

SPECIAL ORDERS

FIRE RESTRICTIONS

BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT CARSON CITY DISTRICT OFFICE –NEVADA

Pursuant to **43 CFR 9212.2**, the following acts are prohibited on all public land areas, roads and trails located within and administered by the BLM-Nevada Carson City District Office, effective at 12:01 a.m. on **Monday, June 30, 2014**, until further notice:


1. Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire (except a portable stove using gas, jellied petroleum or pressurized liquid fuel) outside of a developed recreation site.
2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or at a developed recreation site.
3. Operating vehicles or other motorized equipment off of existing paved, gravel or dirt roads.
4. All motor vehicles must be equipped with an operational spark arrester pursuant to **43 CFR 8343.1(c)**.
5. Welding or operation of an acetylene torch with open flames, except by permit.
6. Using or causing to be used any explosive, except by permit.
7. Possession/use of fireworks, tracer rounds, steel-core ammunition or exploding targets including Binary Explosive Targets while recreational shooting.

Pursuant to **43 CFR 9212.2**, each of the following persons is exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, state or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Title 43 CFR 9212.4 provides that any person, who knowingly and willfully performs any act restricted by the Fire Prevention Order, is punishable by imprisonment of not more than 12 months or a fine in accordance with the applicable provisions of **18 USC 3571**, or both.
