The format for the 2015 Great Basin Mobilization Guide will be modified this year to reflect the new National Mobilization Guide format. Dispatch Center Managers are reminded that they are not only responsible for submitting changes for their respective dispatch centers but also for the agencies and support organizations within their zones.
