16/10)

### I. Authority

This Charter is created under the authority of the Southwest Coordinating Group (SWCG). It sets forth the guidelines and procedures by which the Phoenix National Incident Management Organization (NIMO) will operate.

### II. Mission Statement

To build capacity and capability into the future within the Southwest Area NIMO is chartered to evaluate the current situation of the Southwest Area training program. Evaluation of the current program as it relates to: training needs assessment process, delivery methods of 300+ level courses, and effectiveness of the satellite based approach used for fall and winter 2009-10. SWCG would like suggestions as to other potential training partners within the Southwest Area.

### III. Membership

### IV. Organization

Phoenix NIMO will determine how they will be organized. As Acting RTO Joe Reinartz will be the main point of contact for this project. Staff will be made available to provide reference documents and background information.

### V. NIMO Deliverables

- Evaluate current processes used to determine SWA training needs
- Determine effectiveness of the satellite based training approached that is being used
- Explore possible partnerships for the delivery of 300+ level courses
- Engage partner agencies and other organizations to ensure interagency solutions
- Make recommendations for future training delivery in the SWA

### VI. Meetings

Phoenix NIMO will determine meeting needs.

## **VII. Timeline**

Team should be prepared to present initial findings and recommendations at the SWCG meeting scheduled for May 11&12, 2010. Completion of your analysis and final report is expected by June 30, 2010.
