

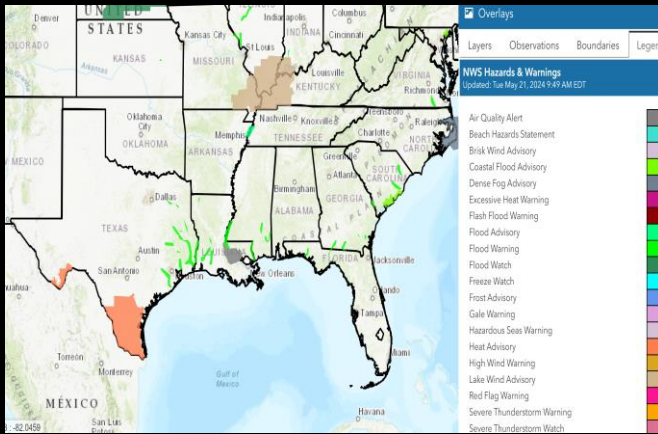

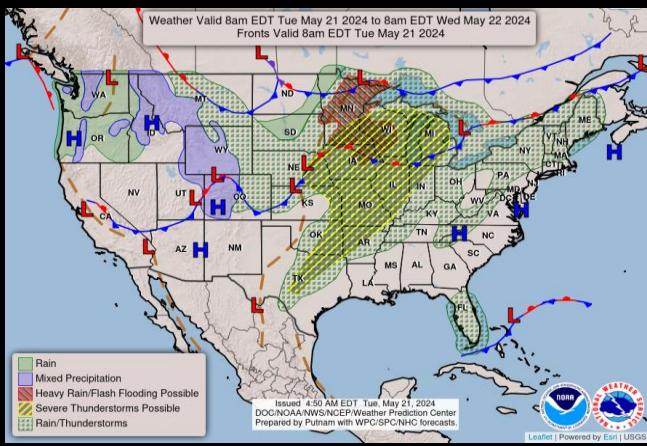


Watches, Warnings and Advisories as of 8am This Morning

Today's Weather Outlook



- An upper level High pressure is generally in control for the next couple of days then begins to breakdown for the second half of the week.
- A dry line in TX and OK brings the potential for showers and thunderstorms, some may become severe.
- Isolated dry thunderstorms cannot be ruled out in TX and OK

Past 24 Hour Rainfall Accumulations



- The Southern Area was mostly dry over the last 24 hours.
- Some light showers did occur in the southern Appalachians and FL.

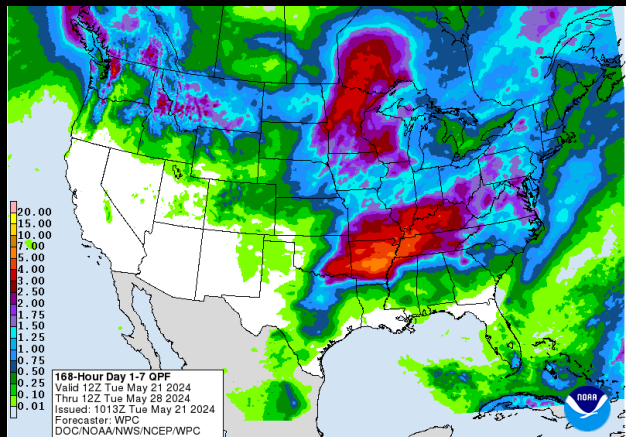


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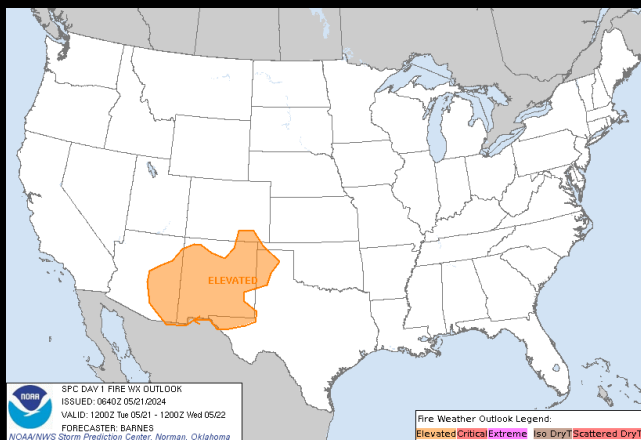


Forecast Rainfall the Next Week



- The next seven days are forecast to see significant rain, mainly for E OK, AR, TN, NW MS, N AL, N GA, and KY, although other areas may also see wettings rain as well
- Most of TX, LA, MS, AL, GA, and FL will be mostly dry, with some localize light showers possible.

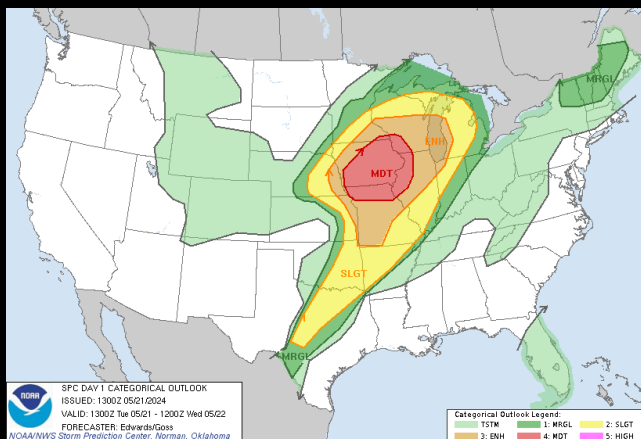


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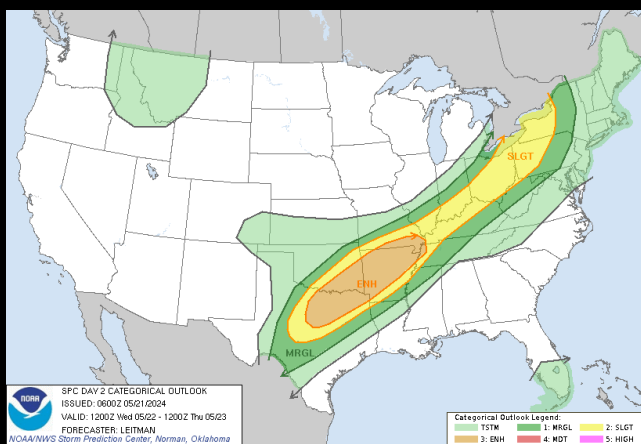


Severe Weather Outlook for Today



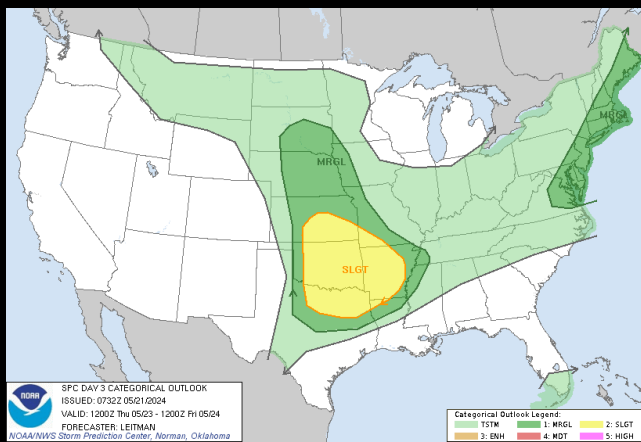
- **Slight Risk:** E OK, AR, NE and Central TX
- **Marginal Risk:** Central OK, AR, Central OK, NE and Central TX.
- **Main Threats:** large hail, damaging wind, and isolated tornadoes.

Severe Weather Outlook for Tuesday



- **Enhanced Risk:** AR, SE OK, NE TX, and NW TN
- **Low Risk:** SE and Central OK, NW and SE AR, KY, Central and NE TX and NW TN
- **Marginal Risk:** Central and NE OK, N central and NE TX, Central TN, KY, NW LA, .
- **Main Threats:** Damaging wind and large hail, and isolated tornadoes are also possible

Severe Weather Outlook for Wednesday



- **Slight Risk:** NE TX, AR, SE OK, and NW LA
- **Marginal Risk:** Central and NE TX, NW LA, NW MS, and SW TN,

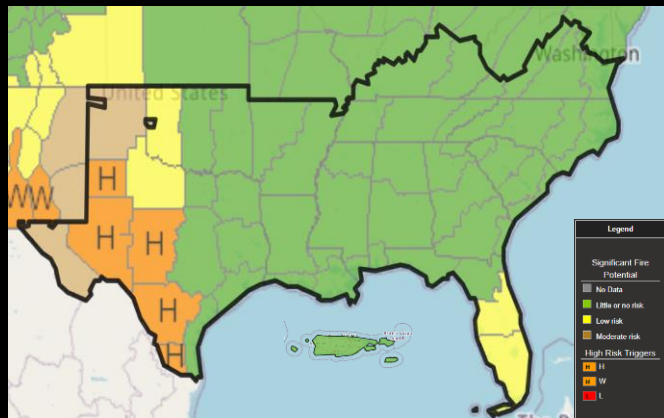


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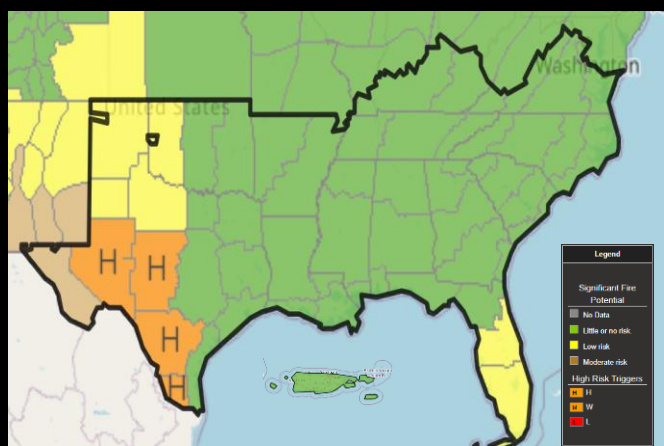


Significant Fire Potential Outlook Today



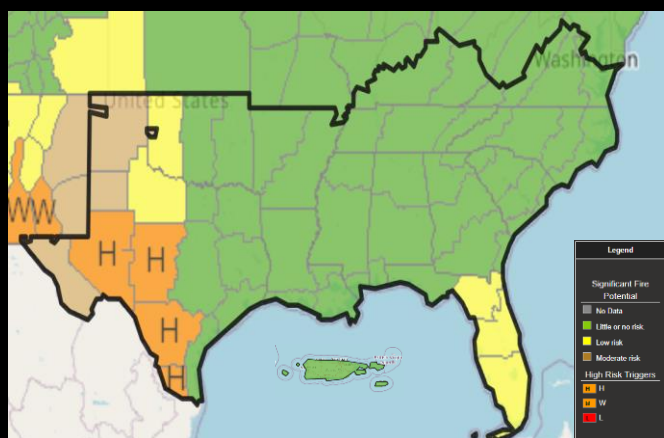
- **High Risk:** W TX, S TX Panhandle, and the Rio Grande Plains for well above normal temperatures, very low RH, and very dry fuels.
- **Moderate Risk:** W TX Mts and the TX/OK Panhandles.
- **Low Risk:** NW Central TX, W OK, and Central/South Florida for low RH and dry fuels.

Significant Fire Potential Outlook for Wednesday



- **High Risk:** W and SW TX, and the Rio Grande Plains for well above normal temperatures, very low RH, and very dry fuels.
- **Moderate Risk:** W Texas MTS for low RH, Dry Fuels.
- **Low Risk:** TX/OK Panhandles, W OK, NW TX, and Central/S FL for low RH and dry fuels.

Significant Fire Potential Outlook for Thursday



- **High Risk:** W/SW TX and N Rio Grande Plains for well above normal temperatures, very low RH, and very dry fuels.
- **Moderate Risk:** W Texas Mts, TX/OK Panhandles for low RH, Dry Fuels.
- **Low Risk:** W OK, NW TX, and the FL Peninsula for low RH, and Dry Fuels.
